

1. Third Lieutenant Konglam TEO, Philippine Army, Res., was on board the NARWHAL at TAWITAWI when she was recently forced to crash dive to avoid enemy action. As a consequence Lieutenant TEO came out as an involuntary passenger.

2. He appears to be better than the average Filipino officer and has enjoyed the full confidence of Colonel SUAREZ (Hammer). There is no place for a 3rd Lieut. Philippine Army in our Filipino organization and in practice such men have been commissioned in the corresponding grade (2nd Lieut.) in the AUS and placed on active duty.

3. This matter has not been previously referred to the Chief of Staff.

4. No original documents are available to furnish USAFFE.

1. It is recommended that 3rd Lieut. Konglam TEO, Inf., Phil. Army, who arrived here recently from the Philippines be commissioned as 2nd Lieutenant in the AUS, and assigned to the 5217th Reconnaissance Battalion.

2. He claims to have been commissioned as 3rd Lieutenant in the Phil. Army Reserves in July 1939, and was called to active duty 25 August 1940. He served during the Philippine campaign with the 71st Infantry and has since been connected with the unsundered units in Sulu.
