1. In accordance with AR 600-45 and USAFFE Regulations 10-50 the following Officer, Capt Howell S. Kopp 0386137, 5217th Rcn Bn Prov is hereby recommended for the BRONZE STAR, posthumously, authority for mission was LO FEKE 289.6 220.453 and 284.8 Hq USAFFE dated 14 and 15 Sep 44.

2. Capt Howell S Kopp volunteered for hazardous duty in enemy occupied territory and while enroute to his designated area lost his life. All members of the submarine party of the "SEAWOLF" were mercilessly killed and had no chance to escape.

3. I personally knew Capt Howell S Kopp and testify to his excellent performance prior to departure for this mission.
