CG SFPL (OSD) msg TCSFP 4632 GO, 12 Aug 50, to CINCFE, info CG Eighth Army and 6SUSA advises that amno tonnages to FECCM during August approximate 135,000 ltons, increasing to 170,000 ltons for Sept and Oct, and further states that to determine releases, and loading intelligently, request CINCFE furnish a priority table indicating priorities as between destinations, for example, Ckinawa, Yokohama, and Pusan, and by services, Army or Air Force. Asquisitions as currently received given no guidance as to these priorities. The msg further requested CINCFE to review ammo tonnages that can be discharged at each port and advise OSD at SFFL. The balance of the msg is on Air Force and Omdnance (Army) logistical supply matters. Action on this msg is assigned to G-4.
- 2. In a meeting conducted by G-4 and attended by representatives of G-4, GHC; Ord Sec, GHQ, and Eighth Army, Trans Sec, GHQ and Lighth Army; FLAF, FEAMCOM and CONMAVFE, the following tonnage figures were given for ammo destined FEC ports based on requisitions submitted on the ZI by the Air Force and Army:

Army: 354,000 ltons from this date to Oct 31, split 2/3 to Korea, 1/3 to Japan. Japan tonnages by depot are 15% Ozono, 70% Ikego, and 15% Loeper. Okinawa tonnages are normal resupply and therefore negligible. Korea monthly tonnages are 200,000 ltons beginning November.

Air Force: 120,000 ltons for August to Japan, split by depot locations - 2/3 Yokota area, 1/3 Yamada (Kyushu area). 75,000 to 100,000 ltons September and thereafter split as above. 30,000 ltons conthly for Okinawa, this rate more or less constant. Korea tonna es are negligible but may be increased dependent on the tactical situation.

3. Trans Sec is delegated responsibility to furnish discharge capacities by ports. Requests for present port ammo discharge capacities with requests for detailed information for expanding present capacities are bein submitted by separate communication to CG RIGOLA, Okinawa, and CG LUSAK, Korea.

TOTE FOR RECORD: 1. Msg G 20973 ADVESI from CG EUSAK requested comparative technical data of SCR 784 and a Set designated as "Q-3" Queries by 2nd Div Artillery personnel in Korea prompted this msg.

2. The complete absence of technical data in the msg rendered impossible the identification of the Q-3 Set mentioned. Also, queries to Mavy and the Air Force did not reveal the existence or possible identification of this equipment.

3. Since the Q-3 Set was mentioned in connection with the SCR 784. it was assumed that the Q-3 Set was used for the same purpose and was similar in basic design to the SCR 784. Based on the assumption that the Q-3 nomenclature was incomplete, it was decided that the only possible resemblmoe to known military equip was with the AN/TPQ-3 Radar Set used for mortar location purposes.



- 2. The effect of the instant revision is to break the equipment reporting down to show the condition of motive power and to show tanks, reefers and hospital cars as separate items. At the same time, line interruptions and supply needs are eliminated from the report.
