Sub landed safely funds and supplies for colonel Suares and for this station on 17th Oct. Morale of men very high now.

Tawitawi

Cases containing mails and propaganda each weighing 100 pounds, not received. Funds not found in any of the cases. All cases unloaded from submarine, opened in my presence. Reference my msg 05th Oct this year handed to submarine Capt PAR 1 and 16 four our urgent needs.

Reference your Number 40:

We are ready to receive supplies with eight mative sailboats. Signals and security will be followed accordingly.

Suarez reports that if 50 power telescope furnished in next supplies his headquarters can cover Alice channel as well as Sibutu. Reports on Sibutu mined areas is conflicting but being investigated.

Suarez to GHQ:

Reference your msg nr 37 priority follows: Philippine money. Arms needed: 400 carbines, 12 browning automatic rifles, 12 Thompson submachine guns and ammunition, eight cases Hand Grenades. Clothing: 400 each of coveralls, mosquito bars, jungle boots, service caps, blankets, drawers, undershirts. Three rolls khaki.

Priority supplies for station FT9. Supplies to be marked YG itemized, follows:

One ton each of rice and field ration, enough canned foods, sugar, coffee, cigarettes, lard, soap, salt, flour. Seasonal north wind for three months after november makes travel small crafts impossible northern coast Tawitawi. Earliest delivery supplies not later middle november. Security rendezvous Tongehatan Pt. Alternate Sites: Languyan Pt and Maraning.

One radio on rendezvous site will flash security warnings to you. Two white disc two meters in diameter on top ten foot pole hundred meters apart on prominent Pts rendezvous be used. Have blinkers. Will use it after sunset to

signal sub if adviseable. Additional supplies needed: three ATR4 radio with crystals, batteries, three walkie talkies, three powerful field glasses, three rolls NEI antenna, one bottle battery acid. twelve batteries for 288 receiver, twelve flashlights, batteries and bulbs. Power cords for T-50-M, crystal tare (5235) and four sets neon bulbs for NEI3, emery cloths and papers, antennae ropes and pulleys, 10 gallons lubrications oil SAE-20. One weather vane, one barometer, ruled encoding papers, two dozen jungle boots, two dozen jungle bags complete gears each, 24 mosquito bars, propaganda magazines, sewing kits and posters, six contour and two navigation maps of Sulu, 12 cartridge belts, 18 pouches for BAR ammunitions, six rolls white cloth, three role boat sail, three sets kitchen pots. Desires arrangement be made to separate

supplies marked YG from those intended for Gol Suarez to facilitate unloading.

Reference your number 27 acknowledged receipt young to Ind. Regarding delivery of priority supplies and reinforcing party sent over in my favor feasibility of situation now recommended. Japs outposts recalled to Bongao, rest sent Davao, sites northern coast safe most convenient due to prevailing season south wind. advise Z-five if okayed. Can inform you rendezvous then. Col. Suarez safe, rumored at Maranino with 80 soldiers. SIR Regtl funds and excess arms taken back by sub be sent over with regt favor only means of reorganization. Exact date your delivery please inform me two weeks in advance so can prepare sailboats. Reporting death Generosolababa

April recommended soldier my outfit.

Chester's field rations consumed already by Lt. Col. Suarez outfit. Has to hunt for food to live daily.

Two rush messages for Hammer not delivered him.
Submarine left rendezvous before special messenger
arrived. Party arrived this camp with arms, ammunition
and little supples. One Officer this regt. left on Sub
when whe submerged due to presence of enemy patrol.
No funds received. We need this badly. Supplies allotted
us were not all taken. Supplies received are like god
sent aid to us all.

TAWITAWI, Sulu

Referring to my reply yesterday 8 Feb Forgot to state MANUK MANKA, unsafe for landing supplies. Too near Japs outpost at BONGAO & SIMUNUL. For security delivery of supplies be done at night we will use six small crafts instead of 3. For security supplies unloaded be done once in few minutes and paddle to shallow waters free fr Japs interceptions. Light panel signals to be used approaching vessel.

Supplies needed: Firearms, ammunition, funds, medical supplies and clothing. Three small crafts with sail and men to handle unloading of supplies already arranged. Regt (rest?) party headed by Lt. SABTALUSMAN. Sites selected having clear approach and deep water to shore sheltered frenemy. Southeastern part and middle part back of BILATAN ISLANDS or MONTABUAN IS behind DALO DALO Village.

Still expecting supplies, Regt lack funds.

SUPPLIES TAWITAWI, (Young)

Please include 5 Jungle Mosquito nets hammock type to party supplies. Plenty mosquitos.

Tawi Tawi

First priority send us firearms ammunition medical supplies fund in British Borneo Philippine Dutch Javanese currency and clothing. You can limit the 6 months party supplies and ration money send spare parts anode and filament vibrators one or two one Dutch set storage battery 24 volts, 5 Jungle flashlights with battery and smokes.

Troops intact. Send us arms, ammunitions, money, medicines for the Regt: Send separate party supplies that will last six months if party stays longer including ration money. Safe places landing supplies back of Billatan Islands, SI Tangkay, Lara Pt. and Ubanak (Ubian?) Would like to join Filipino Division San Francisco as per order from that Headquarters.
