

- 1. The following message (in three parts) has been received:
 - (1) No number, no date, "W-10" to MacArthur Reports on Cebu (Fenton and others).

2. Comments

(1) In order to avoid delay, I am forwarding this message without comment on personalities involved, except that we have no cards on Majors "Sanchez", "Baura" and "Jakosalem", nor upon Governors ""Abellana" and "Montelibano". The Philippine Register lists several Sanchezs. This is a very common name in the Islands but General Stivers considers it doubtful as to whether any of those listed will apply. He advises requesting further information. No "Baura" nor "Jakosalem" are listed. I am contacting Major McMicking.

Regarding "W-10's" enquiries concerning cargo of the "Fifty" Party and whether he can have a radio, I suggest that he be advised that military commanders of the district concerned were instructed concerning the disposition of the equipment and that, unless further ordered from here, he should not be concerned with it. The radios sent to 10th District were for specific purposes and would not be easily transportable to Luzon.

Regarding his question on whether GHQ approval had been given his recommendations on Fenton, Abcede, etc., it is likely that our No.23 of March 19 had not reached him prior to his transmissions to us.



Precis:

FENTON and CUSHING have done a fine job against overwhelming odds. They are entitled to encouragement - - and help when we can get it to them. But the situation, on the other hand, is somewhat delicate. In the first place, the joint command appears to be splitting up and yet the situation does not permit the recognition of either one over the other. We may be able to heal the rift. Certainly, as they are stronger united than they would be fighting each other for control, we should endeavor to do so. In the second place, there is evidence that under their command martial law has been rigidly enforced and numerous civilians executed for pro-Jap activities including persons of prominence, such as members of OSMENA's family. Situation thus suggests action guided by caution. On the other hand, the people of CEBU have and are putting up a magnificent resistance to heavy enemy pressure to pacify them. They deserve recognition for this.





PERSONAL OBSERVATIONS RE CEBU CASE. BREAK BETWEEN CUSHING AND FENTON CONFIRMED BY CUSHING HIMSELF WHO CLAIMS HE HAS ALWAYS DISAGREED WITH FENTONS RUTHLESS ANTI-COLLABORATIONIST POLICY. ASKED WHY BREAK DID NOT COME BARLIER REPLIED HE PREFERRED LESSER OF TWO EVILS AS HE FELT BREAK WOULD BE DISASTROUS. PERSONALLY DO NOT BELIEVE HE IS AFTER COMMAND AS EVIDENCED BY REPEATED REFUSAL TO DO SO AT FENTONS OFFERS DUE SENIORITY AND ALSO FACT HE REALIZES DELICACY AND DANGER IN DOING SO NOW. AGREE WITH HIM SOLUTION IMPERATIVE PARTICULARLY SINCE HE CAME AFTER NOTIFYING FENTON WHO ADVISED AGAINST IT WHICH FACT WILL UNDOUBTEDLY LEAD TO CIVIL WAR WHEN HE RETURNS. DO NOT RECOMMEND HIM FOR COMMAND AT LEAST FOR THE PRESENT FOR OBVIOUS REASONS. ALTHOUGH NEED OF FINANCIAL AID IS EVIDENTLY URGENT YET DO NOT RECOMMEND APPROVAL HIS REQUEST PRINT MONEY TILL COMMAND QUESTION IS SETTLED AS THIS MAY PUT YOUR AND PHIL GOVT IN A SPOT. COMMANDER SHOULD BE PICKED FROM LOCAL OFFICERS AS APPOINTMENT OF AN OUTSIDER WOULD BE MOST DETRIMENTAL TO MORALE AND NOT CONDUCIVE TO COOPERATION BUT DELICACY PRESENT SITUATION INCREASES DIFFICULTY IN MAKING RECOMMENDATIONS. In re CUSHING's visit to VILLAMOR

I indicated receipt of these important messages on CEBU last Friday. Since then, I have been developing such information as is available to us on the situation. It is all too meager.

Of CEBU, Commander PARSONS in his recent reports comments:

"Righth District (Cebu and Bohol): This District has been the outstanding sore spot in the guerilla movement in the Philippines. It is especially unfortunate that this district has not been handled along well directed lines as have the other districts, as it is in the hands of American leaders, and their ill-advised program has acted as a black mark on American initiative and effort in the Islands. It appears that the two American leaders of the guerilla forces - - Fenton and Cushing - have let their ideas of justice follow lines of imagination based upon the "law of the west" where executions and hanging have been indulged in considerably. The result has been a recorded list of over 100 executions of citizens for their alleged pro-Japanese activities amongst whom were several influential people - - including one son of the vice president of the Philippines. This form of judgement and justice resulted in the terrorization of the people in the free areas, and forced them to move into Cebu City to seek protection of the energy, in order to avoid the risk of running afoul of the guerilla "justice."

"Aside from the executions and resultant terrorizing of the people in the unoccupied areas, Femton and Sushing may be said to have unified all units under their joint control (they are co-commanders), and have undoubtedly bothered the enemy considerably with their aggressive warfare - - so much so that during the month of April 1943, the Japanese considered it necessary to send a substantial force of reserves to Cebu and conducted a strong campaign against the guerillas. It is reported that the men in the organization follow their leaders well, and that they have been well-trained and led. It may also be said that Fenton and Cushing undoubtedly were sincere in their ideas of executing all people whom

with reference to executions, so conspicious on Cebu and continuing there until the recent enemy campaign, does not mean to infer that none have occurred in other districts. Apparently, when the guerillas were but a series of bands roaming the country, and before their unification by the officers who have eventually taken charge (and responsibility) quits a number of killings are reported following hasty judgement on "pre-Japanese" cases, as well as extending into the killing of personal enemies in several cases. A stop was made to executions by the commanders of the guerillas forces as they were banded together into a formal organization, and districts that may qualify for recognized districts, nor in the possibly the 5th."

mountains and their organization has been disrupted by the campaign waged against them starting in April. Some of their men have evacuated and deserted to Negros and Siquijor. Fenton and Cushing expect to gather together the forces in the near future, or as soon a enemy pressure slackens. Incidentally, they have told their men that they command a recognized district and that they are in touch with Gen. MacArthur, and have received his support for their activities. In this connection, it is felt that the situation in Gebuits such that the SWPA cannot afford to recognize the district under the leadership of Fanton and Cushing nor to give recognition to the guarilla units until a new leadership may be arranged.

This is by far the most authoritative information on the subject that is available to us. To it might be added the following extracts from VILLAMOR message No. 78, dated 24 June 43:

- l. "Fenton is feared not loved by his men but Cushing well like
- 2. "Total Cebu strength (guerilla) over nine thousand men and six five three officers with almost five thousand rifles, average one hundred rds. There are seven ordnance shops put out seven thousand rds monthly. Grain shortage in south but live stock shortage all over. Troops fairly well trained particularly central area. Morale slowly sinking but loyalty unswerving. Fenton does not believe in issuing currency consequently men and goods not paid. Martial law in effect and playing ball with enemy not tolerated."

Further more, it should be pointed out that civil officials of Cebu are all under enemy control with a type of martial law enforced in the areas under guerilla control.

Guerilla action has been more aggressively offensive than in other areas and hence has been less of a stabilized character that would permit civil government under guerilla sponser and protection.

Apparently, the strong point to the guerilla movement in Cebu has been the great number of soldiers from the relatively large pre-surrender garrison that refused to surrender and instead took to the hills (note, estimate of 5,000 rifles). The shame has been that they have been under ill-advised leadership.

It may be that from the Negros conference now projected, a leader can be found who can be sent into Cebu for the purpose of assuming leadership under the blessing and policies of the C-in-C. This may be but wishful thinking, but I am hopeful that the way may open up to take full advantage of the forces and spirit that are apparently available to us in Cebu.



PERTIG in his message No. 290, 17 September, reports "CREU BEING DEVELOPED AS CENTER OF RESISTANCE WITH ENEMY FORTIFYING IN MOUNTAINS."

This message from VILLAMOR affords substantial confirmation of FERTIG's report.

It may be the purpose of the enemy to provide themselves with a strongly intrenched position in the VISAYAS - - may even indicate a complete change in enemy defensive strategy. G-2 can, of course, better evaluate the nove, but from this desk it suggests the necessity for the closest possible observation of the situation in CEBU as it develops.

We now have with VILLAMOR the extending "strong man" from CHBU, CUSHING, who apparently has the support of the loyal troops consitted to guerilla action (estimated to number 5,000 rifles), or the majority of them. He is pleading for funds with which to support the guerilla novement and recognition by General MacARTHUR of his authority to reorganize.

While his joint leadership with FENTON is answerable for past ill-advised action, I believe present policy should be shaped realistically in the light of conditions and our military requirements, foremost of which is accurate information on which 6-2 may base an evaluation of enemy intentions, plans and moves, which may preve of deep significance. I know of an one in better position to organise the requisite intelligence not to serve the purpose than CUSHING who already has the benefit of a substantial and war-tested following on the Island.

Commander PARSONS has no use for CUSHING because of his illadvised leadership and the fact that he was little more than a "beachcomber" in pre-War days and has strongly recommended against

any form of recognition of him by the C-in-C. However, there is no question of choice before us. Furthermore, our own history gives us examples of men exhibiting little strength in peace who emerge with great strength in War. Examples CRANT.

CEBU since 9 June 43 has been under the intelligence responsibility of the 7th Military District (our message to FERTIG, No. 79, 22nd June 43). However, GADOR will have his hands full reorganizing that district.

If significance is given to the developments in the enemy situation in CEBU as reported, I strongly advise the reshaping of our CEBU policy along the lines hereinafter recommended.

- 2. Transfer 8th Military District (CEBU and BOHOL) to the Commander of the 10th Military District (FERTIG) for intelligence purposes.
- h. Have FERTIG deputize CUSHING to organize cohesive intelligence net among the loyal CRBU guerillas on whom he can count for support.
- 2. Finance and equip CUSHING through FERTIG or GADOR, or both, and instruct him to radio full reports on enemy activity to FERTIG for transmission here.
- g. Instruct PERTIG to pay particular attention to the situntion, facilitate CUSHING by all possible means, and give us the benefit of any evaluation he can give to information as it is developed.

The foregoing recommendations deal only with the reshaping of policy incident to the development of intelligence. I believe in other respects existing policy should remain unchanged. If 5,000 rifles in the hands of loyal men can harass the enemy in his moves, why not? -- Even if we are unable at this time to give them support leadership or direction.



1. Attached message No. 134, 20th Sept from VILLAMOR should be considered in connection with the C-in-C's desire to find a way to send funds to CEBU without taking any position in the conflict for guerilla leadership. (See C-in-C's comment on my Action Sheet No. 658, attached)

2. Of Governor ABELLANA, VILLAMOR in his message No. 23, 23 March 43

"GOVERNOR ABELLANA ESCAPED FROM JAPS LAST JANUARY SIXTEENTH AND IS NOW WITH FENTON PD HOWEVER THERE IS NO ATTEMPT AT CIVIL GOVERNMENT AS FENTON DESIRES AND HAS COMPLETE CONTROL OF ALL ISLAND ACTIVITIES....."

And in his message No. 132, 20 Sept that:

"GOVERNOR ABELLANA OF CEBU NOW IN BOHOL WITH EIGHT OFFICERS."

Governor ARELLANA has obviously been loyal throughout and hence he is entitled to be considered in connection with any study of fiscal policy to meet the Island's requirements.

3. Civil government in CEEU having been surpressed from the start, I doubt that VILLAMOR's suggestion that QUEZON authorize the creation of a currency board would in itself be adequate, although the situation in CEBU is far from elear. For instance, in his last mentioned message VILLAMOR reported furthers

"MY MAN IN BOHOL REPORTS SANTANDER IN CEBU NOW OCCUPIED WITH INDICATION WHOLE ISLAND WILL BE OVERRUN...."

Obviously, if that report reflects the true situation, neither the Governor nor a Currency Board could function with any degree of security, if it could function at all.

- 4. However, with a loyal Governor and the leader of the guerilla forces both available to us, it should not be difficult to find a solution to meet the desires of the G-in-C in the matter.
- 5. I am rather impressed with GUSHING's anxiety and determination to get back to CEBU to work the matter out on his own authority and responsibility with the limited resources available to him. That elevates him considerably

in my estimation and reinforces my conviction that he is the one to whom we should look to keep us informed on enemy moves in CEBU.

6. I recommends

2. That arrangements be made to have both Governor ARELLANA and CUSHING proceed to FERTIG's headquarters and there, with FERTIG's advice and counsel, work out a solution for consideration of the G-in-C.

Governor ABELLANA is now looking for currency in BOHOL - - CUSHING in NEGROS - - neither one will find it as currency is about the most scarce of all commodities in the free areas of the Philippines today. Hence, the delay incident to such a conference would not adversely affect the main purpose of both to provide substantial fiscal relief for the people of CEHU.

put in an analogous position in GEBU as that held by CONFESSOR in PANAY, with headquarters either in BOHOL or MINDANAO, if it is impracticable for him to return to CEBU, and that CUSHING draw upon him for funds to support his military forces incorporated in an intelligence net, if the principle of that plan recommended by my note on VILLAMOR's message No. 132, 20 Sept (copy attached) is approved. The matter of sustaining elements of the army not employed for intelligence purposes could be made the subject of further study as the situation clarifies, or could be handled through some other experienced officer neutral as between CUSHING and FENTON. In this the advice of Governor ABELLANA would be of great value.

- 7. In the manner recommended, the C-in-C would be giving effective support to the civil authority represented in the person of Governor ABELLANA, and to the military forces represented in the person of a co-commander thereof, without being drawn into the conflict between CUSHING and FENTON.
- 8. Of course, it is possible that such a conference as that suggested would bring to light information not now before the C-in-C that would suggest a different remedy, but if it did, the conference would have well served its purpose. In fact to such a conference the C-in-C could address such questions as he desired, to give further needed clarity to the situation.
- 9. It is possible that CUSHING would be reluctant to remain longer away from his forces but if he were doing so under direct instructions from the C-in-C his prestige with the men would increase to a point to overshadow

any threat from his prolonged absence.

10. I would like too to see an opportunity for a heartening message to go from the C-in-C to those soldiers who have so long refused to surrender despite the crushing enemy pressure upon them to do so.

11. The messages to be despatched to put the recommendations herein embodied into effect would be merely, "I desire that...." etc., etc., hence would not need to be submitted for your further approval, although the message to Governor ARELLANA should contain a work of personal greating.

as the courier mail is about to close, but if the C-in-C will but authorize arranging for suggested conference at FERTIG's headquarters, we can continue studies that will, I am sure, effect a solution to his full satisfaction. In this, I will consult with Dr. HAYDEN from whom I look for much help in these matters. Meanwhile, I have wired VILLAMOR to hold CUSHING at his headquarters pending your decision in the matter.



An interesting report on CERU. You will recall that GUSHING is now emroute to FARTIG's Headquarters via CERU. In view of FENTON's reported execution, if CUSHING survives his return, it will be a good indication of his undisputed leadership over the CERU Forces. In such event, it might be worthwhile for the G-in-C to consider recognizing GUSHING as Commander of the CERU Area Command. All of our information tends to fix the primary blame for ill-considered executions on FENTON despite the co-commandership existing. The CERU forces have put of such a splendid resistance against heavy enemy pressure that some recognization by and aid from the G-in-C is due them if the situation clarifies sufficiently to reasonably permit. Leadership question would appear to bear close watching.

At the same time, it is helpful to have the name of ESTRELLA, his second in command. VILLAMOR reported to us on 23 June that he was a close advisor of CUSHING — formerly was a Captain in MINDANAO.

(We have radio contact with CEBU through ANDREES). FERTIG & PARSONS do not like CUSHING with a possible resulting tendency to usher ABELLANA out of the projected conference picture before giving adequate time for CUSHING to arrive. Further application of the old inter-guerilla suspicion and jealous rivalry. Cmdr. PARSONS sometimes shows signs of being as much guerillaised as any of them — has to be checked lest his enthusiasm for one operate to the unnecessary disadvantage of the other.

CUSHING is confronted with terrific obstacles. Yet he is showing courage, determination and complete assurance that the forces and people of CEBU will follow his leadership.

On 5 Aug 43, the C-in-C dispatched following identical message to Commanders

"FOR YOUR INFORMATION AND NECESSARY ACTION CLN CUSHING FROM CEBU ADVISES THAT AGENTS OF OTHER COMMANDERS ARE INFLUENCING HIS MEN TO LEAVE HIS COMMAND FOR SERVICE ELSEWHERE CMA POINTS OUT THAT SUCH ACTION IS UNDERMINING HIS CONTROL CMA REQUESTS APPROPRIATE REMEDIAL ACTION"

Message does not appear to be addressed to the C-in-C and I believe no action is indicated at this time. I view it of the utmost urgency that plans heretofore approved to get ABELLANA, CUSHING and FERTIG together materialise. That is the only way to transform the existing mutual distrust and suspicion into mutual understanding and cooperation with its consequent strengthening of the whole of the VISAYAN-MINDANAO area. This was proved during recent conferences between FERTIG, KANGLEON, INCINIERO, ABELLANA and LOPEZ. PARSONS reports that such conferences started off with a chilly atmosphere in which every man was obviously playing for personal position -- ended with a warmth of understanding and accord, petty differences, which had kept individuals poles apart, being quickly swept away through the opportunity thereby afforded of understanding the others' problems. Monetary allowances and other administrative matters which cause discontent, where forces in one area are believed to fare better them in enother area, were standardized -- problems of supply and communication simplified, etc., etc.

The whole situation insofar as MINDANAO and the Eastern VISAYAS was strongthened by such conferences and if the same procedure can be applied with respect to the leaders of CEBU, NECROS and PANAY, the C-in-C will have and infinitely stronger hand to play in the whole area south of LUZON. I cannot help but feel that a conference of such leaders at some time on board the NARWHAL is the answer.

I am sure that Codr. PARSONS made no such statement as that reputed to him. He may, however, have made some chance remark to the effect that the C-in-C did not condone the many executions of CEBUANOS accused of pro-enemy leanings attributed to the FENTON-CUSHING joint leader-ship, which remark, if made, may well have finally been blown up to the size reported to CUSHING. Such action, as we know, is characteristic of the Filipino and but emphasizes the need for care in statements made, especially those with color of authority from the C-in-C.

It is noted that the message from CUSHING was received by ANDREWS before the latter had opportunity to dispatch the message to CUSHING from the C-in-C insugurating the Celu Area Command and appointing CUSHING as its commander. That message was adequate to readjust the situation.

The reported inter-erea entegonism is responsive to local influences and emotions which the C-in-C's action will do much to eradicate.



Study of priorities established by CUSHING discloses that he runs true to form among PRS intelligence collecting agencies. Committed to intelligence — ammunition, gums, and more gums, get highest priority on his requisition for essential supplies needed.

CUSHING is an unusual study in himself. Showing little strength in civil life, now badly orippled by arthritis and committed to the use of crutches most of the time, his fighting spirit has dominated CEBU resistance since the surrender and his leadership over a following badly harassed by consistently superior enemy forces is remarkable. I believe he and his followers merit all assistance reasonably possible.

I have heretofore advised FERTIG to meet CUSHING's supply requirements—have dispatched on the NARWHAL 20 tons consigned for CUSHING for delivery in the area of the 10th M.D. for later transshipment. This appears to be in accord with CUSHING's recommendation as to safest procedure.

I have advised CUSHING to send signal officers to FERTIG to receive signal equipment and signal operation instructions. Have assured him of FERTIG's full cooperation.

Do not believe it necessary to bring CUSHING's officers here, but records should be dispatched to FERTIG for transshipment here at first opportunity.





CUSHING requested authority to issue bonds in view of our failure to supply him with Philippine currency. We replied that this headquarters was without authority to authorize the issuence of tonds which was primarily a legislative function and queried him for clarification as to the type of currency permitted circulation in his area.

This mescage confirms that the use of enemy script is compulsory in CEBU. We have sent in \$200,000 and will continue to send it in as the opportunity presents itself.

This message is the first direct communication from CUSHING using his own code which we furnished him - discloses that our supplies are getting through and this new channel for communication opening up satisfactorily.

Any of our other guerilla leaders would have decided this problem in the circumstances with 10 bullets without reference to this Headquarters. CUSHING has, however, before demonstrated a more disciplined regard for the will of higher authority. Such attitude may be somewhat indifferent to guerilla standards but gives rise to greater assurance of reliability from the standpoint of command. I believe you will find in CUSHING an able but still subordinate fighter and leader in whom you can fully depend to discharge his mission to the full limit of his capabilities. At the crucial time this is what you will require.

In action taken on the question raised I believe it should be assumed that the message of the C in C may reach the hands of the enemy and precentions in its phraseology taken accordingly.

The information in this report comes from Paulino GUILAS, puppet Commissioner for the VISAYAS. Its interest lies not so much in the information itself (which should be evaluated with extreme cuation) but in the source of the information). In it is disclosed the pattern of puppet reaction to the progress of the Allied counter-offensive, which pattern has long been predictable. By his act in giving this information to CUSHING, CULLAS has placed service to the Allied cause of record - a record that will serve as a defensive barrier to post war charges of tree-

By his act in giving this information to CUSHING, GULLAS has placed service to the Allied cause of record - a record that will serve as a defensive barrier to post war charges of treason. One of the leading puppet officials in the LAUREL government, could be effect his evacuation to this area, GULLAS would not only solidify that defense but avoid the retribution that will follow the start of counter-offensive operations in the Philippine area, when open season is declared by loyal Filipinos upon pre-Jap puppet officials.

That GULLAS should desire to be taken out of the Philippines at this time, while occupying so powerful and influential a position under the LAUREL government, significantly emphasizes the current view in puppet circles of the military situation and the fact that little encouragement is held out by the enemy for survival of the "Republic" under his protection.

The better to evaluate Paulino GUILAS and the position he is now taking, I am attaching hereto a copy of an address he delivered in ILOILO on 19 January 1944. The address is a masterpiece of inconsequential and noncommittal verbosity - in its careful avoidance of pro-Japanism or anti-guarillaism, although in it complete loyalty is disclosed to the LAUREL government. In describing the powers and authority of the office of Commissioner, GULLAS stated:

Powers and duties of my office. The Philippines is divided into three districts - LUZON, VISAYAS, and MINDANAO. LUZON is under the President of the Republic; VISAYAS is under the Commissioner for the VISAYAS and MINDANAO is under the Commissioner and SULU. The Commissioner shall exercise general supervision

and administrative control over the district in which he is assigned and to perform such other duties as may be assigned by the President of the Republic of the Philippines." Of the post of Commissioner for the VISAYAS, ABCEDE wired in his message number 79 of 21 Januarys "MEN LAW AUTHORIZES PUPPET PRESIDENT LAUREL TO APPOINT VICE MINISTERS FOR VISAYAS AND MINDANAO WILL FULL POWERS OF PRESIDENT IN THEIR RESPECTIVE AREAS. VISAYAS CANDIDATES ARE ILDEFONSO COSCOLLUBLA, JOSE LOGSIN, GIL MONTILIA AND LEON GUINTO, GOV, MONTELIBANO REPORTS HE CAN HAVE UNDERSTANDING WITH COSCOLLURIA OR LOCSIN BUT NEITHER WILL ACCEPT POST WITH-OUT OKAY FROM PRES. QUEZON OR FROM THAT HEADQUARTERS. DECISION REQUESTED. It will be observed that Pauline GULLAS, already appointed at the time the above message was dispatched, was not mentioned therein as a possible candidate for the office. I recommend definitely against the evacuation of GULLAS to this area. Any other course would be to invite the eventual petition of all puppet officials from LAUREL, VARGAS, ACQUING on down, for the security of that privilege before this thing is over. 






VISAYAS ON JANUARY 19, 1944, AT THE SESSION HALL OF THE PROVINCIAL BUILDING OF ILOILO

Governor and my colleague Caram, Mr. Justice Barrios, Major Tando, Officers of the Administration, Ladies and Gentlemen:

ALTER THE STREET



As I was coming here, I was reading and old issue of a newspaper in the hotel and I am going to relate to you something which I found to be very illuminating in connection with my present job.

It was a Filipine who was a member of the first bunch of Filipine pensionades that was sent to America way back in 1905 or 1906. His name was "Sapollo". He got this name because he tried to cover his black skin with sapollo in order to mingle with American girls as he loved them very much. In the class, he was known to be witty. In one occassion, the class was asked to give the meaning of the word, indisposition. Sapollo raised his right hand and answered, "when I fight, I fight in this position". And from that mement, Sapollo became the most prominent in the class.

Well, my friends, I have plenty of fight in my position. I also know that the Governor and all the municipal Mayors have plenty of fight in their hands dealing with the recalcitrant elements. There are enemies within and enemies without. The mission of the Governor and the mayors now is much difficult than before. The mission of the peace officer is also much difficult than before. Before he has to deal with men, who used belos and "balisong", but now, he has to account with men, sometimes better armed than themselves, armed with machine guns, automatic rifles and other deadly weapons.

You know, in January 1st, in Cebu, when the people was celebrating happily the New Year, at about two c'clock in the morning, the City was attacked from three points, resulting in five killed and five wounded. The casualties included two members of the Philippine Constabulary and worst of it was that one of the members was to be married on that same day. The Cebu Constabulary Academy was also riddled with bullets. In the following morning when we made our investigation, we found that the two flags - the Filipine and the Japanese flags that were waving in front of the Academy were also riddled with bullets. The Japanese flag got only two holes on it and the Philippine flag got seven holes. Such is the tragedy of the Filipines fighting against the Filipines.

It is not enough that we have suffered in the war. Let us invite our brothers who are still hiding to come to the lewlands and cooperate with us in this gigantic task of the rebuilding of the New Philippines. If they cannot go down let us advise them to lay low and not to molest the innocent civilians nor the constabulary soldiers. For what is our Independence worth, if we have no peace? It is our duty to our province as well as to our country to establish peace and order for our happiness and for the happiness of our children and our children's children.

My dear friends, yesterday, I was present at a conference with the high commanding officer of the Japanese and I am going to say this to you in all conferences because it is a typical example of the predicament in which the Governor or the mayor finds himself at any moment. The Governor wanted to go outside of the City of Ilcilo in order to take me and other members of the

party for instation surposes. Unfortunately man of the alcohol station refused to give him the necessary alcohol. He laid his case before the Japanese Officer. I did not know what has transpired within that short period but I have seen the courage of your Governor. If there is a governor who has the courage and who has that conviction, that man is no other than your Provincial Governor, Fermin G. Caram: (Applause)

Our problem now, my friends, is to conserve what is ours and the power that is ours, Of course, we realise that it is war time. We have to subject ourselves to the exigences of the moment. But I should like to ask you to 'hold high that brow serene'.

I have heard and seen people, in public conferences and in private meetings who do nothing else but present themselves to the Japanese with subservient attitude. They will respect us if we knew how to upheld our dignity. For instance, my friends, when I went to Manila to secure my revolver's license, I had to go to the Japanese for it. Of course the possession of a military arm, requires that we should submit ourselves to military authorities. But I tell you my friends that before I left the City of Cebu for Ileile, I gave an order to the Constabulary Commander at Cebu to issue the licenses for firearms. I have given this order to the constabulary commander at Cebu and I am giving the same order to the Constabulary Commander at Ileilo to issue licenses for firearms.

My dear friends, I can assure you that so long as we respect the Japanese and so long as we do not trouble them, they will also respect and will not trouble us. We need not adopt he stile and belligerent attitude. We know we are weak, but there is strength in weakness as there is strength in a woman. Hold high that brow serene! We are free and independent! We are the Republic of the Philippines!

Last night, I was told by a relative that maybe our independence is not real, because we have a limited power as an independent nation; I told him, for Heaven's sake, great improvements have happened for the last three months that we have had our independence. As the President said, our country is only three months old and a three month's baby is but a tiny piece of a bundle of humanity. What can a three month's baby do? His business is only to wrinate and make unnecessary cries to bit the band. But in three month's time, we have done something - the President has done something.

Among the first measures we have approved was an appropriation of two million pesos for relief and rehabilitation purposes. It is not very much, but we want to relieve the people. Many of our people have suffered as a result of this war.

When I first came to Iloilo, I asked the Governor to please take me around the City. I cannot even remember the city boundary due to the extent of damage to which it has suffered. Probably, your eity has suffered as much as that of the Cebu City of Iloile, but it is for us now to prepare the ground for the days to come. May God in his Kingdom give us life so that we can live up to the day of the declaration of peace! Out of the ashes, we can still rebuild a bigger and more beautiful Gebu and Iloile, the pride of the Cebuanos and the Ilongos.

I was also informed that very soon, there will be a mopping operation up in the mountains of Panay which means that more civilians will be killed - more Filipinos will be killed. My dear friends, I am nobody. I cannot predict

what is going to happen. It is for us to come to understanding with the Japanese.

In Cebu, we have a very serious food problem. You can find not a single rise grain in Cebu. A pound of beef in Cebu now costs P8.00. The chief food of the people in Cebu is corn, but you know how poor is the Province of Cebu. We have always been dependent from Mindanao and from Java. You can imagine how hard to transport food from those places and you can also imagine the distress of your brothers in Cebu. When you eat in a resturant or a parlor, you will find people outside the eating place with a can in their hands hoping that there will be some remnants from your table which they could grab. Now, we do not have enymore corn. That is why I have come to ask the generosity of the Governor of Iloilo to help me. I have also here a telegram from Bohol and Negros Oriental asking for food. I sent a message to the Food Administrator which I dictated this morning and also to His Excellency, the President. I tell you my friends, that yours is an island of paradise. We have a terrible food shortage. So my friends, I come here also to intensify the food production campaign as we cannot tell what will happen next. Manila, too, is facing a shortage of food. What will happen if there is a shortage of food? There will be a food riot. When the children cry for food when there is no food, how ugly would it be. There will be disturbance throughout which would lead to the overthrowing of an organized government.

In Cebu, I have already issued the following order:

- No member of the Neighborhood association can get any food ration unless he presents a certificate that he is engaged in food production campaign.
- No employee can get his salary unless he shows the same certificate.



- Every student, from fourth grade up to higher grades must devote at least one-half of their time in food production.
- 4. No payment of vouchers by the Government to any individual unless he shows the same certificate.
- No license of any kind, repair of buildings, automobiles, including marriage license can be signed unless the interested party can show the same certificate.

We have now declared two meatless days in Gebu - Wednesday and Friday, in order to conserve the meat supply to prevent the slaughtering of cows and carabass which may be fit to work. I thought that you have promulgated the same orders, but I found out that the people here are contented. When we went to Guimbal, I was surprised to see that plenty of palay is being dried in nearly all sides of the road.

Well, my friends. I am almost through with my remarks, but before closing, I wish to inform you that the President is observing a very simple and frugal life. When the President had just been inaugurated into office, he was approached, right away by the palace keeper of Malacanang and was told that she needed ten thousand pasos so that she can properly equip the palace with beautiful curtains. The President replied: "What, ten thousand pasos for curtains? What do I need for curtains? This palace is too big for me and my family".

And I tell you my friends, President Laurel is not living in the Palace of Malacanang. Moreover, he is using nothing but a second hand Ford car. President Laurel is giving us an example that this is the time for economy. I wish to tell you that one time, after a lunch given in honor of General Ashiza, President Laurel invited me for a little conference and he took me to his office. I saw on his desk a list of appointments. I found out that he had already an appointment at 1:30 P.M., so that this goes to show that your President, my president is working from nine o'clock in the morning to 9:00 o'clock in the evening, with interruption, except in the afternoon when he takes his afternoon exercise. He also told me how he nearly lost his life when two bullets were directed to his heart. The first bullet instead of going directly to his heart went a little upward, missing his heart by a fraction of a centimeter. The second bullet was also directed right straight to his heart, but by some unknown power, it went a little downward, missing his heart by a fraction of a millimeter. You might call it mysterical but I call it Providencial. Now, my dear friends, we are very glad that we have in our President a man who is really leading our country in the right path.

When he spoke at the convention in Cebu City of Governors, City Mayors and Commanders of Constabulary, he said: "I want independence because I do not want America to come back in the Philippines as I do not want the Philippines to be turned again to a battle field. I also want independence because I want the Japanese to get out of these lands."

My friends, I have been saying that I am through and yet I am not through. Now, I am ready to hear any suggestion from you but I would prefer that in this convention, you should prepare it in writing. Here, I have certain recommendations from the Governor and I am going to act on them. I am going to lay those which I cannot act to the President.

I am going to request every mayor who is here right now to employ men right away to gather all corrugated irons they could. They would mean nothing to you now, but you will need them. You know in Cebu how much they cost - they are not sold per sheet but per lineal foot. If you are not going to gather them, sombody will do it for you. I was yesterday in Guimbal and the first thing I waw was a few barrels of coil. I told them, for Heaven's sake, hide that coil for you will have need for them. Maybe not today, but you wall need them and I am telling you right now.

Yesterday afternoon, when I went to the High Command and when we were coming out of the office, what did I see? I saw a file of books belonging to the Philippine Government - five thousand to ten thousand volumes. There is fortune and wisdom in those books. I told the High Command that I would like to get them back - right now, if possible, because those books belong to the Province of Iloilo. We need those books. Our children and our children's children need them:

There are lots of things which we want to gather. Gather them while you can. Get them if we must, but get them at any rate. You cannot find a single piece of corrugated iron in Cebu. They are either sold or looted. Even those corrugated irons fried by fire, cannot be found in Cebu. Some of them have been converted into weapons of war. If that happens in Cebu, it may happen here in your province. So my friends, I am glad to be here so that I could give you my advice.

This position of mine is very high. I tell you my friends, my wife was opposed to my accepting this job. I conferred with lots of friends, among them were: Briones, Zulueta, Alunan and with Speaker Roxas. Before I accepted them were: Briones, Zulueta, Alunan and with Speaker Roxas. Before I accepted this job, I was number 3 in the black list in Cebu. The Governor was number 1; the mayor was number 2 and I was then the Judge of the Court of First Instance (looking at Judge Barrios), like you Justice Barries, I was number 3 in the (looking at Judge Barrios), like you Justice Barries, I was number 3 in the list. My wife said that when I was blacklisted as a Judge of the Court of First Instance of Cebu. I will be nine times blacklisted if I accept the position.

It is just a question of making our friends realise. We are not the enemies of the guerrillistas. They are our friends. How many of them who were taken by the Garrison, by the Keinpeitai in Cebu and were saved by those whom they have previously blacklisted! Now, they realize that ours is a mission of peace; they are all our friends because they are all Filipinos. We cannot blame them, because who knows that if we are in the mountains, we would have been Guerrillistas too. Sometimes because of circumstances, they are forced to join the guerillas, The guerrilleros who join in the plot to burn our towns and kill innocent civilians are our enemies, but the guerrillero who is fighting for his innocent civilians are our enemies, but the guerrillero who is fighting for his ideals is not the enemy of the Filipinos. It is for us to make him realize that we are his friends and if we cannot save him, at least we can advise him not to molest the civilians nor the Constabulary men. We are in the gigantic task of building up our county and we all hope that out of the ashes and ruins will rise a new and better Philippines for our happiness and for the happiness of our children and our children's children.

So my friends, finally I am through. Whatever suggestions you would like to give, kindly prepare them in due form.

Before I come to a conclusion, let me outline to you the powers and duties of my office. The Philippines is divided into three districts - Lusen, Visayas and Mindanao. Luzon is under the President of the Republic; Visayas is under the Commissioner for the Visayas and Mindanao is under the Commissioner for Mindanao and Sulu. The commissioner shall exercise general supervision and administrative control over the district in which he is assigned, and to perform such other duties as may be assigned by the President of the Republic of the Philippines. (In this instance, the Commissioner road the instructions given him in connection with his position).

I feel myself of liliputian size to tackle this job. I have not been a member of the assembly nor a member of the Legislature, altho I have been a president of the college of the Visayan Institute. When in fact, I proposed Avolino who has been a member of the Cabinet. I told the President that I am a square peg in the round hole. I do not have the experience. I do not have the background. The position that I have is high but yet so law. Sometimes, I think I am powerful, yet powerless; sometimes, I think I am omnipotent, yet impotent. Without the help and cooperation and with the advice of the Governors and the Mayors in the Visayas, I am helpless. I am asking the people to help me. Without your help, I may not succeed, but with your help, I may succeed. I thank you.

There is no evidence that CUSHING's leadership would be any better received by the people of BOHOL than that INGINIERO's would be by the people of CEBU. As the campaign progresses it is probable that incidents will become general such as that reported to have occured in INGINIERO's headquarters - a time in which calm leadership that steered the people through the dark days may be overwhelmed by those, heretofore in obscurity, who rush to get on the band wagon as the outlook becomes brighter and dangers appear to subside. The evidence clearly suggests however that the most difficult days for the people of BOHOL yet lie sheed. Action taken: None. A PLOT TO KILL MAJOR INGINIERO OF BOHOL BY HIS OFFICERS WAS FRUSTRATED BY TIMELY ARRIVAL OF SENATOR GARCIA IN HIS HEADQUARTERS. THE ORGANIZATION THERE IS DEMANDING A NEW OFFICER. IF YOU DESIRE WE CAN SEND OPERATIVES TO GET DETAILS CONCERNING THIS TROUBLE, PLEASE ADVISE. I FIRMLY BELIEVE THE 8TH MILITARY DISTRICT CAN BE SUCCESSFULLY REORGANIZED. THIS CONSOLIDATION WILL GREATLY RELIEVE FOOD PRESSURE AND PERMIT EXCHANGE OF TROOPS AS RELIEFS. IT WILL ALSO ADD GREATLY TO THE HARMONY AND COMMUNICATION WITH 9TH AND 10TH MILITARY DISTRICT. We have had little indication of the NECROS situation which CUSHING reports from ABCEDE. Assuming the situation to be correctly reported there is little that advisers could do to remedy the same even if dispatched as recommended.

It is furthermore extremely doubtful that food in any great quantity could be procured or shipped from LEYTE or BOHOL to either CEBU or NECROS in view of the enemy patrol of adjacent waters, enemy occupation of Western LEYTE and the apparent strained relations existing between CUSHING and INGINIERO. There appears to be no remedial action available to this headquarters in the matter reported other than to possibly advise ABCEDE if he confirms CUSHING's report on the NECROS situation and requests advice.

The availability of Filipino manpower in sizable numbers to bear arms has been considered by the C in C (conversation with Dr. Carson, et al., 10 April) the problem being how to deliver arms to them by the time desired. In this respect CEBU is probably no different than any other Province in the Philippines.

CUSHING's direct suggestion that BOHOL be placed under CEBU for the re-activation of the old 8th Military District may suggest that some of CUSHING's recent reports implying INGINIERO's inability to control the BOHOL forces are in the nature of sniping tactics designed to undermine the confidence of this headquarters in INGINIERO's ability to properly discharge his command responsibilities.

CUSHING's request should be ignored.



This message is designed to support CUSHING's desire to enlarge the scope of his command to embrace the entire 8th Military District (CEBU and BCHOL). If INGINIERO and his forces did in fact lay low without offering resistance to the enemy it is probable that the latter will eventually withdraw following the usual pattern of movement and permit the resumption of our operations in that area - if on the other hand resistance was attempted it is more than likely that the enemy will remain in strength after quickly overcoming such resistance.

IN OUR EFFEORTS TO SAVE THE LIVES OF THE CIVILIAN PEOPLE WITHIN THE JAPANESE OCCUPIED AREAS WE FEEL IT OUR DUTY TO ADVISE YOU AGAIN THAT THE TIME HAS COME FOR YOU TO PLAY YOUR PART IN THIS WAR.

YOU ARE HEREBY ADVISED TO LEAVE THE JAPANESE OCCUPIED AREAS WITH WHATEVER MEANS YOU CAN. THIS IS NOT THE TIME FOR YOU TO THINK OF YOUR PROPERTY, PERSONAL BELONGINGS, AND SUCH OTHER ITEMS THAT YOU MAY HOLD DEAR IN YOUR HEARTS. 
