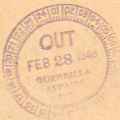

Sirs:

A certain Lieut. Edora, a personnel of the Zambales Military District, appears recognized in the Castillejos Sector roster as lieutenant with a terminal date. He also appears in the approved initial roster of the Palanig Sector as sergeant. In view of which, I have the honor to request that the rank of subject personnel should carry be first determined before payment of any salary due him be made to prevent complications. I understand there is a rule in the Auditing Section, Philippine Army, which provides that when a guerrilla personnel is carried in two approved rosters with different ranks, the roster wherein he is contained with a lower rank is given preference.

This is being submitted, as payment might be given to the personnel herein mentioned without the fact being known that he is carried in one approved roster as sergeant and in another approved roster as lieutenant.

An anonymous letter of complaint, undated against several officers and hundreds of enlisted men of the CASTILLEJO SECTOR & the SAN MARCELINO SECTOR Magsaysay's Grla Forces, ZMD who are ~~being~~ included in the recognized rosters of subject units when they are fake grlas. During the Japanese Occupation they collaborated with the enemies in the construction of airstrip, supplied them with materials, etc. Complainant says that their recognition as grlas of subject unit is a mystery. Taking Melecio Laureta as an example, in 1942 he was just roaming with the Umayá people & at times would join the cattle rustlers. During the occupation he collaborated with the Japanese as a Provincial Supervisor of the neighborhood and a Superintendent of the Kalibapi. From Feb - Mar 1946 he had been going from one grla unit to another asking them to include his name in their rosters but was turn down. A few weeks before the election he received his eight months grla pay for the period from Feb 1945 - Sept 1945. Several others got paid while the real grlas up to the present date haven't been recognized.

Sir :- In the name of justice and in behalf of the Government of the United States of America, we suggest that there must be a rigid and careful investigation of the true status of some guerrilla officers in Zambales province, to find out the true or genuine guerrilleros who deserve to be paid and those who are fake ones. We know many people who are guerrilleros in name in the rosters (recognized) who were already paid and some who are not yet paid and, we know also many who are true and loyal guerrilleros and have not been paid because they were not included in the rosters prepared and presented for recognition by Sector Commanders in Zambales District; some Sector Commanders have excluded those who are not their co-party in the political arena, and those who are not close to them, they took off their names from the rosters altho they are true loyal, and sincere guerrilleros and have sacrificed much for the common cause and they substituted them with those very closed friend close relatives, such as wives, sons, daughters, compadres and favorites even though they are not guerrilleros and were only hiding and sitting in their homes, nor have even given help to those true guerrilleros in the mountains. These kind of people were only listed and recommended for recognition for the sake of GOOD MONEY. There remedy is as follows: A sector Commander or a high officer in a certain Sector or municipality, to dissimulate he asks the Sector Commander in other locality to include his wife's name, his son or brother or his favorite in his roster and vice versa. This is the reason why there are so many women, ladies and very old men in the recognized rosters and many of them are collaborators and buy and sell and profiteers. This is true in all the towns not only in Zambales but in all the provinces in the country. It is regrettable but it is a fact and true. There are many guerrilleros and guerrilleros who should not be paid because they do not deserve it and there are many who were not paid even a single centavo up to this present date who deserve to be paid altho they nearly lost their lives and the lives of their dear family.

We know one by the name of Melecio Laurita who was a collaborator of the Japanese. He was a Provincial Supervisor of the Japanese Neighbourhood and Superintendent of the Kalibapi. If you want to verify the truth of this assertion or information you can find this fact in the offices of the Provincial Governor and Provincial Treasurer of Iba, Zambales, or ask informations from the mayors of all the municipalities of Zambales, in the years of 1943 -1944, they will surely tell the truth. - Now, this fellow, Melecio Laurita was recognized as a guerrillero in Castillejos Sector, and was paid as such in the same Sector, while he is not a member of that Sector. We know personally Melecio Laureta and the whole peoples of San Narciso and San Marcelino, Zambales, know him, that he was never attached to Castillejos Sector, that he was only ~~roaming~~ roaming with the Umaya people in 1942 and sometimes goes with the cattle rustlers, then he was appointed Supervisor of Neighborhood in the province. The recognition of Melecio Laureta as a Guerrilla is very surprising and mysterious. On February, 1946 until the middle of March, ultimo, he (Melecio Laureta) was not yet included to any roster, we know this fact because at that time he was too sad and sorrowful, he was requesting the Sector Commander of San Marcelino to include him in his roster but he was rejected because he was not really a member; he again went to the Sector Commander of San Narciso to have his name included in his roster, still he was rejected and then went to the Commanding officer of the Commando Troop of Paite, he was not admitted either; but few weeks before the last elections it was known that he was already recognized as a Captain in Castillejos Sector, later after the elections he was telling to the people of San Marcelino that he has already received his pay for eight months, that is, from February to September, 1945 This is very unjust, how come that he was paid that salary when we know positively that he never render service in the Army since the landing of the Americans in Zambales until he was appointed Acting Mayor of San Marcelino. He was not even called to either San Marcelino Airstrip nor in Porac Camp nor in any detachment of Philippine Army. If you want to get the truth of this information you send

an investigator to San Marcelino, Castillejos and San Narciso and get informations from the guerrilla officers thereto except Cat. A. Francisco and Capt. Sixto Cacho because these officers must be the ones who manipulated the recognition of Melecio Laureta, they are the leaders and campaigners of Congressman Magsaysay. We suspect that the name of Melecio Laureta was inserted in one of those first recognized rosters in Castillejos Sector or they might have erased one name of an officer or an enlisted man and substituted it with the name of Melecio Laureta. Why is it that, he was not yet recognized on February until the middle of March, 1946 and then it came out that he was recognized and paid from February 1945 to September 1945? And we know that there were some supplementary rosters submitted prior and long ahead in which the names of deserving guerrilleros are included have not as yet acted upon until the present time. Here is one reason more, Melecio Laureta was a strong leader and supporter of the candidacy of Mr. Agustin Medina one of the opponent of Major Magsaysay, and President Osmeña's leader too. We hereby certify that also that Melecio Laureta has been a strong opponent of Major Magsaysay and campaign manager of Agustin Medina long before the elections until the middle of March, 1946, but it is a surprising and mysterious as we have said before, he (Melecio Laureta) become one of the leaders of Major Magsaysay five days before the day of the elections. If you want to have this statements approved let one investigator go to San Marcelino and confer with one Mr. Gerino Alvarez and with all the prominent men there and you will get the truth.

In Zambales we know that there were many officers and enlisted men who surrendered to the Japanese. These men should not be paid their back pay if there will be any back pay. We do not know only all their names but we can mention some those whom we know personally, as follows: Captains Hilario Hilario, Teddoro Montalla, De Castro and Lt. Bundañg all of Iba, Capt. Peregrino of Cabangan, Capt. T. Corpus of Palawig; Venancio Rodriguez, Cat. Eianing Rodriguez; Capt. Oliva, Capt. Peding Piga, Capt. Soria all of San Marcelino; all the officers of San Narciso except Captains Cawagas and Ramos with hundreds of enlisted men and all officers and some hundreds of enlisted men of San Antonio. The Castillejos officers and enlisted men have cooperated with the Japs in constructing the Airstrip of the enemy at San Marcelino and Castillejos. Some were contractors in the construction of buildings some were contractors of enties and some were contractors of materials such as bamboos and cogon or nipa some officers of San Marcelino too have been contractors like one Lt. Zacarias Beltran and Cirilo Peñgue.

Sir, if the investigator to come is an impartial, just and cannot be influenced by dancing and drinking or good time very sure, all the informations stipulated above shall come out true. But we are very sorry that we can not set our signatures because we are afraid, you know those people concerned and affected will get mad and they are vindictives, we are afraid to lose our heads yet.

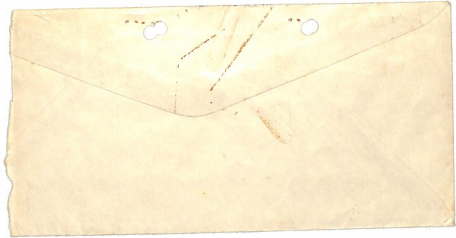
