Your number 18, what in hell have you done with my signalled supply requests for past three months. Your supply vessels s far as I concerned were cook tours. I have been on my knees for past 60 days pleading for gas and oil and other items enable me just keep open. Check up on my past signals and you will see what I mean. Fyi on first so called supply vessel received following, weather equipment, nine cases ration, two cases aspirin tablets, one carton cigarettes. Second supply vessel unloaded one ton junk out of which salvaged two radios. It sounds like Whitney is back on Job if so three cheers from Mindoro and church services your benefit.

To enable me set up APO and Bataan Stations without further delay can you paradrop ATR4A radio batteries and tubes and crystals for three BZ's requested, our number 227. Signals will be two red panels on beach plus two smoking fires, articles to be dropped 100 meters inland from panels which will be on spot described, our number 228. Our security would not be jeopardized.

Rowe to General Macarthur: "Sir, since Colonel Whitney left Brisbane my supplies have been ridiculous. Like your good self in past have tried to do best by improvising but some items cannot be improvised. I have always realized importance of my assignment and assure you have done and will continue to do best to attain your objectives which incidentally are also mine 'to go home'. Request one shipment supplies which will be small but will include what I need for 100 days, receipt of which will enable me assume full responsibility for supplying you with information I know you need from this area. "List of supplies necessary w will be sent on your request."

My headquarters now one mile east Abra De Ilog. Have not received radio supplies although expect same in two days. Present workable radios at headquarters and Manila. Three days after equipment arrives will have stations at following places, San Jose, Maricaban Island, Lubang Island, Naujan, Marinduque, and Bataan. Parties either already at the these places or ready to go. Have around 300 trained men hal half of which armed with 80 carbines, two .30 cal mach guns, ten tommies, one .50 cal mach gun and misc .30 caliber rifle and hand grenades.

I need gas and oil. Can you paradrop one drum of each at main station immediately. If you have no parachutes drop it in the water. if you cannot supply so advise and I will make a raid and get some lend lease from the Japs Please give me break and answer yes or no immediately as my batteries low and whole network endangered.

Spark plugs for chargers, radio testers, frequency meter, batteries for 288 radios, binoculars 12 power with 2 over 12 if available, spare parts kit for all our radio sets including receiver power packs, fuses, battery clips, extensiontwisted, power cord, 2 loud speakers for 3BZ, parallel lamp cords, electric tapes and 1.0 MFD 2,000 volts, 1.0 MFD 1,000 volts condensers. On supplies listed please include following: Three field telephones with one drum number eight combat telephone wire two battery chargers. Please also send all Philippine Pesos Jap currency now almost worthless and dollar supply running low. One Val Crashed, burned yesterday at Mamburao.

Found Nicholson an old friend and anxious cooperate each other and you. Have detailed two companies subject to his call for any mission. Also working up arrangement to consolidate all intelligence to be sent direct to southwest Pacific with copy to you and credited both parties.

Your nr 16. Plain panels will be displayed as instructed on north side of north Pandan Island, same position as previous.
