"YOUR DISBURSEMENTS ARE A MATTER OF GRAVE CONCERN TO THE PHILIPPINE GOVERNMENT. AS COMPARED WITH ALL OTHER DISTRICTS AND COMMIANDERS, THEY ARE OUT OF ALL PROPORTION. EVEN COMPARED WITH YOUR OWN FIGURES, DISCREPANCIES EXIST WHICH AT THIS DISTANCE ARE NOT EXPLICABLE. FOR INSTANCE, YOUR EXPENDITURES WHEN YOUR FORCES WERE REPORTED AT TWENTY THOUSAND DID NOT DIFFER MATERIALLY FROM LATER EXPENDITURES WITH FORCES REPORTED AT TEN THOUSAND. WITHOUT APPROVAL YOU HAVE ON YOUR OWN AUTHORITY FAR EXCEEDED THE AMOUNTS AUTHORIZED YOU BY THE GOVERNMENT. WITHOUT KNOWING THE FULL FACTS OF YOUR NECESSITIES AND THE CIRCUMSTANCES WHICH DICTATE YOUR ACTIONS IT IS IMPOSSIBLE EITHER TO CONDONE OR TO CONDEMN WHAT YOU HAVE DONE. THE APPROPRIATENESS OF THE ACTION YOU HAVE TAKEN WILL HAVE TO BE ADJUDGED AND SETTLED AFTER THE WAR. IF THE FACTS WARRANT WHAT YOU HAVE DONE YOU NEED HAVE NO FEAR. IF THE CONTRARY IS THE CASE, YOU WILL HAVE TO ACCEPT THE RESPONSIBILITY OF YOUR OWN HANDIWORK. AS A GENERAL PRINCIPLE, YOU SHOULD EXERT EVERY EFFORT TO CONTROL INFLATION BY LIMITING EXPENDITURES TO THE MINIMUM. REDUCTION WILL HELP YOUR FINANCIAL POSITION. OTHERWISE, UNCONTROLLED PRICE LEVELS WILL MAKE IT DIFFICULT IF NOT IMPOSSIBLE TO EXIST OR TO BUY FROM THE CIVILIANS ESSENTIAL SUPPLIES. TO HELP YOU I WILL ENDEAVOR TO SHIP INCREASING AMOUNTS OF COMMODITIES OF INTRINSIC VALUE SUCH AS MEDICINES WITHOUT CURTAILING PROJECTED SHIPMENTS OF RIFLES AND AMMUNITION"

PERALTA's action reflected in attached messages, 168, 169 and 170, is weak. He assumes a self righteous attitude, neither offering a defense nor attempting to justify his action. He asks for auditors, at the same time pointing out the difficulty involved keeping records, contending that many of the same went down with the sub lost after leaving his area last August.

PERALTA has many good points and many bad ones - it being not yet clear which counterbalances the other. The insolent tone of which he is capable is probably the result of youth, extreme egotism, and the difficulties confronting him - - the two former having contributed to the mastery he

The wide publicity given his letter in the United States was an open challenge to best enemy effort to capture or destroy him - it may well prove to have been a tragic error of judgement with CONFESOR's life as forfeit. As Civil Governor representing the million people who inhabit PANAY, he is entitled to reasonable protection from the military forces as an individual whose widely publicized pronouncements symbolize defiance of enemy efforts toward pacification he is even further entitled to such protection.

The instance cited by PERALTA lends no strength to his contention. That a platoon could not be sent over the ILOILO-ANTIQUE border to afford the Governor emergency protection, because of a conflict in areas thereby involved, would seem to disclose a lack of flexibility in dispositions hardly justified by the situation in PANAY where Provincial lines and governments have given way to centralization for reasons of expediency.

As the matter now stands Governor CONFESCR has appealed to President QUEZON to request the C in C to direct protective action. The message of CONFESCR has been withheld by PERALTA who may or may not have given the full gist of it in attached dispatch.

I believe that ultimately PERALTA should be directed to afford CONFESOR, as Governor, such protection as the exigencies of the situation in PANAY will permit.

Meanwhile, I believe that PERALTA should be directed to forward the message CONFESOR is endeavoring to get through to President QUEZON. That the matter be thereafter given further study in the light of it content.
