ALL SOLDIERS AND SUPPLIES BROUGHT BONOAO THREE KILOMETERS EAST CURRY. FOUR BIG NIPA HOUSES (TWO SERVING AS QUARTERS FOR OFFICERS ONE EACH FOR STORING RICE AND PALAY) SMALL HUTS HAVE THREE OR FOUR SOLDIERS SCATTERED IN WIDE ABACA PLANTATION. FOXHOLES SURROUND HUTS. DIGGING CAVES WITH TWO ENTRANCES INTO MOUNTAIN SIDE STILL GOING ON. 279 MM GUNS SEEN ON TRAIL TO BONOAO. BAMBOOS AND NIPA SHINGLES STILL BEING BROUGHT UP NIGHTLY.

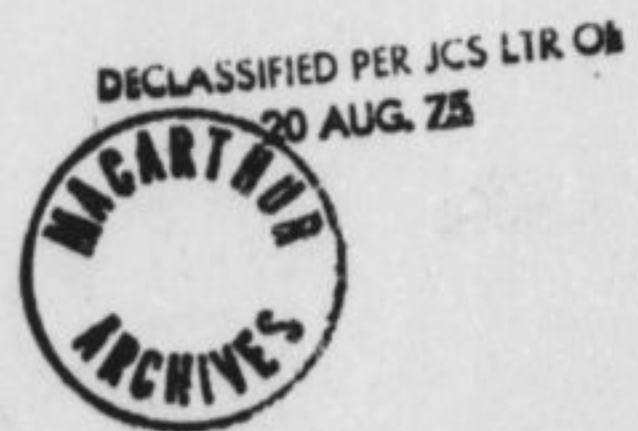
