PASSIVE RESISTANCE AND SIMPLE SABOTAGE

1. ORDINARY CITIZENS - Annoy the enemy by:-

Not understanding when he asks for directions.
Neglecting to buy enemy controlled newspapers.
Whispering in his presence on the streets, in public vehicles, in cafes, etc.
Constantly reporting spies to the police on invented evidence or by anonymous letters.
Jamming the mails with letters. Empty, addressed unstamped envelopes.
Meaningless flashes at night.
Making it appear to "suspects" that their rooms have been searched, their correspondence opened and their telephone tapped.
Anonymous letters to wives, creating scandalous situations, Instigating rumours about a currency ramp.
Worrying authorities by repeatedly asking them about new restrictions, documents, etc. Filling in new forms wrongly.
Causing considerable annoyance to the Police by chalking meaningless signs on pavements, walls and doors. Doing it systematically, chalking a circle everywhere this week, next week a cross and the following week, a triangle. Getting all your friends throughout the country to make the same marks at the same time, avoiding entirely chalk marks which have any meaning; they will think you are using a code but will eventually discover the truth - you can then use other signs which will have a meaning.

Pouring water on the pavements outside shops on frosty mornings.
Dropping acids, glue, water or combustibles into letter boxes.
Burning coats with cigarettes.
Stealing clothes from cloak-rooms.
Simultaneous use of telephone by a large number of people. 25% of subscribers will usually blow out an exchange.

2. BARGEES - Annoy the enemy by:-

Handling your craft carelessly.
Causing delays and stoppages in canals and locks.
Running aground when passing any bad places.
Not pumping bilges too often.
Leaving swing or bascule bridges open (i.e. road closed).
Wasting water in locks by leaving sluices partly open.
Drawing the sluices before the lock gates are closed, thus causing them to crash together.
Applying unnecessary force or leverage to hand-operated machinery, sluices or levers.

3. BARMEN - Annoy the enemy by:-

Keeping for him beer that is slightly "off" and wine that is corked.
Mixing cocktails wrongly.
Excellent opportunities for spreading scandal.
Introducing laxatives or even poisons into his drink.

4. BARBERS - Annoy the enemy by:-

Being over-conscientious in attending to him, thereby causing delay.
Seeing that there are no magazines, etc. to relieve his tedium.
Being called away for other purposes and leaving him with a soapy face - having previously told him his skin is very sensitive.

5. BUS AND TRAM DRIVERS - Annoy the enemy by:-

Dislocating bus schedules.
Handling your bus carelessly in traffic.
Neglecting to stop when he wants to get on your vehicle.
Frequently going on when he wants to get off your vehicle.
Change points, cut cables, put pebbles on lines.
Immobilizing trams or fusing central power supply at rush periods in crowded streets.
Ensuring occasional breakdowns.
Throwing lengths of wire over the overhead cables - result fire or short-circuit.
(See also Motor Transport Workers.)

6. CARPENTERS - Annoy the enemy by:-

Carelessly constructing doors that do not fit, windows that are draughty.
Leaving nails and screws projecting, loose planks, safety sash cords.

Constructing important functional apparatus (chairs, book-shelves, tables, etc.) that will collapse when used.
Using unseasoned wood where possible.

7. CHEMISTS' ASSISTANTS. - Annoy the enemy by:-

Making slight "mistakes" in prescriptions - i.e., accidentally introducing Glauber's salts.
Creating embarrassing situations when asked for embarrassing commodities.

8. CINEMA WORKERS - Annoy the enemy by:-

Neglecting to give him a good seat.
Causing newcomers to jostle him in the dark.
Causing frequent breakdowns, flickering, bad focusing, speeding up or slowing down the rate of the film.

9. COOKS - Annoy the enemy by:-

Ensuring, where possible, that his food is vile.
Wasting coal, gas, water, etc.
Garnishing his dishes with poison or laxatives to taste.
Sabotageing all cooking apparatus.

10. DENTISTS. - Annoy the enemy by:-

Insisting on as many extractions and stoppings as possible.
By the application of cocaine, oil of cloves etc., ensuring that the patient leaves the surgery under the impression that the pain has disappeared - an impression that will speedily be dissipated after a few hours. This will cause an extra visit.
Drilling new holes where none were before.

11. DOCKSIDE WORKERS - Annoy the enemy by:-

When loading goods (especially munitions and military equipment) by crane, seeing that the goods are sometimes accidentally dropped from a great height, either on to the dockside or on to railways or into the sea.

12. DOCTORS. - Annoy the enemy by:-

Systematically exaggerating the serious condition of sick people and their wives.
Recommending the nastiest medicine.
Introducing laxatives or poison into their medicine having first warned patients that the effects will be unpleasant but beneficial in the long run.



13. ELECTRICIANS. - Annoy the enemy by:-

Being stupid about repair work.
Accidentally connecting bells the wrong way.
Making faulty connections.
Mistaking voltage of bulbs and inserting wrong ones.
Having the wrong type of fuse.
In workshops, arranging the wiring to cause frequent breakdowns.
Arranging fuses to cause fires.

14. FACTORY HANDS - Annoy the enemy by:-

Wasting as much time as possible.
Forgetting your tools.
Spending a long time in the lavatory.
In your keenness to work well, questioning your foreman and engineers too frequently.

14. FACTORY HANDS (continued)

Forgetting to oil or under-lubricating machinery.
Failing to report defects in material.
Mislaying finished batches of parts.
Frequently leaving motors running and lights on.
Ignoring a slack belt.
Leaving taps running when departing from factory.
Leaving open windows in textile and cotton mills with a view to reducing temperatures.
In cold storage, deliberately leaving open doors of cold storage chambers.
Keeping your skilled knowledge to yourself and never helping others by passing it on.

Screwing nuts too tightly when they will be expected to heat up in use, or too loosely when they will not be subjected to rising temperature.

Omitting split pins.

Using unsuitable oil for lubrication.

Accidentally spilling acid or alkali on machinery, particularly on electrical equipment. Making "mistakes" in the setting of adjusting valves and control gears.

Wearing out the chisels on turning lathes by using too much pressure - result: too large iron filings.

Applying too much heat to the product on which you are working, thus altering the degree of tempering with steel and iron greatly reducing the quality of the finished product such as pistons, fly wheels, gun-barrels, axles or shafts, rails, etc.

15. FARMERS. - Annoy the enemy by:-

Feeding seed-corn to your stock.
Sowing too deeply.
Letting machinery rust in the fields.
Getting crops in too late.
If possible, killing too much stock.

16. FIREMEN - Annoy the enemy by:-

Encouraging fires in occupied blocks, allowing flames to spread or, at least, soaking enemy belongings with water.
Misdirecting hose.
Over-shooting turnings in fire-engines.
Breaking down doors, walls and windows unnecessarily.
Dragging hose over rough ground or sharp projections.
Dropping debris on hose.
Blocking inlet valve of hose with waste.
Interfering with couplings, e.g. ~~not~~ ensuring that fire-engine goes into action without trailer pump.

17. FISHERMEN - Annoy the enemy by:-

Failing to comply with harbour regulations.
Accidentally tying up in the wrong place.
Scattering the fishing fleet to make the control more difficult.
Going into the harbour after dark and at irregular intervals.
Poisoning your fish before sale at the market.

18. FLORISTS. - Annoy the enemy by:-

Creating scandals by sending flowers to wrong people.

Dip the flowers in salt water before handing them over the counter; they will die suddenly in approximately twenty minutes.
Introducing too many pins and bits of wire into a bunch.

19. GUARDS ON TRAINS - Annoy the enemy by:-

Delaying the departure of trains.
Off-loading baggage at wrong stations.
Forgetting to switch on lights.
Conversing loudly and boringly outside compartments.
Locking doors to W.C.'s and between coaches, especially on long journeys.
Forgetting to wake sleepers at the right stations.
Ensuring that heating apparatus is frequently out of order in cold weather and on in hot weather.

Leave doors of empty carriages open when the train is in motion.

20. HOTEL WORKERS - Annoy the enemy by:-

Calling him too early or not at all.
Neglecting to turn on central heating except on hot days.
Muddling shoes, losing them or returning them to the wrong person.
Sending bogus telephone calls in the middle of the night, if possible, ordering them to report for duty.
Sending parcels containing delicate materials to Officers residing with their wives.
Forgetting to replace stair rods.
Omitting to wind clocks or regulate them when they are wrong.
Forgetting to tell him to "mind the step" when coming out of lifts (there should always be a step).
Forgetting to clean bedrooms; as soon as complaints are made they should be cleaned up so thoroughly that things get lost - e.g. studs, socks, etc.



20. HOTEL WORKERS (continued)

Forgetting to close windows of bedrooms when it starts to rain.
Occasionally losing keys of their bedrooms.
By giving every facility to burglars, pick-pockets and blackmailers in hotels - provided they confine their attention to the enemy.
Running baths that are either too hot or too cold. Forgetting to provide paper in W.C.'s.
Rarely answering the first ring.
Neglecting to air damp sheets.
Ensuring that hot water systems are out of order frequently.
Scorching clothes sent to be pressed or ironed, and returning them to the wrong persons.
Dropping large objects into the W.C.. and pulling the chain.
Damping their razor blades so that they become rusty.
Creating horrible smells in dining rooms by burning rubber, etc. in the grate.

21. HOUSEWIVES - Annoy the enemy by:-

Giving him bad service if he is billeted on you.
Spoiling salvage arrangements by putting waste in wrong bins.
Accidentally burning salvage material.

22. LOCK GATESMEN. - Annoy the enemy by:-

Being careless in the handling of your gates.
Causing hold-ups at the locks.
Wasting water by bad handling of the sluices.
Forcing hand gear too far.



23. MINERS. - Annoy the enemy by:-

Raising smaller quantities.
Sending up quantities of dead rock with the coal or iron ore.

24. MOTOR TRANSPORT WORKERS. - Annoy the enemy by:-

Careless handling of your vehicles in traffic.
"Not noticing" punctures and driving on flat tires.
Never going the nearest way if you know a longer one.
Frequently driving into the wrong entrance.
Not fixing your waterproof covers too securely or ensuring that they leak.
Letting oil drop on roadway.
Running your lorry, particularly in bottom gear, with a nearly empty pump (Be careful to refill with oil before returning at the end of your journey).
Greasing fan-belt.
Draining radiators.
Draining lubrication systems.
Contaminating fuel with water, sugar paraffin, urine, etc.
Puncturing radiators.
Contaminating lubricating oil with paraffin.

24. MOTOR TRANSPORT WORKERS (continued)

Placing a nail inside a match box and putting the match-box in front of the back tire of a stationery car; the nail goes smartly in and the box falls off.

Placing a block of wood or potato up the exhaust pipe.

Removing float out of the float chamber of the carburettor; (not one repair shop in a hundred will have one to spare).

Removing the ~~rot~~ and replacing the distributor head; this takes longer to discover.

Inserting a piece of paper between the make and break on the magneto.

Locking or loosening brake on the wheel.

25. MUSICIANS - Annoy the enemy by:-

Playing out of tune.

Introducing a few bars of blatantly non-Aryan music.

Playing very loud when he is sitting near the big drum.

Repeatedly altering the tempo.

Playing badly and un^rhythmically.

Where he has taken possession of theatres or music halls and installed his bands or orchestras, wedging masticated chewing gum into the bottom of all brass instruments, and dropping it inside the piccolos, oboes, clarinets, bassoons and flutes - preferably as far away from the joints as possible; the joint effect at a symphony concert will be devastating.

26. NEWSPAPER WORKERS - Annoy the enemy by:-

Delaying production

Forgetting to correct mistakes in proofs.

Making errors in typesetting.

Accidentally putting blocks upside down.

Judiciously using wrong captions.

Spelling names wrongly.

Arranging misprints calculated to make him look ridiculous.

27. PAINTERS - Annoy the enemy by:-

Frequently spilling paint, and knocking over your paintpot .

Leaving ladders in places likely to dislocate either pedestrian or road traffic.

Forgetting to mark up "wet paint".

Using far more paint than necessary, when painting property thereby increasing cost.

Mixing paraffin with your paint so that it will not dry.

28. PLATE LAYERS - Annoy the enemy by:-

Being careless in tightening up bolts on chairs and fish-plates.

Occasionally losing a few bolts.

29. PLUMBERS - Annoy the enemy by:-

Leaving joints leaky.
Using washers that will quickly deteriorate.
Always being too busy - especially in an emergency.
Forgetting your tools.
Making the water supply unsatisfactory.
Causing flooding by means of punctured floats or upwardly bent levers on ball cocks.
Seeking opportunities to connect the sewage system with the drinking water.

30. POLICEMEN - Annoy the enemy by:-

Forgetting to report fires.
Misunderstanding requests for directions.
Failing to notice when he wants to cross traffic.
Frequently holding up staff cars.
Overlooking offences against the enemy's law.
Giving misleading reports and orders.
Misdirecting traffic.
Giving every assistance to criminals of all sorts for operating.

31. PORTERS - Annoy the enemy by:-

Loading mail and baggage slowly.
Handling your truck carelessly so that mail bags, etc. fall between the train and the platform.
Making "mistakes" with the registration of luggage - e.g. incorrect labels.
Misdirecting concerning times and platforms of trains.
Omitting to close carriage doors properly.
Putting luggage on wrong train.
Using leaky waterproof sheets, on trucks.
Smearing oil on the door handles and footplates.
Effacing markings on baggage.
Changing labels on trucks.
Muddling labels on luggage.

32. POSTMEN - Annoy the enemy by:-

Delivering mail to the wrong door.
Do your round a different way each day so that he will not know what time to expect the post.
Delaying delivery in all possible ways.

33. RAILWAY WORKERS - Annoy the enemy by:-

See Railway Sabotage.

34. ROAD REPAIRERS - Annoy the enemy by:-

Causing hold-ups by taking a long time over your repairs.
Leaving sharp tools and materials about, especially on corners.
Using wrong materials.
Making bad repairs.
Ensuring that your red danger signals are frequently out, at night.

35. SAILORS - Annoy the enemy by:-

Damaging marine internal combustion engines as in road transport.
If steam, draining boilers, jamming or misadjusting safety valves and other steam valves.
Cutting ropes and cables.
Damaging wireless apparatus.
Jamming or cutting cables of steering gear.
Sinking vessels by opening seacocks, especially at night.
Blocking pumps by inserting waste down "in-take" pipes and jamming valves.
Blocking speaking tube between bridge and engine room - smashing it, if it is a telephone.
Demagnetizing compass or throwing it out many degrees by concealing a bar of steel or iron in its neighborhood.
Fusing lights frequently.

36. SEWER MEN - Annoy the enemy by:-

Causing traffic congestion by frequent removal of manhole covers.
Upsetting ventilation conditions in sewers.
Dropping bricks, cement, etc. into sewer pipes.

37. SHOP ASSISTANTS - Annoy the enemy by:-

Not understanding his requests.
Stupidly bring him the wrong goods for selection.
Making mistakes in address when despatching goods.
Giving wrong change.
Being obliging and doing good trade only after there has been good news for your country.
Damaging goods before despatch, and, on receiving complaints, blaming the postal or transport authorities.

38. SHUNTERS - Annoy the enemy by:-

Frequently over-shooting the switches.
Leaving trucks with brakes off.
Shunting trucks on the wrong trains.
Leaving couplings loose.
Setting switches wrongly.
Swapping destination labels on trucks.

39. TAXI DRIVERS - Annoy the enemy by:-

Mistaking instructions.
Making unnecessary detours.
Drawing up short of or past the "fare" and his destination.

40. TELECOMMUNICATIONS - Annoy the enemy by:-

Making mistakes in the delivery of telegrams.
Loitering on the way to delivering telegrams.
Giving frequent wrong numbers.
Delaying putting their calls through.
Forgetting to disconnect them.
Frequently cutting them off "accidentally".

40 TELECOMMUNICATIONS (continued)

Destroying test desk records and altering resistance, values at exchanges.
Driving pins and nails into cables.
Pulling down lines with ropes, attached to cars or lorries.
Cutting supporting wires so that lines fall down on the arms and "short".
Sawing through posts.
Driving nails into cables and pouring water in the holes.
Boring holes in the base of telegraph poles and pouring acid into the holes, causing eventual rotting.
Removing rubber disk from under diaphragm of receiver, and substituting a round piece of paper.

41. TICKET AGENCY CLERKS - Annoy the enemy by:-

Not understanding him when he asks for information.
Making mistakes when issuing the ticket.
Giving two (or more) tickets for the same seat.
Accidentally destroying printed tickets, thereby being forced to issue written substitutes which will cause infuriating delays.

42. TICKET INSPECTORS - Annoy the enemy by:-

Not understanding when he asks for information.
Directing him to leave the train at the wrong station.
Making mistakes with tickets - e.g. returning or removing the wrong portion.
Making repeated inspections.

43. TYPISTS - Annoy the enemy by:-

Leaving out or mis-spelling words in letters, invoices, orders and forms of all kinds,
General non-co-operativeness.
Burning papers.
Filing wrongly.
Inflicting minor damage on typewriters, duplicators, dictaphones, etc.



44. WAITERS - Annoy the enemy by:-

Making mistakes in his order.
Giving him very slow service.
Serving best portions to others.
Serving hot meals on cold and dirty plates, and cold meals on hot and dirty plates.

45. WASHERWOMEN - Annoy the enemy by:-

Losing, shrinking and muddling clothes.
Tearing clothes.
Scorching clothes when ironing.

46. WATER SERVICE EMPLOYEES - Annoy the enemy by:-

Losing your turn-cock key when it is required.
Making mistakes in cutting off or leaving on the water supply.

1. On the subject of counterfeiting, Commander PARSONS said in his report of 20 August:

"Regarding the rapid redemption of guerilla and "emergency" circulating notes, this is very important to avoid the counterfeiting of some of the currency. Due to the limited facilities available and conditions under which the guerilla and emergency currency was printed, ordinary precautions to prevent counterfeiting could not be followed. As soon as normal conditions return and facilities may be made available to uncouth individuals, the bills could be counterfeited without difficulty. The best insurance against this would be to ban the circulation of all types of currency (as noted above), and order the redemption of all currencies within a period of thirty days. It will admittedly be quite a task to redeem all currencies within such a comparatively short time, but it should be attempted to avoid the possibilities of counterfeiting."

2. Commander WILSON said in his report of 11 May 43 to Pres. QUEZON:

"Counterfeiting: - Counterfeiting is done at the present time but apparently on a small scale. Every effort is being taken by the General Headquarters, 10th M.D. to curtail counterfeiting. However, it is my opinion that as there are so many different varieties of emergency notes in circulation and it being a very simple manner to duplicate the notes now in circulation, it is very possible that before the termination of the war there might be quite a number of these counterfeit notes put in circulation. It would be most likely a little difficult for the proper authorities to detect the counterfeit notes from the legal issue. The poor quality of the paper indirectly aids the counterfeiter for, being easily mutilated, it makes it difficult to distinguish the genuine from the fake notes. The exact quantity of emergency notes put in circulation is difficult to determine. However, His Excellency, Pres. QUEZON, authorized the Prov. of Mindanao and the Visayas to print approximately twenty million pesos. I believe the Cebu Emergency Currency Board must have printed in the neighborhood of 10 million pesos as they were also supplying most of Mindanao with currency during March and early April, 1942. The Mindanao Emergency Currency Board issued about 1,700,000 pesos and at the present time the revived Mindanao Emergency Currency Board has printed and issued 1,800,000.Pesos."

3. The summary of economic and political conditions 15 September 43 to 15 January 44, contained no reference to counterfeiting whatsoever.

4. No report at any time has been received by this headquarters suggestive of counterfeiting even on a small scale -- as a matter of fact, I can find no reference to the subject in any of our signal or written communications from the Philippines.

5. As a consequence of the above, there is not an iota of evidence to support the conclusion that "counterfeiting of emergency currency is getting to a serious point," and, I believe, President QUEZON should be so informed, lest it appear that this headquarters is not fully alive to the facts actually involved. At most, Cmdr. PARSONS' reference above to counterfeiting was a warning against delay in redemption following the war -- Cmdr. WILSON's, mainly speculative, with little basis in fact.

6. Recommend dispatch of reply to Pres. QUEZON substantially as follows:

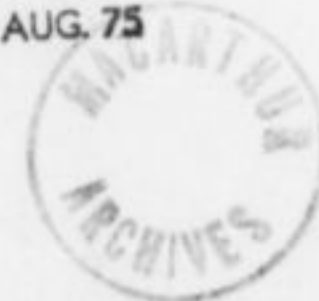

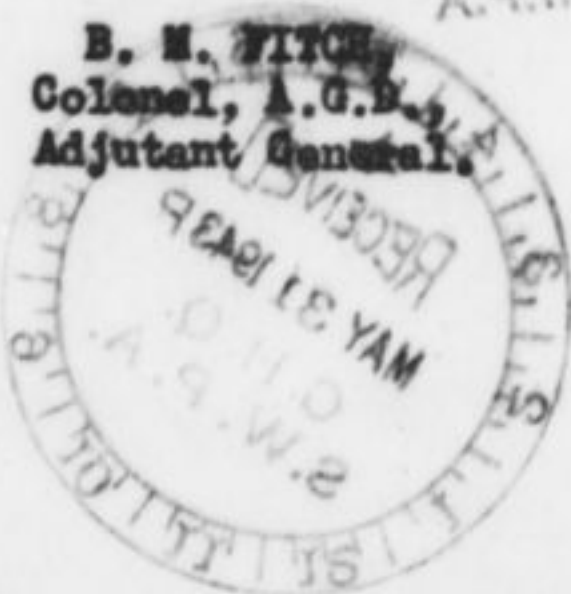
