Divino spent all of his time in hiding in the mountains on Mindanao. He was unable to give any information of value.

CHRONOLOGY

8 Dec 41 - Stationed at Del Monte, Mindanao.
May 42 - Was with Oscar SMITH, in the hills of Maramag, Bukidnon, at the time of surrender.
1943 - Stayed with natives in Surigao.
Jan - Mar 44 - Worked as radio operator for Col FERTIG in the Butuan, Agusan Area.
Mar 44 - Evacuated.
