Dear Mr. Sevilla:

The Commanding General has directed that you be informed that the complementary roster of the Training Sector, Squadron "B", Magway's Forces, 23d, purporting to be a guerrilla organization under your nominal control, has not been favorably considered for recognition as an element of the Philippine Army.

A set of general requirements for guerrilla recognition, established by General MacArthur during the liberation of the Philippines, has been used as a guide in considering the roster of this unit. After careful investigation and full consideration of all available substantiating records and testimony of witnesses having pertinent knowledge, recognition of this guerrilla unit is not deemed to be warranted because of reasons mentioned below:

- a. Alleged records were not maintained as to dates of enlistments, dates of promotions and necessary related information.
 - b. Many members apparently lived at home, supporting their families by means of farming or other civilian pursuits, and assisted the guerrilla unit on a part-time basis only.
 - c. The unit was not maintained actively in the field in opposition to the enemy.
 - d. Record of services was not substantiated by sufficient acceptable evidence.
 - e. The unit was not maintained in the field in the way of an organized fighting force.
- It is considered that the previous recognition of approximately 231 officers and men of this unit during the liberation of the Philippines by the 23d Squadron "B", Magway's Forces, which were recognized by the Commanding General for their aid during the liberation of the Philippines constitutes adequate and just acknowledgment of military services rendered as to dates of enlistment.

It is requested that you comply with the provisions of Executive Order No. 68, by the President of the Philippines, dated 26 Sept 1946, copy attached.

Lt. Col. H. L. Garnahan:

1. The supplementary roster of the Palauig Sector, Squadron "B", Magsaysay's Guerrilla Forces, Zambales Military District, consisting of 442 officers and men under the command of Captain Ramon S. Sevilla has not been favorably considered for recognition.

2. Basis of non-recognition:

a. Adequate records were not maintained as to dates of enlistments, dates of promotions and necessary related information. Many members apparently lived at home, supporting their families by means of farming or other civilian pursuits, and absented the guerrilla unit on a part time basis only.

c. The unit was not maintained satisfactorily in the field in opposition to the enemy. Members assisted Guerrillas only on a part time basis, acting as "Home Guards".

d. Record of service was not substantiated by sufficient acceptable evidence. There are no supporting papers for any of the companies of the unit.

e. 281 men of Bn Hq, Hq & Hq Co, Companies A, B, and G were previously recognized under Captain Cariaga.

f. Most of the officers and men also appear on the roster of the Palauig Special Battalion and many of them also appear on another roster submitted by Sevilla under name of "Western Luzon Guerrilla Forces".

g. Some of the members of subject unit have previously been recognized and paid when the Palauig Sector was recognized under Capt. Cariaga.

h. Members had previously filled out questionnaires giving the "Palauig Special Battalion" as their unit, listing the Palauig Sector, Squadron "B" as their former unit.

Report on the "Palauig Sector,
Squadron D, Magsaysay's Forces, ZMD"

In accordance with verbal instructions from Chief of Section Guerrilla Affairs, G-3, AFWESPAC, Lieutenant Morris S. Flory, on 7th of July, 1946, proceeded to Palauig, Zambales to contact the "Palauig Sector, Squadron D, Magsaysay's Forces, ZMD", in order to determine whether or not this organization should be recognized by the United States Army. The following report is a summary of the investigation and basis for the recommendation.

ALLEGED HISTORY

The Palauig Sector, Squadron B, Magsaysay's Forces, ZMD was first organized on 25 August 1942 under the command of the late Captain Ulpiano Tuazon with the help of Sgt. Miller and Captain Antonio Decano who were members of Captain Ralph McGuire's Western Luzon Guerrilla Forces (WLGFF). Captain Tuazon was killed on October 29, 1942 and was succeeded by Captain Vicente Villanueva who was inturn killed in the early part of January 1943. After the death of Villanueva the unit commanders disagreed on policies, the organization was split up and divided into two sections: the Palauig Special Battalion under Richard P. Asis and the Palauig Sector under Captain Isabello Cariaga. This is actually what happened but, according to the submitted history by Ramon Sevilla, after the death of Captain Villanueva, Captain Teodoro Montalla, who was then Inspector General of the WLGFF, took command until Captain Bernardo Azurin was appointed Palauig Sector Commander on 15 June 1943.

The presence of strong Japanese forces in the Province forced the Unit to lay aside plans and remain silent for a while. They did not carry on their guerrilla activities for fear the Japanese would discover their organization. On 20 November 1943 activity was again resumed and the unit claims to have been active from that time until final liberation.

The unit was engaged in minor skirmishes, but were lightly armed, most of their encounters being fought with bolos. Outside of this minor activities were the warning of civilians when danger approached and doing espionage work against the enemy.

The unit in the beginning had few members and practically no arms or ammunition. They claim 3 companies with approximately 400 members. However, 281 men of Battalion Hq, Hq & Hq Co, Companies A, B, and C of the Palauig Sector were recognized under the command of Isabello Cariaga.

Upon investigation it was found that most of the Officers and men appear on the roster of the "Palaug Special Battalion", their ranks in subject unit and above unit varying considerably.

The members of this unit had previously filled out questionnaires when the Palaug Special Battalion was investigated, giving the Palaug Sector as their former organization.

Ramon Sevilla is the man who submitted the present rosters of companies A, B & C were previously recognized from the Palaug Sector under Captain Isabella Cariaga. Sevilla also has submitted a roster under the name of "Western Luzon Guerrilla Forces" (WLGFF) an entirely separate unit., consisting mostly of members on the rosters of the Palaug Sector and the Palaug Special Battalion,

The unit had few arms and little ammunition, most of their fight was with bolos. Consequently they could not have been very effective. There are no supporting papers for the unit either before or after the American landings on Luzon. The organization acted more as a "Home Guard" unit than as a military unit.

Most of the members did not have full time activities with the guerrillas but remained at home, assisting the guerrillas only occasionally.

Some of the members listed on subject roster have been previously paid under the command of Captain Cariaga.

It is concluded that the members of this organization did not have full time status as a guerrilla and it is believed that the members of the unit worthy of recognition have been recognized under the command of Captain Cariaga.

POLITICAL ASPECTS

Most of the officers of this unit hold political jobs today. The policy at the time of submission of rosters was that if the individual did not agree with the political beliefs of officers making up rosters his name was omitted.

RECOMMENDATIONS

After careful consideration of the statements made by the present members and analysis of the documents presented, it is recommended that with the exception of those members previously recognized as members of the Palauig Sector under the Command of Captain Cariaga, The "Palauig Sector, Squadron "B", Magsaysay's Guerrilla Forces, Zamboales Military District., be not favorably considered for recognition.

BRIEF HISTORY OF THE ORGANIZATION FORMERLY KNOWN AS WESTERN LUZON GUERRILLA FORCES, UNDER THE COMMAND OF THE LATE CAPTAIN RALPH MCGUIRE, PALAUIG SECTOR ATTACHED TO 152nd INF. 2nd BN. 86th DIV. AND ITS ACTIVITIES.

Sometime in the month of July, 1942, Captain Antonio Decano and the late Sgt. Miller of the U. S. Army, approached us advising us to organize Guerrilla Forces under the direct command of the late Captain Ralph McGuire. At once an organization known as WESTERN LUZON GUERRILLA FORCES, under the command of the late Captain Ulpiano Tuazon, as commanding officer of the Palaui Sector, was formed. Unfortunately, the command of Capt. Ulpiano Tuazon was cut short by his sudden death which he met in the hands of Japanese patrols whom he encountered somewhere in the mountains of Zambales. Immediately, upon order of Captain McGuire, Captain Vicente Villanueva took over the command sometime in October, 1942 to replace the late Captain Tuazon.

During this time, because of the aid of certain Filipino traitors and spies, who found material aid and favor in the enemy, our activities as guerrillas reached the suspicion of the Japanese stationed in this province. The Japanese became furious and at once launched an intensive house-to-house search for suspected guerrilla members, resulting in the capture of a number of guerrilla suspects among whom were the following: Captain Vicente Villanueva, his wife, Maxima Achacoso, Ceferina Lazaro, Mayor Ramon Sevilla, Bernardo Maliberan, Leon Falaminiano, Joaquin Angulo, Pedro Mendoza, Andres Altares, Marcelo Altares, Senobio Altares, Victor Miranda, Simon Duplao, Bonifacio Custodio, Estimo Aldea, and Otello Dizon. These guerrilla suspects were severely tortured but later released with the exception of Capt. Vicente Villanueva, Bernardo Maliberan, Leon Falaminiano, Joaquin Angulo and Pedro Mendoza who were retained and whose fate was never heard of since then. It may be stated in this connection that Bernardo Maliberan, Joaquin Angulo and Leon Falaminiano were captured while on their way home after taking supplies to the Camp of Captain Ralph McGuire somewhere in the mountains.

After the death of Captain Vicente Villanueva, Captain Teodoro Montalla, who was then Inspector General of the Western Luzon Guerrilla Forces, took the command for the meantime until after Captain Bernardo Azurin was appointed Sector Commander of this Sector by Captain Antonio, formerly Adjutant General of the Western Luzon Guerrilla Forces on June 15, 1943.

In spite of the efforts of the Japanese soldiers to capture all of our comrades still they failed in their attempts. Consequently, they stationed Japanese Garrison composed of Japanese soldiers and Filipino constabulary men in this Municipality to help wipeout guerrilla members. In the course of their stay some of our comrades were captured and tortured and others were executed. Among those who were captured were, Juan Rianza, Pacifico Mora, Eusebio Maliberan, Macario Agostosa, Domingo Monato, Ireneo Dizon and Victor Gararo. These men were later released with the exception of Ireneo Dizon and Victor Gararo who were retained and sentenced to be executed. Our Municipal Mayor, Ramon S. Sevilla, then a secret officer of our organization diplomatically intervened and tried with all his efforts to save the lives of our two comrades. At first the detachment commander of the Constabulary soldiers stationed in this Municipality, acceded to the plea of the Mayor on condition that the two men should act as guides of the constabulary men to the camp of our Organization.

But the loyalty burried deep in the heart of our two comrades, and their vows and swears to duty, to both the United States and the Commonwealth of the Philippines, made them prefer a thousand death to disloyalty. Thus, they met their heroic death in the hands of the Constabularymen somewhere in the mountains sometime in the month of June 1943.

The presence of strong Japanese force in Province, who were in close watch of every movement that we made, forced us to lay aside our plans and remain silent for a while. We could not carry on our planned activities for fear that the Japanese would discover our secrets and thus put an end to our lives and to the noble cause for which we had been fighting. Fortunately, our silence won the confidence of the Japanese and accordingly, the strength of their force in this province was reduced for obvious reasons. Taking this opportunity, forgetting all past tortures and executions and other horrible experiences, and unmindful of all possible dangers that we were facing, we again resumed our activities in full swing on November 20, 1943. From then until the coming of the Liberating Forces and the final liberation of the whole Islands we had remained active doing all means within our power to help win final victory over the common enemy. And we are proud to enumerate here in chronological order the various activities that we had had from 20 November 1943, until the coming of the liberating Forces, as follows:

- 20 Nov. 1943-Secret Meeting at Magalawa Island under the leadership of Captain Antonio Decano.
- 16 Jan. 1944 we raided Japanese truck a Pañguligan and took one Japanese Radio Set.
- 26 Feb. 1944, made sabotage work when a Japanese ship anchored at Subic, Palauig, Zambales, by taking away all available food supplies and destroying tanks of gasoline and crude oils.
- 19 June 1944, Japs raided our camp and we retreated and we were not able to bring with us our captured Radio Set.
- 21 Sept. 1944 we raided Japs Camps at Luan who were remnants of bombs made by US planes. 21 were killed. Captured 1 machine gun 500 rounds.
- 23 Sept. 1944 Captured 2 Japs in Luan and killed them 25 Sept. 1944.
- 5th Oct. 1944 Secret Meeting with Captain Conrado Estella as this town was often times his hiding place.
- 6th Oct. 1944 Burying all partially damage vessel of Japs at Luan and destroying all tanks of gasoline and crude oils and taking away all food supplies that are of need by the civilians.
- 27 Nov. 1944 Detailed outpost guards when Lt. Doyle and Sgt King, who were found hiding in the Swamps of Kaslagan, were escorted to Dumaraya a safer place wherein to hide. Both of them were American pilots whose ship chruised near the beach of Kaslagan.
- 15 Dec. 1944 killed 2 Japs at Sto Nifio who stayed confiscating foodstuffs of civilians while they were retreating southward
- 17 Dec. 1944 killed 3 Japs at Banlog found hiding in the cut of villagers.
- 19 Dec. 1944 Killed 2 Japs at Luan who were hiding in the cave of said place.
- 23 Dec. 1944 Killed 1 Jap at Sto Tomas Palauig.
- 26 Dec. 1944 Killed at Cauyan, Palauig.

- 29 Dec. 1944-2 Japs killed at Baylog.
- 1 Jan. 1945-Rushing to Luan to spy the movements of Japs while being raided by 2nd bombing of US Planes in this town and as result we were able to kill 20 while they were running for safety.
- 2 Jan. 1945-Sabotaging all cargoes of Jap Vessel and at the same time burning partially damage wooden vessel.
- 4 Jan. 1945-Sabotaging all cargoes of Jap Vessel damage by US Planes near the shore of Boto-boto and killed 10 Japs running for rescue.
- 10 Jan. 1945- 3 Killed at Zalasa while they were retreating Southward.
- 20 Jan. 1945-1 Jap pretending to be a doctor was killed at Sto. Niffo, Palauig.
- 2 Feb. 1945- Special envoy together with Capt. AZURIN, Sector Commander, went to meet the American Forces that landed at the shore of San Narciso, Zambales.
- 5 February 1945- Mopping up operation in remote forest so as to wipe out every Japanese disturbing the peace and tranquility of civilians.
- 15 Feb. 1945- 2 Japanese killed at Mabalacat, Palauig.
- 27 Feb. 1945- Meeting US Petty Boat at Loc-loc-balite, Palauig, under the command of Lt. McGOWEN.
- 28 Feb. 1945-5 killed at Bulawan, Palauig.
- 5 March 1945- Detailing Out Post guards in the camps of Capt. Wayne Sandefur, of "L" Co. 152nd Inf. 2nd Bn.
- 6 March 1945- some of our men went on Patrol with "L" Co. 152nd Inf; to Dampay and Salaza, Palauig.
- 7 March 1945 - Detailing Bridge Guards for "L" Co. 152nd Inf. 2nd Bn.
- 28 March 1945- Together with US Army soldiers we killed approximately 250 Japs at sitio Malamios, Salaza, Palauig.
- 29 March 1945- 1 killed at Maguisguis. (Jap)
- 1 April 1945- 7 killed at Maguisguis. (Jap)
- 19 April 1945- 3 Japs killed at Titon, Palauig.
- 21 April 1945- 9 Japs killed at Binangbangan, Palauig, Zambales.
- 22 April 1945- 4 Japs killed at Kaslagan, Palauig, Zambales.
- 23 April 1945- 1 Jap killed at Cauyan, Palauig, Zambales.
- 25 April 1945- 3 Japs killed at Titon, Palauig, Zambales, captured 1 saber, and a .45 caliber pistol handed over to the Headquarter, and five were killed at Kapataan.
- 27 April 1945-2 Japs were killed at Cauyan, Palauig, Zambales.
- 1 May 1945 - 2 were captured and turned at Headquarter.
- 2 May to date- still doing Mopping up operations.

The foregoing activities were accomplished in spite of inadequate arms, as in most cases we used only native bolos. Other minor activities worth mentioning were the warning of civilians to avoid mingling with Japanese soldiers, advising them to keep all their domestic animals and personal properties far from the reach of the Japanese soldiers in order to avoid confiscation by the latter, and doing espionage work against the enemy.




