CHRONOLOGY

- Sept 41 - Stationed at Clark Field with 14th Bomb Squadron, 19th Bomb Group.
- 24 Dec 41 - Unit went to Bataan and was sent to Malabang, Lanao, to operate the radio located there.
- 1 May 42 - Went to Leyte with air corps group after the Japanese landing at Parang, Cotabato.
- 12 May 42 - Went to Cautit Point, Surigao, after Col CORNELL advised the group to either surrender or get off of Leyte.
- 3 Jun 42 - Was with James MILLIGAN, Sgt, 14th Bomb Squadron, 19th Bomb Group at Tigon, Surigao, when he died.
- Mar 43 - Met Col McCLISH and Commander PARSONS in Suriago; accompanied Parsons to Col FERTIG'S Headquarters.
- 5 May 43 - Commissioned a 2d Lt by Col Fertig and made radio operator of the station at Bonafacio.
- 1 Jul 43 - Captain HAMNER left Mindanao for Sulu, Tawi Tawi.
- Mar 44 - Evacuated.
