1. Following is a paraphrase of a message just received from the 10th M.D., Philippines.

"REQUEST THAT STATUS OF ROBERT K. GENTRI ASN 6569572, STAFF SGT M.C. BE CLARIFIED. HE WAS DISCHARGED ON 16 APRIL 1942 TO ACCEPT APPOINTMENT AS SECOND LIEUTENANT M.A.C. PERMANENT ENLISTMENT RECORD SO ENDORSED AT CEBU UPON ORDERS OF CHENOWETH. NO SERIAL NUMBER ASSIGNED. ASSIGNED COMPANY COMMANDER 11 NOV 1942. PROMOTED TO FIRST LIEUTENANT 1 JULY 1943, TRANSFERRED TO INFANTRY. OFFICER HAS AN EXCELLENT RECORD."

2. If your records do not disclose anything to confirm the above statements, it is suggested that the War Department be queried as to just how solid is carried on WD records at this time.
