SUBJECT: ORDER OF ACTIVITIES

TO: THE COMMANDING GENERAL, U. S. ARMY
APO 707 AFWSPEC

On the first week of February 1946, the first platoon of Company D, San Marciso sector was admitted to work for the 17th Platoon, 595 Air Warning Battalion, under 1st Lt. Herbert Brown, by that time stationed at Boddang, San Marciso, Zembales. This platoon helped in the erection of their tents, and in securing materials such as bamboos and woods for the building of the officers' quarter and supply rooms. From that time on, this platoon has done patrol and guard duty at the camp and radar station, near the vicinity of the camp, and at the same time some members helped as workers in the kitchen, at the officers' quarter, at the medical tent, at the motor pool, and in other tents. Around the months of April and May this platoon with some members of the 17th platoon, 595 Air Warning Battalion went, from time to time, to Furocawa, Forac, within the town of Botolan, Zembales, to attack the Japanese camp in that place and also to get boards, posts, and iron roofings, which the Japanese had confiscated from the neighboring towns. These woods and roofings were later made into recreation hall and dining room for the 17th Platoon. This platoon of Company D, during its attachment to the 17th platoon had done its best in maintaining peace and order of the neighboring places. Banditry and rustling were stopped, the disturbance of peace and order by undesirable elements were stopped due to the constant patrol of this platoon during the day and night. The 17th platoon did not undergo any hardship in securing supplies and manual labor due to the good cooperation of this platoon.

The recommendation given to the 1st platoon Company D, thru long and faithful service by 1st. Lt. FROMME, then commanding officer of the 17th Platoon, 595 Air Warning Battalion, was taken by Capt. Andres Padrigo and Capt. Benedicto Evangelista of Squadron C, Magsaysay's Forces with the understanding that the said Captains should worked first for the recognition of this platoon, prior to any other company of their organization. It was by means of that recommendation, which they used so cleverly, and unscrupulously for the recognition of other companies, striking out the names of the members of this platoon from their rosters. Would such anomalies and deception and treachery go without investigation and examination leaving the rightful owner without recognition and without reward? Would Capt. Padrigo and Capt. Evangelista with other officials go without being investigated in using such certification for their own material greed and personal and financial benefits leaving this platoon who had earnestly, faithfully, and diligently earned such recommendation, groping in the dark?

It is true that Capt. Padrigo and Capt. Evangelista with the members of other companies, worked in Makinaya, Subic, Zambales, but they were not labor battalion under the name of the gubrillas. They worked there in Subic as PCAU laborers, receiving their daily wages and rations as set aside by the PCAU office. I could not see any reason why these officers could lay claim to a certain certification without working for it even for a day.

Hence we the undersigned request and demand an investigation of this matter so that the rightful owner of such certification and not the usurper be justly benefited.
