Now we require of them but organized passive defense - - discourage anything else. You will, of course, know better how to interpret the word "demonstrations" as employed here than I do. To me it suggests taking advantage of enemy quiescence by rather large scale raids on enemy held positions. This is probably necessary at times to revive lagging morale both on the part of the military forces and the people. At the same time, if carried to the point that it provokes enemy reinforcements and reprisals, it can act as a boomerang.

One thing I do like to see from this message, however, is the suggestion of a synchronization of movement between the two commanders. With coordination and cooperation developed, the interior movement in the Philippines will prove not only much more lasting but much more vital to our present and future interests.

G-2 may find the reduction of occupational forces in these areas as indicative of operations projected for other fronts - - may be to a certain extent tied into the policy which dictated enemy withdrawal from KISKA.







LETTER DATED AUG ONE SEVEN OF UNDERSECRETARY DING TO ME AS FOL-LOWS "WHILE I WAS IN SORSOGON I OBSERVED GUERILLA MOVEMENT THERE CONFERRED WITH MAJOR LAPUZ AND GOVERNOR ESCUDERO. WITHOUT SIDING ANYONE AND AS AN IMPARTIAL OBSERVER, I CAN STATE WITH ALL SIN-CERITY BOTH ARE NATIVE OF THE PROVINCE AND IN MY OFFICIAL CAPACITY THAT MAJOR LAPUZ IS NOT AT FAULT; THAT HE IS TRYING TO WORK FOR THE COMMON CAUSE JUST LIKE ANY OTHER LOYAL ARMY OFFICER. ESCUDERO MISUNDERSTANDS HIM AND BECAUSE OF THE ILL ADVICE OF THREE UNDESTRABLE LIEUTENANTS SURROUNDING HIM, THEY ARE WORKING FOR LAPUZ DOWNFALL. HOWEVER THE INTELLIGENT AND MAJORITY OF THE PEOPLE OF SORSOGON KNOWING AS THEY DO THE ACTUAL CONDITIONS OBTAINING THEREIN ARE NOT ONLY SIDING BUT ALSO SUPPORTING MAJOR LAPUZ AND HIS UNIT KNOWN AS THE SIXTY SEVENTH INFANTRY. WITH LAPUZ AS CORPS C O, THEY HAVE BEEN CONSIDERING THEMSELVES AS ATTACHED TO PANAY HORS. THE RIFT EXISTING BETWEEN ESCUDERO AND LAPUZ CAN EASILY BE SOLVED BY A WRITTEN RECOGNITION BY THE PANAY HORS OF THE SIXTY SEVENTH INFANTRY. PANAY HORS IS VERY WELL RESPECTED THRUOUT THE BICOL REGION AND WITH THIS RE-COGNITION PETTY TROUBLES WILL BE ENDED AS EVERYONE WILL FALL INTO LINE. THE MAIN CONTROVERSY IS AS TO WHO IS THE RECOGNIZED MILITARY LEADER BY THE PANAY HORS.

ONCE THERE IS DEFINITE PRONOUNCEMENT BY YOUR HORS THERE IT WILL GRADUALLY DISAPPEAR. I HAVE BEEN IN FREE SAMAR FOR ALMOST TWO MONTHS TRAVELLING FROM ONE TOWN TO ANOTHER. I HAVE SEEN THE MIL ORGANIZATION UNDER MERRITT AND CONSIDERING ACTUAL CONDITIONS IT IS INDEED SPLENDID. THE MILITARY UNITS IN LEYTE ARE NOT YET UNIFIED AND IT WOULD BE IMPROPER IF NOT RIDICULOUS TO PUT SAMAR UNDER LEYTE COMMAND CONSIDERING DIFFICULTIES OF TRANSP AND COMMUNICATION TOO. I HAVE PASSED ON MY WAY HERE THRU THE ISLAND OF BANTAYAN AND HAVE PERSONALLY MET OFFICERS OF THE GUERILLA FORCES OF THE ISLAND OF CEBU. I HAVE BEEN INFORMED OF COLONEL FENTONS CONDUCT AS COMMANDING OFFICER OF CEBU AND THE UNANIMOUS DISAPPOINTMENT OF OFFICERS UNDER HIM. IT IS ONLY THE SPIRIT TO WORK FOR THE COMMON CAUSE THAT IS SAVING THE GUERILLA UNIT THEREAT FROM CRUMBLING INTO PIECES." VERACITY OF THESE STATEMENTS DEPENDS ON CHARACTER OF DINO OF WHOM I HAVE NO PERSONAL ACQUAINTANCE. I KNOW MEMBERS HIS FAMILY ONLY ONE OF WHOM IS MAJOR DING MEDICAL CORPS NOW AT WASHINGTON WITH QUEZON. FURTHERMORE "I TRAVELLED THRUOUT THE SOUTHERN TAGALOG, BICOL AND VISAYAN PROVINCES CON-TACTING PEOPLE AND STRENGTHENING THEIR MORALE. I HAVE FOUND OUT THAT OVERWHELMING MAJORITY OF FILIPINOS ARE SOLIDLY BACKING THE GUERILLA MOVEMENT EVER CONFIDENT OF EARLY VICTORY." HE ALSO SAYS HE HAS PLENTY MORE TO TELL ME.
