MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

Lt Col Hugh L. Carnahan:

1. The supplementary rosters of "Companies A and B, Commando Troops, San Felipe Sector, Magsaysay's Guerrilla Forces, Zambales Military District" under the nominal control, of 1st Lt Jose Carino consisting of 227 officers and men were not favorably considered for recognition.

2. Basis for non-recognition:

- a. Adequate records were not maintained (names, ranks, dates of enlistment or joining, dates of promotion, and necessary related information.)
- b. Some members of the unit did not devote their entire effort to military activities in the field to the exclusion of normal civilian occupation and family obligations. They were not full time guerrillas. They operated in the different towns by terrorizing the civilians, stealing from them and demanding to be supported by the guerrillas of the lowlands.
- c. Record of service was not substantiated by sufficient acceptable evidence. There is insufficient evidence to show that the above unit acted as a military organization either before the American occupation or after.
- d. Names appear on the Santa Cruz roster that also appear on the above roster.
- e. 127 officers and men of this unit have previously been recognized under the command of Captain Trivias.

Dear Mr. Carino:

The Commanding General has directed that you be informed that the supplementary rosters of Co's A and B, Commando Troops, Nagasayay's Forces, Zambales Military District, purporting to be guerrilla organization under your nominal control, are not favorably considered for recognition as elements of the Philippine Army.

A set of general requirements for guerrilla recognition, established by General MacArthur during the liberation of the Philippines, has been used as a guide in considering the record of this unit. After careful investigation and full consideration of all available substantiating records and testimony of witnesses having pertinent knowledge, recognition of this guerrilla unit is not deemed to be warranted because of reasons mentioned below:

1. CONDUIT. Adequate records were not maintained, (names, ranks, dates of enlistment or joining, dates of promotions, and necessary related information).

2. MILITARY SERVICE. Some members of the unit did not devote their entire effort to military activities in the field to the exclusion of normal civilian occupation and family obligations.

SUGEL AND COMPANY OF GUERRILLA ELEMENTS.

3. RECORDS OF SERVICE WAS NOT SUBSTANTIATED BY SUFFICIENT ACCEPTABLE EVIDENCE.

4. RECORDS OF SERVICE ON THE PART OF SUGEL AND COMPANY OF GUERRILLA ELEMENTS WAS NOT SUBSTANTIATED BY SUFFICIENT ACCEPTABLE EVIDENCE. It is considered that the previous recognition of approximately 17 officers and men of the San Patricio Sector, Nagasayay's Forces, who were recognized by the Commanding General, MacArthur, for their aid during the liberation of the Philippines, constitutes adequate and just acknowledgement of military service. It is found that following the situation, sufficient evidence was obtained and verified. It is felt that this first recognition, was obtained in accordance with the provisions of Executive Order No. 66, by the President of the Philippines, dated 26 September 1944, very satisfactorily.

5. RECORDS OF SERVICE WERE NOT SUBSTANTIATED BY SUFFICIENT ACCEPTABLE EVIDENCE.



Report on the
"Commando Troops, San Felipe Sector
Magsaysay's Guerrilla Forces, Zambales Military District (ZMD)"

In accordance with verbal instructions from Chief of Section Guerrilla Affairs G-3, AFWESPA, Lieutenant Morris S. Flory on 12 July 1946 proceeded to San Felipe, Zambales to contact the "Commando Troops San Felipe Sector, Magsaysay's Guerrilla Forces, Zambales Military District (ZMD)", in order to determine whether or not this organization should be recognized by the United States Army. The following report is a summary of the investigation and basis for the recommendation.

ALLEGED HISTORY

The unit was first organized in August 1942 under the leadership of Captain Trivias, who gathered together men from the different sectors of the ZMD. The unit became known as "Commando Troops, San Felipe Sector". They acted as a Special Group, stayed in the mountains and were seldom active in the towns or lowlands outside of obtaining food and weapons. They claim to have furnished patrols and guards for the different towns and Barrios and were supported by the Guerrillas and civilians of the lowlands by contributions of food and clothing, sometimes by donations and sometimes by appropriations.

The unit consisted of approximately 150 men up to August of 1944. In September 1944 the unit was enlarged to approximately 375 members when dissention broke out between leaders of the unit, the organization split up into 2 factions. Captain Trivias remained leader of the original group, designating his unit as "Commando Troops Number One" while 1st Lieutenant Jose Carino became leader of the other faction designating his unit as "General Service Troops" but later in 1944 they changed their name to "Commando Troops Number Two". The unit under Carino was composed mostly of men from San Narciso, San Felipe and San Antonio Sectors, consisting of 2 companies, A and B, with a reported strength of approximately 225 members. Their headquarters was established in the Barrio of Manbaqui near San Felipe.

The primary activities of the unit were guarding the Barrios and towns. They also claim to have supported the 38th Division in the fight for Zigzag Pass.

FINDINGS

The following named persons are those interviewed by the contact team and their statements are the basis for the findings:

1. 1st Lt. Jose Carino - CO of subject unit
2. 2nd Lt. Pedro Robles - Ex off of subject unit
3. Mr. Fontillas - Paete Mt Troops, resident of San Narciso
4. Mrs. Fentillas - Paete Mt Troops, American
5. Capt Favia - recognized member of San Narciso Sector
6. Capt Decano - Ex off of Merrill
7. Capt Francisco Gayaban - Botolan Sector (recd)
8. Capt Lazaro Cawagas - CO of San Narciso Sector

9. Capt Manglicmost - CO San Felipe Sector
10. Capt Menuel Barretto - CO Maloma Sector
11. Sgt Bulalio Guerrero - Co B of subject unit
12. Cpl Tomas Aquino - Co B of subject unit
13. Modesto Adamos - 2nd Lt Co A of subject unit
14. Cpl Marial Feria - Co A of subject unit

Upon investigation it was found that the "Commando Troops Number Two" did not act as a military organization. According to the statements of Mr. & Mrs. Fontillas, Filipino resident of San Narciso and his American wife, the unit was a bandit organization whose chief activity was preying upon the civilians by looting, robbing and terrorizing them. According to civilians in the area, Jose Carino, the nominal leader of this group is still considered a bandit but gets by because he is a nephew of Captain Gawagas, the commanding officer of the "San Narciso Sector."

The unit was never organized until after the first bombing of Luzon by the Americans in September 1944, at which time they were known as "General Service Troops". When the Japanese were retreating through their Sector to Zigzag Pass the members of the unit went into hiding and did not return until American domination of the area was assured.

Several members whose names appear on the roster were connected with the Japanese PC and were paid for their services.

They do not claim attachment but say they worked with the 151st Infantry, 38th Division from 29 January 1945 to 31 March 1945, then under the command of Captain James Hankinson but have no papers to prove such claim. If they did work with the 151st Infantry, it was probably in the capacity of laborers.

Several names of subject unit also appear on the Santa Cruz Sector roster.

It is concluded that the members of this organization did not have full time status as a guerrilla, they claim no active resistance to the Japanese and what activities they were engaged in were more against the civilians than the enemy.

127 members of the "Commando Troops Number One" under the command of Captain Trivias have previously been recognized.

It is believed that members of the "Commando Troops Number Two" under 1st Lt. Jose Carino, worthy or recognition have been recognized under Captain Trivias.

POLITICAL ASPECTS

This unit does not appear to have any political affiliations or aspirations.

RECOMMENDATIONS

After careful consideration of the statements made by the present members and an analysis of the documents presented it is recommended that with the exception of those members previously recognized, the "Commando Troops, San




