This is a rather frank appraisal of the guerilla movement in Central LUZON. It is however difficult of evaluation in view of the rivalry influencing such opinions. Even MANZANO makes no attempt to evaluate.

UMALI OF QUEZON'S OWN TO MACARTHUR:

"HIGHLIGHTS ONLY, AND MANZANO COMMENTS. GUERRILLA ORGANIZATIONS ARE OFTEN PERSONAL POLITICAL ORGANS. THIS LEADS TO CONSTANT FRICTION AND INEVITABLE CONFLICT. INDUCTION OF THOUSANDS OF UNTRAINED PEOPLE MITIGATE (MILITATE?) AGAINST PROPER INTELLIGENCE ORGAN AND JEOPARDIZES SAFETY OF ALL.

"QUISLINGS AND SPIES SHOT FREQUENTLY IN CITY. ENEMY ESPIONAGE PARTICULARLY STRONG THERE.

"ANDERSON GOOD GROUP FOR INTELLIGENCE SUPERVISION. HUKBALAHAP LEAD BY OLD ABAD SANTOS IS COMMUNISTIC AND RABID ANTI-JAP. MAY GIVE TROUBLE LATER, BUT NOW FOLLOWING RAMSEY. MANY SMALL GROUPS AFFILIATED WITH SEVERAL DIFFERENT LARGER UNITS, THUS GIVING FALSE TOTAL NUMBER OF MEMBERS, SINCE MANY NAMES ARE DUPLICATED. MANZANO THINKS THAT FRANCISCO MIGHT BE ONE LEADER TO RALLY PEOPLE, BUT FERTIG DISAGREES. HIS NAME SMEARED WITH ODIUM OF GEN. FHRTS (FORT'S?) EXECUTION, AND HE IS WITHOUT HONOR HERE. MANY USAFFE VETERANS MERELY WAITING YOUR ORDERS.

AS OF 25TH MAY MANDURIAO LANDING FIELD ONE PURSUIT PLANE PAINTED OLIVE DRAB AND ONE BOMBER PAINTED LIGHT GREEN. TIRING LANDING FIELD ONE DAMAGED PURSUIT PLANE UNDER REPAIR. MANDURIAO LANDING FIELD CAPABLE LANDING AND TAKING OFF DURING RAINY DAYS. TIRING LANDING FIELD NOT CAPABLE OF LANDING OR TAKING OFF BY BIM (BI-MOTORED) PLANES EVEN DRY WEATHER, GRAVEL SURFACING GOING ON. WEATHER CONDITIONS IN THESE FIELDS THIS DATE IS SUNNY WITH MODERATE RAIN FALL AT NIGHT. PREVAILING WIND NORTHEAST TO SOUTHWEST WITH SLIGHT VARIATIONS. 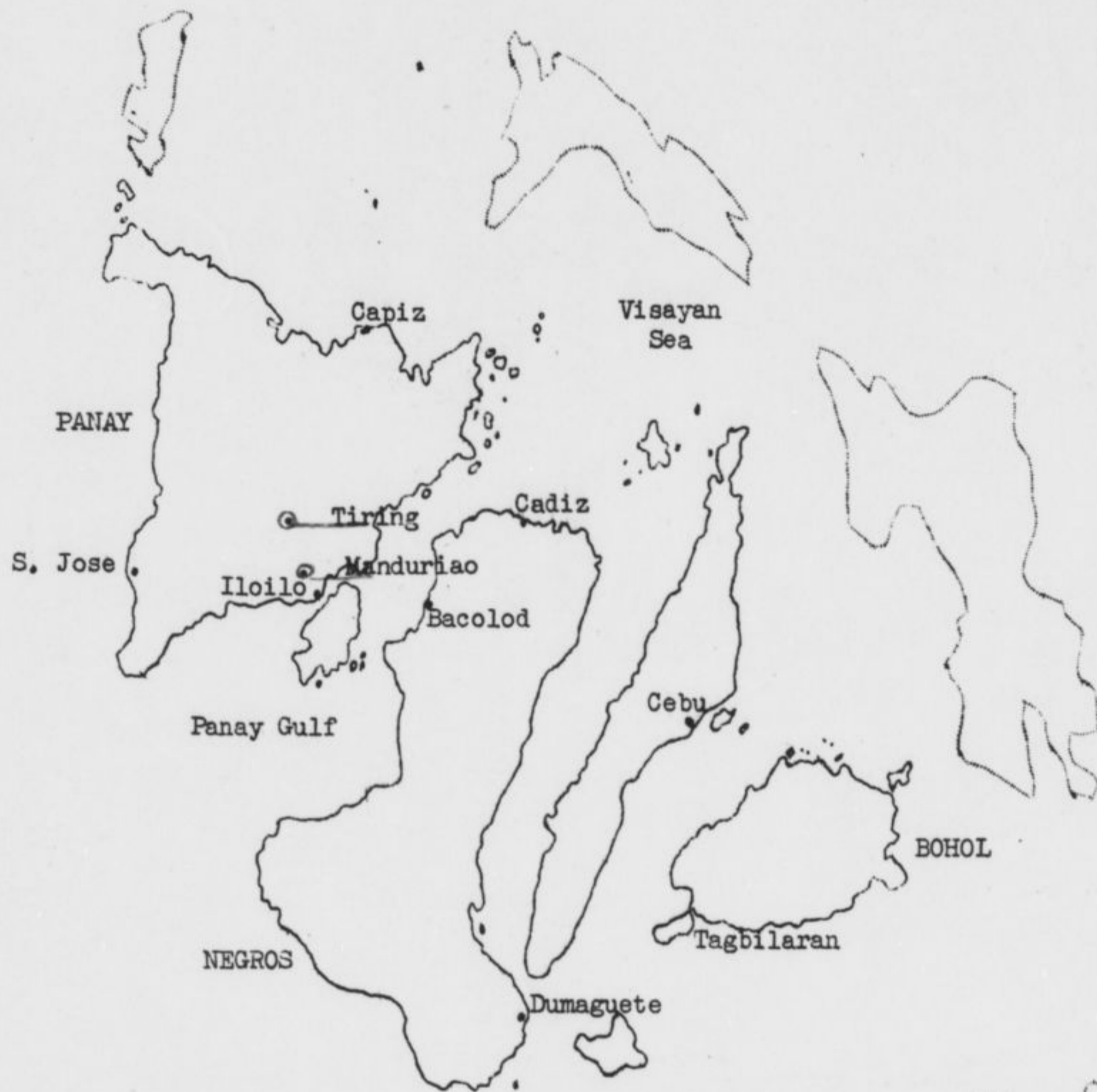

INCREASING ACTIVITY MAY INDICATE ENEMY INTEREST IN ESTABLISHING A WITHDRAWAL AREA THRU AGUSAN VALLEY, TO BE OCCUPIED WHEN THEY ARE FORCED TO RETIRE FROM THE BEACHES. AN AERIAL BLOCKADE TO CONCENTRATE ON LAUNCHES, BARGES AND SMALL SHIPS TO STOP THE ARRIVAL OF TROOPS AND SUPPLIES WOULD CRIPPLE THEIR PLANS WHICH NOW APPEAR TO BE A STRONG DEFENSE OF THE ISLAND ALTHO AS YET THEIR FORCES ARE LIMITED.

ANDREWS is pretty much on the spot in dispatching the message for the Governor which apparently ABCEDE refused or was reluctant to dispatch. ANDREWS being a subordinate in ABCEDE's command we had best ignore his request for instructions too.
