Parham, an American-Mestizo, played an inactive part with the guerrillas on Negros. His information was merely confirmatory of information received many times from other evacuees concerning general conditions existing on Negros.

CHRONOLOGY

1942 - Mar 43 - Lived in evacuation with family in the moun-

tains on Negros.

- Father, Archer PARHAM, formerly Divisional Jun 42 Superintendent of Schools on Negros, surrendered to the Japs in an effort to obtain medicine for his family.

- Joined the guerrillas, stationed with the Mar 43 Medical Corps of the 75th Infantry.

- Worked in the hospital.

Mar-Nov 43 - Commissioned a 3rd Lt and assigned to District 23 NOV 43

Headquarters.

- Served as Staff Officer at District Headquar-Jan-Jun 44 ters, also did some coding and decoding work as well as work in the finance office.

- Beginning of Japanese campaign on southern 31 May 44 coast of Negros. All CPs destroyed. Guerrillas did as well as could be expected.

- Brother, Conrad M PARHAM, 13 years old, was 2 Jun 44 captured by Japs, later heard that he was serving Jap soldiers as errand boy.

- Evacuated. 20 Jun 44

GUERRILLA ORGANIZATION: Though the discipline is not good and though the financial records are not kept in the proper manner, Parham said that the guerrillas were doing well under the circumstances. It would be difficult to improve the situation.

PERSONNEL REQUIREMENTS: American officers and men are not needed. The men would welcome Americans but the officers would resent them. They want to do it by themselves so as to receive all of the credit.
