

- 2. He appears to be better than the average Filipino officer and has enjoyed the full confidence of Colonel SUAREZ (Hammer). There is no place for a 3rd Lieut. Philippine Army in our Filipino organisation and in practice such men have been commissioned in the corresponding grade (2nd Lieut.) in the AUS and placed on active duty.
