URMSG C 61528. Reported use tear gas. Pol statement Col Yun Tchi-Woong, Surgeon Gen, Korea Army. ROK unit involved 1st Div, 11th Regt, 2d Bn, 17th Co, 1st Platoon. Time 1800 K 27 Aug. Location hill between Bak-Gak and Chel-Gak (1152.2-1464). Platoon moving up hill contacted enemy below crest, enemy threw hand grenade which fell about 5 feet left of point (2 men) and gave off cloud of pale yellow smoke from one end accompanied by fizzing sound. They at once began shed tears and mucous was discharged nose and felt chest discomfort. Stated rest platoon also effected. Col Woong saw men morning 28 Aug eyes showed signs conjunctivitis but stated tears, mucous and chest condition cleared 2 to 4 hours later. Grenade was not recovered as platoon retreated down hill. Relation of wind direction to platoon and grenade not clear. Col Woong stated that yellow cloud clung to ground and was seen by other ROK forces in area. From symptoms outlined appears grenade was tear gas. Pale yellow color possibly type of agent used, burning mixture or chlorine incorporated in grenade filling. ROK instructed in future secure munitions forward immediately EUSAK.

Due to inability to secure verified reports from confidential sources sent into the area of B-29 strike of 16 Aug, a reliable estimate of results cannot be made at this time. Two reports from such sources state that the strike did damage to material and personnel targets in the bombed area. Although these reports were made under circumstances that precluded any collaboration both reports contained extravagant claims that cannot be verified and are of doubtful accuracy. It is possible that the strike did cause an undetermined damage to material, personnel and installation as well as some disorganization and may have delayed temporarily en stock on Taegu. Several en radio intercepts have indicated that units were within the strike area and it is possible that damage is more extensive than can be assessed at this time.





I have received your instructions including those delivered in person by Brig General Wright, Asst Chief of Staff G-3 PEC. These instructions have been put into effect and the matter discussed with Ambassador Muccio. There was never any intention on my part to interfere with any sovereign civil function of the Government of the Republic of Korea. It should be stated however, that limited and cursory investigation lends credence to the belief that a considerable number of these executions were performed by and apparently at the direction of the Army of the Korean Republic. Since these United Nations Forces are under the operational command of General MacArthur through his designated representative in Korea, there appears to be a command responsibility as to the propriety and legality of these executions.

Request action be taken to procure helicopters and pilots for each div, corps, Army Hq, on the fol basis: Passenger helicopter (Sikorsky HO 3 S, or equivalent for a lift of 400 pounds with pilot, or pilot and 2 passengers): 4 each division; 2 each corps hq; 3 each Army Hq. Helicopters capable of carrying 1600 pounds of freight (Sikorsky HRP Type, or equivalent, as flown by Marine Sqdn HMX 1, Quantico Virginia): 3 each div; 2 each corps hq, 2 each Army Hq.

"Part 2. Helicopters are urgently need for communication liaison, and supply of troops in Korea, with particular emphasis on mountain operation. The supply and evacuation of isolated groups in mountainous and inaccessible areas; the expeditious establishing and proper logistical support of VHF teams on high locations; aerial reconnaissance for tactical units, to include arty fire observation; the laying of wire lines from the air, in the operation of courier service in zones unsuitable for L Type aircraft are some of the many uses to which the helicopters can be put, with results which will many times repay its original cost in the instance of establishment of VHF relay stations, it is estimated that installation time can be decreased by 75%, and further, that many now inaccessible locations could be used, thus greatly improving VHF communication service. Subject is evacuation of patients from Pusan. Request contained in reference B specified Fukuoka as discharge port. The HMS Maine cannot dock at Fukuoka. The discharge of patients "in the stream" is not desirable. This vessel will be used for evacuation to other Japanese ports. It is estimated the Muller, Keathley and Maine, together with expected air lift, will fulfill requirements through 30 Sept 50. The Keathley and Muller, while considered to be a satisfactory expedient, present considerable difficulty in the loading and discharge of patients; therefore, request provision for shipping, as feasible, that can more efficiently handle patients. Further, in order to provide for the anticipated increased lift into Fukuoka beginning 1 Oct 50, it is requested that 2 ambulance vessels, with maximum draft not to exceed 22 feet be assigned for shuttle service between Pusan and Fukuoka at the earliest possible date, prior to 1 Oct 50. This requirement is in addition to vessels Benevolent and Repose, which will be used for purposes other than ferrying to Fukuoka.
