





MEMO FOR RECORD:

- 1. CINCFE msg CX 56821 of 26 June directed CG MARBO to load available cargo on USAT LSTs 898 and 802 and sail the vessels for Yokohama immediately. This msg also advised that in the event the FS 288 was not urgently required at MARBO to sail this vessel to Yokohama. These vessels were ordered to Yokohama in view of the anticipated need for American manned landing craft.
- 2. MARBO msg SP 9915 MBYTR of 27 June instructed the 802 at sea to change course and proceed to Yokohama immediately if no cargo aboard. In the event cargo was aboard, notify all addressees tonnage, destination, and ETA Guam. This msg also advised that the 898 was due in Guam on 1 July and MARBO planned a full load of Navy cargo for Yokohama discharge, MARBO msg further advised that the FS 288 was not operational. Immediate action was being taken by MARBO to make the FS 288 ready for sea.
- 3. MARBO msg S 9918 MBYTR of 27 June advised that the LST 802 was unable to decode MARBO msg S 9915. The ETA of this vessel at Guam is 1 July and MARBO recommended that CINCFE take whatever action deemed necessary direct to the vessel.
- 4. The 802 and 898 are being ordered to proceed for Yokohama without loading cargo at MARBO since it is anticipated the need for these vessels will develop soon. Since 7 days sailing time is required for an LST to travel from Guam to Yokohama, it was deemed advisable to sail these vessels empty. The Deputy Transportation Officer has directed that the FS 288 and the LT 455 be brought to Yokohama as soon as possible for use by 8th Army as required.
- 5. CG FENF (Lt Col Meehan) reported that a requirement existed at Guam for lift of approximately 2,000 M/T of high priority cargo for Okinawa discharge. DEPCOMSTSWESPAC advised on 30 June that COMSTS had offered the USS Oglethorpe, ETA Guam 1 July, for use in the Far East in lieu of the O'Connell. This offer: has been accepted. Therefore it is planned to load the Navy cargo at Guam for Japan and the AF cargo for Okinawa aboard the Oglethorpe and sail the vessel for Japan via Okinawa. Separate action will be initiated on this subject.

At 0900 6 B-26 a/c took off but mission aborted due to weather.

Nine B-26 aircraft took off at 0720, target tanks, claim 1 tank destroyed,

North Korean armed forces launched an extensive invasion of South Korea at 0400 hours, 25 June, employing an estimated four Peoples Army (PA) divisions, three Border Constabulary (BC) brigades, and 70 tanks. A North Korean artille ry barrage on Ongjin was followed by infantry attacks on the Ongjin Peninsula, in the Kaesong area, the Chunchon area, and amphibious landings on the east coast. Preliminary reports indicate that North Korea committed to action the 3d BC Brigade on the Ongjin Peninsula; a PA division, possibly the 1st, in the Munsan area, and possibly the 3d in the Pochon-Uijongbu corridor; the 2d Division reportedly is in the Chunchon area; the 1st BC Brigade and an umidentified division on the east coast, in the Kangnung area; and the 7th BC Brigade in the vicinity of Pochon. Another North Korean division reportedly is being held in reserve near the 38th Parallel in the vicinity of Sindongni (990-1695), opposite the right flank of the South Korean 1st. The South Korean 17th Regiment on the Ongjin Peninsula withdrew to the south. Kaesong was seized almost immediately by one North Korean regiment, while a tank company, one armored infantry battalion, and antitank units, with approximately 20 guns, drove south along the Pochon-Uijongbu corridor. South Korean forces in the corridor withdrew to the main line of resistance. Reports state that North Korean tanks penetrated to within five miles of Uijongbu, and that 27 tanks were approximately 14 miles north of the city at 1800 hours, 25 June. Subsequent reports state that from 12-20 enemy tanks have been destroyed, just north of Uijangbu; it is believed by U.S. officials in Secul that South Korean suicide teams may have been employed to destroy them, since such teams have been dispatched for that purpose. It is estimated that the attack in the Chunchon area was carried out by one North Korean division, reinforced with strong artillery support, and approximately 10 tanks. The attack along the east coast was carried out in two operations -- an attack across the 38th Parallel by an estimated two battalions of the 1st BC Brigade, and an amphibious landing by the remainder of the brigade, approximately 10 miles south of Kangnung. Numerous other landings reportedly were made along the east coast of South Korea.

On the afternoon of 25 June four North Korean planes strafed Kimpo airfield, in five separate runs, causing damage to buildings, fuel supplies, and a U.S. C-54. The planes also strafed Seoul Airfield, inflicting slight damage on seven South Korean Air Force T-6-type aircraft. For all practical purposes, South Korea has no defense against air attacks.

Four South Korean divisions, the 1st, 6th, 7th, and 8th, presently are defending the main line of resistance, while the 2d Division has been moved from its home station at Taejon to the vicinity of Seoul. South Korean naval units are moving out from Pusan to prevent further landings along the east coast.

South Korean officials and the armed forces reportedly are handling the situation calmly and with ability.






