CHEERIO ALL HAPPY TO HEAR FROM YOU. SENDING MSG MOST THINGS YOUR HAVE ASKED BY COURIER TO MAJOR PHILLIPS MINDORO. HAD BAD NEWS FROM MY SISTERS LATELY. IN THE HILLS HARD UP AND LOST EVERYTHING. YOUR MESSAGE BRIGHTENED ME UP.

SHIPPING MANILA BAY AT TIMES AS HIGH AS THIRTY IN IT ARRIVING
IN CONVOYS OF EIGHT TO TEN SHIPS WITH DESTROYER ESCORT UP TO MARIVELES.

TOTAL MOVEMENT ABOUTHUNDRED AND FIFTY VESSELS MONTHLY OF FIVE TO TEN
THOUSAND TONS DEADWEIGHT CAPACITY. LATELY VERY FEW TANKERS. ALL
MERCHANT TYPE ARMED WITH THREE TO ROUR INCH GUNS AND MACHINE GUNS.

CONCENTRATES COCO OIL AND BY PRODUCTS, SALT, SOME SUGAR, ROPE AND HEMP. FRENCH LINER TRIPS NOW IRREGULAR LAST SEEN MANILA TWO WEEKS AGO.
SHIPPING AT JOSE PANGANIBAN AT PRESENT NIL BUT SAN FERNANDO UNION AND LEGASPI INDREASINGLY USED FOR TROOP MOVEMENTS.

DEWEY DOCK REFLOATED AND IN ACTIVE USE MANILA BAY ABOUT THREE
MILES OFF BREAKWATER. WARSHIPS SELDOM SEEN HERE EXCEPTDESTROYERS. IN
THE LAST FEW MONTHS FOUR LARGE AIRCRAFT CARRIERS. BELIEVE CONVOYS
HAVE AIR ESCORT BASED AT TAIWAN AND MANILA.

GENERALLY TWELVE BOMBERS LEAVE MANILA NORTHBOUND IN STAGGERED FORMATION ABOUT SEVEN A.M. RETURNING ABOUT NOON. ALSO DURING MORNING SOME
FIGHTERS ACTIVE BUT BELIEVE MERELY FOR TRAINING AND OBSERVATION. DAILY
AIR TRANSPORT SERVICE TO TAIWAN AND DAVAO. TOTAL AIR FORCE ESTIMATED
NOT MUCH MORE THAN HUNDRED AND FIFTY MOSTLY BASED AT NICHOLS, NIELSON

TROOP CONCENTRATION PRINCIPALLY AT MANILA AND ALONG NORTH AND SOUTH ROADS IN SMALL UNITS AS GARRISONS. MANILA CONTINGENT COMPOSED MOSTLY OF RECRUITSAT TRAINING AND ALSO RETURNING UNITS FROM SOUTH PAGIFIC ON CURE AND RECUPERATION. ESTIMATE LUZON FIFTY THOUSAND MEN.

MORE CONVINCED THAT NEW GOVERNMENT MERELY PUPPET REGIME CONTROLLED BY
ENEMY. LOYALTY FILIPINOS UNCHANGED. NO CHANGE OF POLICY OF ENEMY CONTROL. PRESENT TEMPER OF PINOYS UNCONCERNED OVER ANY PROGRAM INDEPENDENCE FROM AMERICA. NOW ONLY INTERESTED IN LIBERATION FROM ENEMY AND
ASSISTANCE FROM AMERICALFOR RECONSTRUCTION.

COMMODITY PRICES SOARING RESULTING IN GROWING POPULAR DISCONTENT. JAP
ARMY CONTINUE WITH CONTROL AS BEFORE INDEPENDENCE.

PHIL GOVERNMENT HAS NO PLANS TO ESTABLISH AN ARMY BUT ONLY TO
INCREASE CONSTABULARY TO FORTY THOUSAND. HEALTH CONDITION SO FAR
SATISFACTORY BUT GREAT SHORTAGE MEDICINES AND TERRIBLY DEAR. VERY
LITTLE CLOTHING MATERIAL AVAILABLE. RATIONING OF FOOD AND CLOTHING
INEFFECTIVE. JAP FIRMS STILD CONTROLLING ALL BUSINESS AND INDUSTRIES.

TRY TO CONTACT HIM AND RELAY FURTHER INFO. AM TRYING TO SECURE ADDITIONAL LISTS AND INFO ON WAR PRISONERS.

ROXAS BELIEVES HIS PRESENCE HERE UNTIL SHORTLY BEFORE START OF ACTIVITIES THIS AREA. SUGGEST MAKE PLANS FOR EVACUATION LATTER PART OF FEBRUARY. FINAL DECISION TO BE RELAYED TO PHILLIPS OR FERTIG.

GRATEFUL TO RENWAC (GEN MAC 1). THIS MESSAGE PREPARED WITH HIM.

SUGGEST PHILLIPS HOLD RADIO SET PENDING OUR OTHER ACTIONS.

FINANCIAL CONDITIONS OF THREE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED WAR PRISONERS

CABANATUAN FAIRLY SATISFACTORY BUT OTHER CAMPS VICINITY MANILA WHERE

THEY ARE COMPELLED TO WORK IN AIRFIELDS AND PORT AREA QUITE BAD AND

CONTACT DIFFICULT BUT TRYING OUR BEST. THE FORMATION OF A NEUTRAL

COMMITTEE HAS BEEN AUTHORIZED BY THE JAPS THERE PAST FEW DAYS TO

COLLECT CONTRIBUTIONS FOR THEM. SISVIA MILIANTRIAS. FINANCIAL

REQUIREMENTS SANTO TOMAS FULLY COVERED.

SCHOONER COULD BE AVAILABLE IF YOU THINK NECESSARY OUTLINE
PURPOSE TO ASCERTAIN FEASIBILITY. MRIMITIVO SAN AGUSTAN CONTACTED.
MESSAGE RECEIVED AND ANSWERED. HE SHOULD BE NOW AT FERTIGS WITH
IMPORTANT INFO FOR YOU. CONSIDERED DANGEROUS AND INADVISABLE YOUR
LANDING BATANGAS NOW. SENDING VELONO TO PHILLIPS TO ESTABLISH
REGULAR CONTACT. JUAN AND RIC FAMILIES WELL ABRAZOS DE ELLOI. WHAT
HAS BECOME OF MY PAPERS YOU SAY NOTHING OF WRITTEN AUTHORIZATION
FOR INDUCTION AND FINANCING FROM AUSTRALIA. THOSE ARE BADLY NEEDED
