1. Recommend that approval be given to promotion in the Philippine Army of the following named Area Commanders:

To Be Colonel

Lieut. Col. Ruperto K. Kangleon, 1059, Inf., P.A.

To Be Lieut. Colonel

Major Salvador Abcede, 01520, P.A.

2. Colonel KANGLEON is the senior officer in point of service of the Philippine Army on active duty. The promotion indicated is not only merited in the light of his service in command of the LEYTE Area Command, but it would inspire him the better to meet the tests ahead and strengthen his leadership over the LEYTE forces through the increased recognition and prestige thereby gained.

3. Major ABCEDE for "face" has held the guerilla grade of Lieut. Colonel since his assumption of command of the 7th Military District. He still, however, holds the grade of Major in the Philippine Army. He has done a splendid job in the exercise of his command. The intelligence he has sent in is detailed and reliable and his organization for the reception of supplies is superior to that of any other area. In such activity submarine commanders have given him highest commendation.

4. Herewith is action sheet designed to give effect to these recommendations if approved.
