Reynolds spent most of the time that he was with the guerrillas doing hospital and office work. He took an inactive part in the activities and was more interested in getting to Australia than in helping the guerrillas. The limited information given by him is passed on for what it might be worth.

CHRONOLOGY

- 26 Sep 41 - Arrived at Ft Stotsenburg, Pampanga, P.I.
- 24 Dec 41 - Moved with unit to Bataan.
- 9 Apr 42 - Surrendered on Bataan.
- 21 May 42 - Arrived in Bacolod, Negros with 9 other American prisoners
- May 42 - Jul 43 - Drove trucks for the Japanese over most of the roads of Negros during which time the guerrillas conducted many ambushes, a few of which were effective.
- 4 Jul 43 - Escaped with 6 other American POWs into mountains near Bacolod.
- 5 Jul 43 - Arrived in Sub-Sector "E" and joined the guerrillas under Captain SANSOM.
- 15 Aug 43 - Assigned to Sub-Sector "C", Co "F", worked in Company Headquarters for a while.
- 1 Nov 43 - Transferred to Sub-Sector "E".
- Nov 43 - May 44 - Worked in office and hospital. During this period guerrillas in this sector conducted 6 ambushes against the Japanese, none of which was effective.
- 26 May 44 - Arrived at District Headquarters to meet the sub.
- 1 Jun 44 - Retreated into mountains during Jap drive along southern coast of Negros.
- 20 Jun 44 - Evacuated.
