1. The attached basic correspondence brings to attention the fact that the officer mentioned is among several who have taken dangerous assignments and because of their isolation are not being brought up for consideration for promotion to next higher grade as readily as may be those still in this area.

2. Lieut. Anas completed a grueling period of training with commendable efficiency. His initial mission to deliver stores, equipment and personnel to the Sixth M.B. in 1943 was carried out without a hitch. He has since been operating in the area as a Coast Watcher District Supervisor.

3. Lieut. Anas has ranked as first lieutenant since August, 1942. Prior to his service with A.I.B., he had ten months at an advanced base in New Guinea with the Transportation Corps and his record there appears to have been quite satisfactory.

4. It is felt that in view of his long service and his proved value to the Philippine effort, consideration should be given to recommending him to promotion to the next higher grade.
