

Becker APO 500 22 November 1944 My dear Becker: I have just recently learned of the message you endeavored to get through to the Commander in Chief a week or so ago containing obscene language wholly unbecoming an American soldier - to say nothing of a noncommissioned officer. Had I been present at Hollandia at the time that message came through, which fortunately was not written up by the cryptographic section, I should have immediately taken steps to have you broken to the grade of private and relieved of your responsibility. As other action however was taken by Major Telesco in my absence I shall not pursue the matter further at this time but in future should you exhibit similar characteristics of obscene and disrespectful language to the Commander in Chief or any superior officer over you, you may be assured of drastic action against you in the premises. I realize, of course, the difficulties of your present service. ties, nome others, however, have shown that they could not master such difficulties with the dignity and self control, befitting the American soldier, desired in the discharge of important responsibilities. I AM IN RECEIPT OF YOUR MESSAGE OF AUGUST SIXTH COMPLAINING THAT CONTACT BY KAZ WITH YOUR STATION WAS NOT ESTABLISHED ON FOURTH AND FIFTH AND THE MATTER IS UNDER INVESTIGATION BY THE CHIEF SIGNAL OFFICER (GENERAL MACARTHUR TO CORPORAL WILLIAM BECKER THIRD) I UNDERSTAND THE DIFFICULTIES OF YOUR POSITION AND EVERYTHING POSSIBLE WILL BE DONE TO ENSURE PROMPT RECEPTION OF YOUR REPORTS WHICH ARE OF GREAT VALUE, BUT DESIRE THAT IN THE FUTURE PRESENTATION OF SUCH MATTERS YOU ENDEAVOR TO EXERCISE THE PATIENCE AND DISCIPLINED RESTRAINT EXPECTED OF US AS SOLDIERS AND WITHOUT WHICH DUTY CANNOT BE WELL DONE.

If this weather information is important as I think it is and you say it is them it deserves proper handling. It is getting just that on this end, if one radio set and good operators cannot be devoted to appointed frequency at the appointed times we may as well stop running and hiding. No contact all day August 4th, no contact this morning, we are in perfect tune and your man does not call or does not tune, each synoptic hour we continue to call him for two hours or more. He does not even answer. I volunteered to do a job and am doing it. Let us have some cooperation. (Corporal William Becker Third.) Where the hell is Station KAZ. Those operators must be rookies. My men have eleven and five years experience respectively.

IT THIS WEATHER INFORMATION IS IMPORT ANT AS YOU SAY IT IS AND AS I THINK IT IS THEN IT DESERVES PROPER HANDLING. IT IS GETTING JUST THAT ON THIS END, IF ONE RADIO SET AND GOOD OPERATORS CANNOT BE DEVOTED TO APPOINTED FREQUENCY AT THE APPOINTED TIMES WE MAY AS WELL STOP RUNNING AND HIDING.
