These two messages should be read together. The rising differences between the military and civil heads is probably a natural sequence to higher morale and assurances of our early return arising from the victorious march northward.

I believe that the intervention of this headquarters in the matter would be impractical and unwise and should be avoided. Time will eventually adjust such differences as if neither side gets encouragement from here both will eventually get together and work them out locally.

ANDREWS is pretty much on the spot in dispatching the message for the Governor which apparently ABCEDE refused or was reluctant to dispatch. ANDREWS being a subordinate in ABCEDE's command we had best ignore his request for instructions too.
