1. CINCFE msgs C 56998 and CX 61074. CG EUSAK is responsible logistic support 27th Brigade (UK) upon arrival Korea.

2. Following logistic data this unit furnished for planning purposes and/or necessary action:

a. General. Unit is equipped with British equipment. One month resupply equipment accompanies. After consumption this resupply necessary to re-equip unit from U. S. Army stocks.

b. Class I. Unit requires complete support upon arrival. Three months supply tea, sugar, and milk and 4 hard rations accompany unit.

c. Class II. Two sets jungle green, 1 set cold weather battle dress and great coats accompany troops. Resupply winter clothing by British Army except cap, field ctn, OD w/visor, Jacket Field M 43 w/Hood and Gloves Shell, leather w/insert which will be furnished from U. S. Army stocks.

d. Class III. Unit requires complete support upon arrival.

(1) Accompanying unit:

Organic GP and SP vehicles.

Organic 3 inch mortars. Plan to substitute U. S. 81mm mortars this item when ammunition supply therefor permits.

- (3) Medical evacuation. Through normal U. S. Army channels to Japan. Beyond Japan by British means.
- (4) Burials reported by Unit to AGRS in bulk.
- (5) Marking. All British Army equipment bulk-shipped for unit marked with 3 inch green band.
- (6) Unit will provide Ordnance Liaison Group to aid ammunition identification, segregation and handling.

M/R Our message CX 58549 established a new policy of assignment of APO's to units in Korea. Non-division TO&E and TD units assigned Pusan Base Command would use APO 59 as a mailing address. Non-division TO&E and TD units assigned to EUSAK would adopt APO 301. Such units will continue to use APO 301 although further assigned to I corps and this for the reason Corps Hq is a strictly tactical outfit and should not be loaded down with postal administrative duties such as maintaining a directory section, etc. It will have only a small serving APO for financial services. Division units attached to other divisions would not adopt APO of Division to which attached. Non-division TO&E and TD units attached to Divisions will not adopt APO number of division to which attached but will use APO 301. Instant radio informs CG EUSAK that APO 358 is APO assigned to Hq, Hq Co, MP Plat, Hq and Hq Btry Arty, I Corps and 4th Signal Bn.

"1. Consistent with reqmts of financial agreement effected with ROK on 28 Jul 50 and in accordance with gen approval of all interested United States agencies following basic procedure will be applied to acctg for advs of Korean won for use in Korea. Specific details of procedure being fwdd air mail:

(a) A funding off actg for the unified comd (UNFO) will be designated by CG of Armed Forces of member states of United Nations to rec advs of won from ROK to meet needs of all United Nations Forces. UNFO will acct for such won only as prop. United States Army funding off will be designated to acct advs of won from UNFO to meet needs of United States Forces. Such won will be recorded in regular disbursing officer acct in dollar equivalent at approved rate of exchange

(b) UNFO will fwd radio advice to COFF of won advanced to USAFO and will keep record of any won advd to Fin Offs of other member states. USAFO will fwd radio advice to COFF of won recd from UNFO.

(c) COFF will advise Treasury to trf from USAFO of 1 dollar checking acct to special res acct established by Treasury the dollar equivalent of won recd by UNFO.

(d) USAFO will trf won to United States Army Disbr Offs at approved rate as trf of cash. Won trfs to USN and AF Disb Offs will be made by exchange for cash check.

(e) Rates to be used for internal United States acctg purposes and for sales to pers will be as indicated in CURADS W 86122 and W 86577 be approved by Wash based on recommendation and data furnished by CINCFC in coordination with AMIK and Treasury reps. Details of acctg for rate adjustments included in procedure being air mailed.

2. Above outlined procedure is basically similar to that established in WWII in acctg for fgn currs recd without concurrent dollar pmt. This procedure in accordance with GAO and Treasury Dept reqmts and approved by those agencies.

MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: Reorganization and Re-equipping of ROK Army.

1. Eighth Army Msg EX 30250 OW, 14 Aug 50, constituted a requisition on San Francisco Port for equipment for four (4) additional ROK Divisions. Informal conversations with G-4, Eighth Army, confirmed this fact and established that FUSAK contemplated organizing and equipping a total of ten (10) Divisions.
2. CINCPAC Msg CX 59709, 9 Aug 50, authorized CG EUSAK to increase the strength of the ROK Army to any number he deemed advisable, but directed that all requisitions for additional equipment be forwarded through this Hq. This precaution is essential to avoid placing demands on the ZI which they cannot meet from resources at present available.
3. G-4 has been furnished by G-4 DA, a list of critical item availability which indicates that many items required by a Division are in short supply in the ZI.
4. In view of the above, it was considered desirable that CG EUSAK be advised of the critical supply situation and requested to submit his plans prior to making commitments to ROK Army.

1. Msg C 20973 ADVKSI from CG EUSAK requested comparative technical data of SCR 784 and a set designated as "Q-3". Queries by 2nd Div Artillery personnel in Korea prompted this msg.
2. The complete absence of technical data in the msg rendered impossible the identification of the Q-3 Set mentioned. Also, queries to Navy and the AF did not reveal the existence or possible identification of this equipment.
3. Since the Q-3 Set was mentioned in connection with the SCR 784, it was assumed that the Q-3 Set was used for the same purpose and was similar in basic design to the SCR 784. Based on the assumption that the Q-3 nomenclature was incomplete, it was decided that the only possible resemblance to known military equip was with the AN/TPQ-3 Radar Set used for mortar location purposes.
4. CINCPAC msg CX 59755 to CG EUSAK furnished relative tech data between the SCR 784 and AN/TPQ-3 Radar Sets. Further, detailed info was requested whereby identification may be effected in case the basic assumption as contained above is incorrect.
5. On 13 Aug 50, Lt Col Tombs, who recently returned from Korea as G-4 Liaison Officer, passed info to Mil Com Div (Lt Lee) a copy of ltr conveying info that artillery personnel in Korea consider SCR 784 to be superior to AN/TPQ-3 Sets for mortar locating purposes.
6. This msg to EUSAK fwds pertinent factors to be considered in the determination of the advisability of utilizing SCR 784 RADAR Sets in Korea. If it is decided that SCR 784's will be used in Korea, advice is requested as to the quantities required and type units that will be issued those sets.

SIPE (OSD) advises loading berths in ZI being made available to permit increased loading of Army and Air Force ammo and explosives for F. COM during August, September and October. It is required that vessels be discharged without delay upon arrival and that depots and receiving agencies are capable of receiving ammo for storage or delivery at the same rate as discharged from shipside. CG SFPA (OSD) msg TCSFP 4632 GC, 12 Aug 50, to CINCFE, info CG Eighth Army and 6SUSA advises that ammo tonnages to FECOM during August approximate 135,000 tons, increasing to 170,000 tons for Sept and Oct, and further states that to determine releases, and loading intelligently, request CINCFE furnish a priority table indicating priorities as between destinations, for example, Okinawa, Yokohama, and Pusan, and by services, Army or Air Force. Requisitions as currently received given no guidance as to these priorities. The msg further requested CINCFE to review ammo tonnages that can be discharged at each port and advise OSD at SFPA. The balance of the msg is on Air Force and Ordnance (Army) logistical supply matters. Action on this msg is assigned to G-4.

2. In a meeting conducted by G-4 and attended by representatives of G-4, GHQ; Ord Sec, GHQ, and Eighth Army, Trans Sec, GHQ and Eighth Army; FSAF, FEAMCOM and COMNAVFE, the following tonnage figures were given for ammo destined FEC ports based on requisitions submitted on the ZI by the Air Force and Army:

Army: 354,000 tons from this date to Oct 31, split 2/3 to Korea, 1/3 to Japan. Japan tonnages by depot are 15% Ozono, 70% Ikego, and 15% Loeper. Okinawa tonnages are normal resupply and therefore negligible. Korea monthly tonnages are 200,000 tons beginning November.

Air Force: 120,000 tons for August to Japan, split by depot locations - 2/3 Yokota area, 1/3 Yamada (Kyushu area). 75,000 to 100,000 tons September and thereafter split as above. 30,000 tons monthly for Okinawa, this rate more or less constant. Korea tonnages are negligible but may be increased dependent on the tactical situation.

3. Trans Sec is delegated responsibility to furnish discharge capacities by ports. Requests for present port ammo discharge capacities with requests for detailed information for expanding present capacities are being submitted by separate communication to CG Eighth Army, Yokohama, CG RYCOM, Okinawa, and CG LUSAK, Korea.

1. Msg G 20973 ADVESI from CG EUSAK requested comparative technical data of SCR 784 and a Set designated as "Q-3". Queries by 2nd Div Artillery personnel in Korea prompted this msg.

These observations are accompanied by corresponding changes in entries in Column H up to 5 Aug, and in Columns H and I after 4 Aug. Desire full explanation of radical changes in columns G and H entries for 24, 26, and 31 Jul; 3 and 4 Aug, and for columns G, H, and I after 4 Aug.

Part II. Information desired concerning the number of those operable locomotives available, reported as 142, on 3 Aug, which you project will be available and operable on the following dates: 15 Aug, 15 Sep, 15 Oct, and 15 Nov. In making projections for these dates, do not include: (a) engines estimated as being rendered inoperable in future, due to combat action; (b) engines being or to be procured or requisitioned; (c) engines undergoing or to undergo major repairs in Japan. In making projections for these dates, do include: (a) engines now undergoing or to undergo repairs in Korea which will be available. These projections shall show separate categories of figures for road engines and switch engines.



Part III. During recent visit, TO, GHQ, FEC, observed about half of operable locomotives and raises two questions: (a) despite overhaul within current year most engines observed appeared near a second overhaul period; (b) steady neglect boiler washing and general maintenance indicates early depreciation of presently operable locomotives. Consider these two factors critically in replying to Part II.

MEMO FOR RECORD:

1. As directed by C/N #1, C-4 to TO, subj: "Organization of Movements Control Division, Trans Sec," the vessel and Terminal Status Branch has been organized to keep a daily vessel status report of all terminal operations. The Branch is required to prepare forecasts of transportation activities and maintain data showing the effect of current and planned movements on terminal capacities.

2. The Daily Port Operations Report, Reports Control Symbol QTO-05 (R1), which has been established as a procedure for controlling the flow of vessels and cargo to all F.C ports and to maintain complete terminal data, is required from Pusan. Thru the media of this report, the current

status of the port can be evaluated and possible port congestion ascertained beforehand and thus alleviated. Port performance and capabilities can be appraised.

3. CINCFE msg CX 57461, 8 July (initiated by C-4), requested daily transmission of a Port Activity Report. This report was purposely requested in brief form as an expedient, to be discontinued upon establishment of a Pusan Port Agency. The report does not give detailed enough information to evaluate port capabilities or performance. Instant message will accomplish the desired information. (CINCFE msg CX 57461 is hereby rescinded.)

4. The QTO-05 (R1) report, now in effect at other ports, is considered sufficient in detail, however, slight variations are made for the purpose of brevity. Miss McDermott, Office of the Comptroller, advises that a new Reports Control Symbol is not required.

5. Lt Col Chappel, Trans Section, 8th Army, advises that this report will satisfy 8th Army needs. Trans Sec, 8th Army, will request the discontinuance of a report titled, "Ship Status Report," which was requested by CG 8th Army and which is transmitted daily by Pusan Base Command.
