

OUR NR 215. MESSAGE WAS BROUGHT BY ABUEG WHO SAYS HE IS SECRETARY TO ASSEMBLYMAN ESPANOLA. SAYS HE MADE TEXT OF MESSAGE HIMSELF BUT HAS AUTHORITY FROM HIS ASSEMBLYMAN. HE CANNOT PRODUCE WRITTEN AUTHORITY HOWEVER BUT PROMISES CONFIRMATION BY ESPANOLA WHO IS HIS BROTHER-IN-LAW. CROSS-EXAMINATION REVEALS THAT BOTH LIVE IN CUYO AND HIS STORY PROBABLY TRUE FROM HIS PERSONAL REPUTATION. ESPANOLA WAS GOVERNOR OF PALAWAN IN 1937, REELECTED IN 1940. IN 1941 HE RAN FOR ASSEMBLYMAN, WON, AND ABORDO WHO WAS APPOINTED BY QUEZON TO FILL HIS PLACE AS GOVERNOR. STATES THAT ABORDO AND ESPANOLA ARE POLITICAL FRIENDS, THAT THERE IS NO POL-ITICAL BICKERING IN PALAWAN HE KNOWS OF, THAT CIVIL GOV-ERNMENT AND ARMY AUTHORITIES ARE ON BEST OF TERMS. PRINT-ING OF EMERGENCY CURRENCY IN PALAWAN DONE ON INITIATIVE OF PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT, BUT LATER ON THEY RAN OUT OF PAPER. ESTIMATES HALF MILLION PESOS SO FAR ISSUED. THEIR MONEY WAS TYPEWRITTEN OR MIMEOGRAPHED. CLAIMS THAT EVERYTHING IS ABOVE BOARD ALTHOUGH HE HAS APPARENTLY NO CONNECTION WITH ISSUE OF MONEY. PROBLEMS OF PALAWAN ARE IMPENDING FAMINE

Comment:

In the most part these suggestions are basically sound and now being followed. One thing that PERALTA of course does not realize is that the men we are sending in are not subject to local political guerilla and enemy influences; that they are soldiers trained under the American flag and that they have a much broader education from school and experience than does the average Filipino Provinciano.

The submission of these suggestions however reflects a helpful attitude and they will be referred to our training Department for consideration in the preparation and instruction of future parties.

Precis:

In re FERTIG's desire for air support to relieve pressure on his position

Comment: Enemy's action was to be expected. It focuses attention on the danger from too great a concentration with consequent immobility, on bunching control elements in one area. I am taking care of this by sending into Western MINDANAO equipment and personnel to establish army and navy control radio stations capable of automatically taking over coordination of net and establishing immediate contact with this headquarters and PERTH when Western MINDANAO is under enemy attack. I am also establishing the main weather station in Western MINDANAO with local station on the AGUSAN. When that is accomplished we will establish similar facilities in Central MINDANAO (BUKIDNON) in order that we may be assured of continuous open channels of communication regardless

> Ofttimes it is evident that local commanders are too close to the forest to see the trees. Heretofore we have left too much to their judgement in the matter of communications and their judgement has failed at crucial times. 

Comment: There would be no particular advantage in having WISE evacuated here for personal report. He obviously is desirous of continuing in the discharge of the mission assigned to the PHILLIPS party. The MINDORO position will be re-established with facilities for weather observation and emergency radio control station just as soon as forward transport becomes available.

Meanwhile I will send in to PERALTA adequate supplies including radio equipment to permit WISE to re-establish communication and carry on pending the regrouping of the survivors of Maj. PHILLIPS: party and reinforcement.







FRANCO VERA REYES REPORTED TO BE C I O DASH 12, REPUTED TO BE JAP SPY . SOURCE OF INFO RAMSEY AGENT SUPPOSED TO BE OPERATING IN FORT SANTIAGO. RELIABILITY UNKNOWN. ONE RUMOR OF HIS ACTIVITY AS FOLLOWS: HE PRESENTED LETTER SUPPOSED TO HAVE COME FROM CMDR PARSONS TO MOTHER-IN-LAW OF PARSONS. OLD LADY THOUGHT IT GENUINE AND HENCE WAS SUPPOSED TO HAVE GUARANTEED HIS AUTHENTICITY AS MACARTHUR UNDERCOVER AGENT TO PROMINENT PEOPLE LIKE ELIZALDES AND OZAMIZ. REYES THEN SOLICITED CONTRIBUTIONS AND GOT THEM OKLATER ON, CONTRIBUTORS LANDED IN JAIL. WE CANNOT VOUCH FOR ANY MORE OF THIS RUMOR EXCEPT THAT WE RECEIVED REPORTS FROM OTHER AGENTS THAT ELIZALDE AND OZAMIZ WERE REPORTED IN JAIL LAST MARCH FOR UNKNOWN REASON. REYES REPORTED TO BE AT PRESENT DIRECTOR OF A JAP BANK IN MANILA CAPITALIZED AT THREE NAUGHT MILLION PESOS FROM A TAGALOG PERIODICAL. BEFORE WAR, HE WAS REPUTED TO BE SWILNDER AND FORGER.

The following are unaccounted for:

T/4 Vicente A. Agbayani T/4 Alfred A. Alberto

I regret that this further confirmation of PHILLIPS' death renders his survival increasingly doubtful. He was a gallant officer and found no hesitancy in volunteering for his mission to an area of extreme hazard. His first act upon arrival was to unfurl the American flag and nail it to the heights overlooking CORREGIDOR. Even the enemy had sufficient respect for his courage to render him burial with military honors (PERALTA's message of 28 April), an act I believe without precedent in the Pacific war.

The surviving men, originally hand picked, are now seasoned veterans and will be invaluable to us once we can move in reinforcements and re-establish our positions upon stronger foundations. I assure you that this is but a temporary set back, rather than a failure as described in G-2 note of 6 May, and that the area of North MINDORO will again be brought under

close observation and within our channels of communication as before.

The question of MINDORO is receiving the close attention of this Section.

Action recommended:

I recommend that consideration be given to the posthumous award of the Distinguished Service Cross to Major PHILLIPS. He made mistakes but led his men in reckless indifference to danger seeking only to advance the C in C's objectives as he understood them. Few officers of the American Army would have desired the PHILLIPS mission, fewer still would have accomplished it better. The knowledge of his presence spread to every part of LUZON and while possibly constituting his death warrant it did much to re-build the morale of the people through the realization thereby gained that General MacARTHUR was there represented by a military detachment -- that the American flag was once more aloft to defiantly mark an American position.

I hope that the courage manifested by Major PHILLIPS, which commanded the enemy's respect, will be adjudged to merit the recognition herein recommended.

It was then found that most of the guerillas were civilians inducted into service under some authority from PERALTA rather than unsurrendered USAFFE soldiers. Decision of the C in C was opposed to the encouragement of active guerilla resistance on MINDORO as it could serve no useful purpose but to the contrary would call upon the people retaliatory enemy action.

I cannot agree with the proposition that armed protection is essential to the preservation of a signal position. None of SMITH'S net elements have such protection, nor do many of our more isolated coast watcher stations. To the contrary armed protection on the scale possible but invites enemy action. The most we require is the friendly support rather than protection of the people.

Attached message while inviting authority and resources to develop the MINDORO guerilla movement makes no direct bid for same and I recommend no action be taken thereon.
