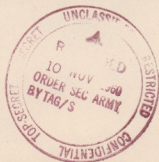

Receipt is acknowledged of roster submitted to this office 18 May 1946, for the "Sawang Mountain Troops, Zamboales Military District."

Special press release from Public Relations Office AFWESPAC dated 1 February 1946, stated that no application for recognition of guerrilla units will be accepted by this headquarters after 15 March 1946. This press release was widely circulated by newspapers and broadcast over local radio stations.

Your request for recognition of the Sawang Mountain Troops, Zamboales Military District (supplementary rosters) was personally delivered to this headquarters 15 May 1946 and does not meet deadline referred to in paragraph 2 above.

It is considered generally that all concerned have had ample opportunity to prepare applications for recognition. In the opinion of this headquarters your request is not adequately justified and therefore is not favorably considered.





Subject: Recognition of Aglao Mountain Guerrilla Troops

To: Commanding General, AFPAC.

1. It is earnestly recommended that the Guerrilla Forces organized at AGLAO under Capt. Dalmacio Rodriguez, and at SAWANG under Capt. Pam Melicia, both in the municipality of San Marcelino, Zambales, be recognized as loyal pro-American troops that rendered a great amount of faithful service to our cause.

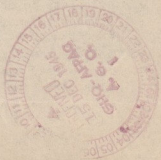
2. I and a number of other Americans made our headquarters in these localities during the period 22 Sept. 1942 until 18 Feb. 1945, and I have personal knowledge of the unswerving loyalty of these people in protecting the lives of many escaped Americans, of their unselfish aid in supplying us with food and other necessities, and of their great assistance in fighting the Japanese and supplying information that was valuable to our forces.

3. By means of the assistance given by Capt. Dalmacio Rodriguez of Aglao, and the men under his command, it was possible for me to maintain contact by courier with other American officers in Pampanga and thereby co-ordinate the activities of guerrilla groups in affording protection and subsistence to Air Corps personnel shot down over central Luzon, as well as to American, British and Dutch refugees who had escaped from the Japanese. At no time was the loyalty of Capt. Dalmacio Rodriguez in doubt, and I have full confidence in the accuracy of any roster that he may submit containing the names of the men under his command during the period mentioned in Par.2. Their aid saved many American lives.

4. Captain Pam Melicia is the chieftain of the tribe of Negritos residing in Sewang. In May or June, 1942, Major Claude A. Thorp, O-15101, Capt. Ralph McGuire, CE, and other Americans including PFC George M. McCarthy, Jr. 20645234, came to Sewang and were given help and protection for a number of weeks. At that time Maj. Thorp organized this tribe as guerrillas and they remained 100% loyal thruout the Jap occupation, in spite of many attempts by the Japs to obtain their surrender. On 2 April 1943, I was forced to retreat from sitio Ibad of barrio Aglao, due to raids by the Japanese. Captain Pam Melicia and a number of his men came to where I was and escorted me to Sewang and gave me and two other Americans complete protection from then until the fall of 1944 when it was possible to move back to Aglao. During this time Captain Pam Melicia was subjected to numerous attempts by both the Japs and by a few Filipino collaborationists to obtain his surrender, but he and his men remained steadfast in their loyalty to Americans. For 24 days in Sept., 1943, Sewang was under siege by 62 Japanese troops and 80 B.C.s who were collaborating with them. Captain Pam Melicia was given the opportunity of surrendering to the Japs and thereby obtaining amnesty and supplies but he scoffed at their offers and with only 18 firearms plus bows and arrows he would have attacked the 142 well-armed men had I not advised caution. Thru the help of some of the loyal Filipinos of Aglao, a face-

saving plan for the Japs was finally adopted which resulted in their withdrawing without casualties on our side. Later these loyal Negritos were instrumental in carrying messages to the Mt. Pinatubo guerrillas under Lt. Conner, and in eliminating many Japanese who were attempting to escape south after the landing of our troops at Lingayen. I can state positively that at least 3 Americans would either have died of starvation or been captured by the Japs had it not been for the help given by Captain Pam Melicia and his tribe.

5. I would further recommend the approval of any roster submitted by Capt. (or Major) Ramon Magsaysay of Zambales, as I have full confidence in his integrity.

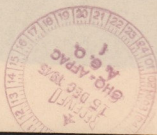

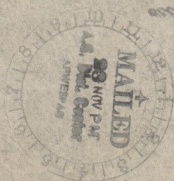
3. It is desired that payment of this unit for the period above specified, by Finance Officers of the Philippine Army, be expedited.

In accordance with verbal instructions from Chief of Section, Guerrilla Affairs Section, U. S. Army Training Group, AFWESPAC, APO 500, Lt Middleton contacted the SAWANG MOUNTAIN TROOPS under the command of PAMALECIO SURIA, Captain (guerrilla rank).

On June 6, 1942, Pamalecio Suria was the chieftain of 2,000 negritos and was appointed Captain of all Negritos or Balingas in the Sawang district by Capt R. McGuire under the authority of Lt Col Thorpe. Suria did not form a military organization. He did carry on what is considered tribal warfare against the Japanese. Patrols harassed small groups of Japanese to such an extent that the mountainous district of Sawang was unsafe for any Japanese.

Suria gave shelter, food and protection to an American sergeant and two American officers. One of the American officers, G. Merrill, Colonel (Cav) GSC, U. S. Army wrote a letter to Suria which is hereby extracted in part:

"My very dear Captain;

"For more than a year and a half you have been the commander of the troops that have afforded protection to myself and other Americans, during the most difficult part of the period between the fall of Bataan and the liberation of the Philippines. You and your men and officers have always been on the alert to keep danger away from us, and have provided food and shelter at times when they were sorely needed. This unswerving loyalty to us and the United States calls for the highest praise that can be given and it is my most ardent wish that this devotion shall be properly and fully recognized by our government.

Actually this unit would not have applied directly to AFPAC for recognition if their roster of 186 men had been included in the ones prepared by the Hqs ZAMBALES MILITARY DISTRICT under Major Ramon Magsaysay. In fact because the original roster had been cut and the ranks changed, Pamalecio Suria was on the verge of open warfare with certain Rodriguez of the San Marcelino unit. A "safe conduct" back into the mountains for Suria and 5 bodyguards from Lt Middleton induced him to come to a conference at the 14 AA Command. Col Olvis and his Provost Marshal, Rodriguez' son, Rodriguez' brother (S-4 of Magsaysay),

a provincial official, an interpreter and Lt Middleton were present. Col Olvis stated that in the interests of peace and order there would be no necessity of feuding or need of "safe conducts". Peace was declared by all parties. The S-4 of Magsaysay was asked to make sure that the entire 164 men were put on a roster thru channels. The rank of captain for Suria was demanded and all other ranks were to be at the discretion of Magsaysay.

The negritos have a record of over 500 dead Japs during 1945. They were given weapons and rations by the 152nd Infantry. Several people in San Marcelino stated that Suria's guerrilla activities were the most effective of any unit in the area.

The negritos are mountain people that are inclined to distrust the educated Filipinos, yet they appear intensely loyal to the Americans.

No political aspects were uncovered during the investigation.

RECOMMENDATION

1. This unit of 186 men should be recognized thru the Zambales Military District.
2. These men should be processed in the military area on the outskirts of San Marcelino and allowed to return to the mountains in the shortest possible time.
3. Recognition order should state that these men will bring all U. S. Army weapons in for surrender when they are processed.
4. Recommend that original date of organization be 1 June 1942 and that recognition be granted from 1 March 1945 to 31 August 1945.
