MEMO FOR RECORD:

1. SS Bel Jeanne was originally scheduled to go on berth 30 Aug for lift of 20 flatcars and 50 tankers from Nagoya, 3 locomotives and 25 flatcars from Kobe, and 2 locomotives from Tokuyama to Pusan; and 15 locomotives and tenders from Pusan to Japan. CICFEMSG CG 62062 of 4 Sep cancelled above routing and scd Bel Jeanne for Manila-Japan LCM lift. Msg advised CG JLCOM and CG Army Eight that vessel for lift of railroad rolling stock would be nominated soonest.

2. FEAF (Lt Col Meehan) advised 10 Sep that tankers were urgently required in Korea to transport jet fuel. Tankers now avil in Korea are capable of lifting only 60% of requirements.

3. ISTS has made avil time chartered Alma Victory, EM Nagoya 15 Sep, to lift tankers and flatcars. According to ISTS estimates, ves should be able to load all Nagoya requirements (50 tankers and 20 flatcars). Any space remaining after loading Nagoya requirements will be negligible, therefore no arrangements are being made for vessel to load at Kobe.

4. Part 2, action msg, is to inform CG Army Eight that 15 locomotives and tenders which would have been backloaded on Bel Jeanne cannot be loaded aboard Alma Victory, as vessel is incapable of handling.

5. Action further suspended on T/J 20524 until 18 Sep pending nomination of a vessel for remaining railroad rolling stock.

1. CG FEA msg AX 4918 MAT-SUP-T of 29 Aug requested shipping to lift approximately 10,000 M/T avammo from Guam to Okinawa.
2. CINCFE msg CX 61947 of 2 Sep advised FEA that shipping would be provided as soon as possible.
3. CINCFE msg CX 61561 of 29 Aug requested RYCCM to advise the date they could handle this shipment.
4. RYCCM msg YX 21573 of 2 Sep recommended the shipment of avammo be scheduled to arrive Okinawa 30 Sep, msg further requested that cargo be block stowed wherever possible to facilitate discharge.
5. Request for lift placed with MSTS/ESPAC on 2 Sep. MSTS/ESPAC on 6 Sep nominated the Yankee Pioneer ETA Guam 14 Sep.
6. PORDIR GUAM msg 040448Z to DEPCOMSTS/ESPAC advised that due to the shortage at Guam of dunnage and sheathing lumber for ammo lift it was recommended that:
 - a. Additional ammo ships scheduled Guam be fully sheathed and supplied with dunnage.
 - b. That SS Rutgers Victory be returned Guam for removal of lumber supplied. This vessel lifted AF bombs from Guam to Yokohama.
7. DEPCOMSTS/ESPAC msg 050512Z requested that 2d F Mei Port be directed to leave all dunnage aboard Rutgers Victory since vessel would return to Guam for lift to ZI. Radio, CINCFE, CX 60240, 16 Aug, to CG RYCOM, in part, requested that a study be initiated immediately, from a Transportation, Ordnance and Air Force standpoint, to determine the maximum ammo handling capacity at Okinawa with equipment facilities and labor available, and that CINCFE be advised as soon as possible.

2. Due to no reply, radio, CINCFE, CX 61561, 29 Aug, requested results of study be furnished, advising maximum ammo handling capacity.

3. Radio, CG RYCOM, Y 21608, 5 Sep, advises as follows: "Due to present 37 deadline of all available land transportation, and no immediate indication of improvement, impossible to handle more than 30,000 tons ammo per month."

4. Reasons for deadline are not known. Major Doriot, Ord Section, advises that requisitions for spare parts needed by FEC major commands are now placed on the ZI instead of on JLCOM. Ordnance may be able to supply a limited quantity of a particular item as an emergency measure from JLCOM stocks, if sufficient quantities are on hand to fully supply the needs of Korea and Japan.

5. Coordination: Major Doriot, Ordnance Section, GHQ;
Concurrence: None.

6. Action completed on Trans Jo 19928 (Radio, CINCFE, CX 60240, 16 Aug), and suspended until 18 Sep on Trans Jo 20691 (Radio, CG RYCOM, Y 21608, 5 Sep 50).

1. CO US Mil Port Manila msg R 1111 DMPT-T of 8 Sep advises Manila has on hand 2770 M/T for Yokohama and 2040 M/T for Okinawa, and requests advice when vessel can be expected to arrive Manila.
2. CINCFE msg CX 62516 of 9 Sep, to Chief JUSMAG Manila and CG PHILCOM AF, dispatched prior to receipt of R 1111 above, nominated Longview Victory for lift of equipment of Philippine Expeditionary Forces from Manila to Pusan, and stated vessel should be also loaded with surplus vehicles for Yokohama.
