Report on Beath of Captain Albert Eiteben

l. In accordance with the attached request from Erc. E. S. Kitchen, 1885 South Harvard Mivés, Les Angeles, 6, Calif., I am submitting a statement covering the circumstances of the status, death and burial of her sen, Captain Albert Kitchen, in the Philippines.

2. Albert Kitchen was in Cobu, Philippines at the outbreak of war, and immediately volumbeared his services to the Army. He was attached to a demolition squad in sivilian especity. Application was made by Col. John C. Gook, communing the Cots Advance Quarternatter Depot, to the Constading Seneral on Corrugidor for consissions for several of us. In Pobruary the examinations were approved, and Eitches was advised about Pobymany Bith that he had been counterionid a Captain, At that time he had been transferred from the demplition ogued to the position of V.S. Army Strongport Service officer in charge on the S. S. MAYON. It was by more chance that I did not hold that position myself, an it had been assignof to me, but on the mersing of the assignment I was out on a despition job and Mitches was assigned to toke my place a few minutes before the yessel left Cobs for on assistance in Mindeman. I proceeded to Mindeman to relieve him on the Mayon, but received orders on the fitch of Pebruary that Captain Kitchen was to remain on the Hayes and I was to return to Cobus On the 26th of Pebruary, at about 1420, the Japanese made a consustrated air attack on all shipping along the Mindanse coast, hambing and sinking the vessel on which I was waiting to return to Cobu. Two planes attacked the Mayon at anchor in Masipit Marbor, Agusan Prevince, scoring two direct hits and several misses. The vessel burned for two days, with the loss of eleven lives. The charred bedies of all eleven were recovered, Captain Kitchen's body boing identified by the number of the curtematic pistel he was weering. He was buried with military benefs in the cometery at Batuan, Agusen Province. As Army Bransport Service Courations Officer in Mindones, I made a full report on the matter which I outsitted to S.S.A.T.S. Headquarters in Cobs, when I returned to that port with the survivors.

5. It is requested that official notification of his doubt be made to his nother, through War Regardment channels.




