

1. I wish to emphasize desirability of initialing withdrawal this group (less Air Section) at early date. Group is now performing no survey duties whatsoever, nor has it performed any survey duties for past month since departure of Gen Fox party with draft report. Remaining eight Off, one DAC, and 26 EM of group are occupied solely with administering themselves and furnishing some radio service which local AMEMB and Navy Sig NAS installations are capable of handling.

2. Present remnant of original large group is occupying offices in Ministry of National Defense building directly under eyes of Chinese Nationalist Govt who there foresee us daily and must wonder at retention here of this inactive group.

3. Original billeting and messing arrangements called M 50 E M in Bankers club and 30 officers in hostel number 2 at subsistence rates of \$3.50 and \$4.25 per day for EM and Officers, respectively, provided that respective strengths did not fall below 40 and 20. Since present strength of group remnant is now 26 EM and 8 Off, Deputy Commanding General of Chinese Combined Service Forces has reqstd conference with me on 4 Oct to set new and higher subsistence rates and to arrange for moving eight Off from hostel to smaller and less expensive accommodations.

1. Chinese agent reported 21 Sep that Chinese Commies are planning to send Cheng-Keng, Commander of 4th Army Group, to French Indo-China to assist the Viet Minh Forces.

Comment: Cheng-Keng commands the 13th, 14th and 15th Armies. The 13th and 14th Armies are stationed in Kunming and Kaiyuan respectively. The 15th Army was moved on or about 15 Jul fr Yunan Province to Liu-Chow and later fr Liu-Chow to Lungshien near the French Indo-China border.

2. Chinese agent reports that Commie authorities in Peiping have issued orders to blockade all communication centers on the French Indo-China border in order to prevent commercial tv.

3. G-2 MND estimates that the Chinese Commies received total of 350 aircraft fr Russia during the period Feb to Aug 50. Among these aircraft were 28 Yaks, 100 Mustangs (Russian version), 120 light bombers and 50 transports.

4. Chinese Navy Hq reports that 3 regts of paratroops (total strength of 6,000) were organized in Mukden in late Aug. the 1st Regt was transferred to Hankow. The 2d and 3d Regts are located in vic of Peiping and Shih Men Shih (Shih Chia Chuang).

RAK transmitters furnishing sole communications from this group to CINCFE now operating from emergency elec power provided by power units PE 75 and 95. Transmitters are presently housed in bldg recently constructed by Chinese AF who now require bldg at early date. Alternatives as fols:

1. Construct new bldg at airfld for transmitters and build new elec pole line to meet for commercial power;
2. Relocate transmitters in metropolitan area in existing housing and arrange for increase allocation primary elec distribution in area and for installation transformer.

Emergency power units not designed heavy duty nor for high octane avgas it has been necessary to burn at rate 70 gals per day. Piston heads chipped and other damage apparent all units which now require 4th echelon repair. Tools, parts and facilities for 4th echelon not avail. Only 2 PE 75 units now working and of 3 PE 95 units, 2 are beyond local capability for repair and 1 is being returned from Chinese repair depot today to be placed in service. Chinese have cooperated to extent lending us 3 additional units, now all unserviceable, making depot repairs free of charge, and using Chinese replacement parts.

Due to necessity relieving Chinese unnecessary expense, to decreasing gas consumption and to prevent further extensive damage to power units it is essential that transmitters be moved to adjacent to commercial elec power. Such a location has been offered and is being tested for adequate radio transmission characteristics today. If site is satisfactory technically proposed to move transmitters there to immediately in which case funds required at rate \$75 US per month to cover power purchase

Para 1. Improvements to airfield at Chingchow (Liakling Province) reported completed and aviation school established there. Russians have furnished estimated 15 bombers and 8 trainers for use of school. Airfield at Luchow (Kwangsi Province) is being repaired and extended.

Chinese Navy Hq reported on 12 Sep that the submarine training centers established by the Russians in Lo-Ching and Hsung-Kee, North Korea have been transferred to Vladivostok, Port Arthur and Dairen. 2. G-2 MND Agent reported 11 Sep that 500 cadets recently completed 8 month course of instruction at Marine Training School in Canton and were organized as 1st Battalion of Marine Corps in Canton Army Area under command Tseng Ming. They will be transferred to Wan-Chido Islands for duty within few days.

3. G-2 MND Agent reported 12 Sep that the 26th Army is moving South from Feng Hua; destination unknown at present.

4. Chinese agent reported 12 Sep that Lin Piao transferred 4 of his armies to the north from Kwantung and Kwangsi Provinces during the period 15 Jul to 12 Aug. Majority these forces located in general area Mukden-Antung-Chian; remainder at Chingwang Tao and Yingkou. Another 300,000 troops under Lin Piao's Command are concentrating in Hankow-Wuchang-Hanyang area.

Para 1. Chinese agent reports via Hong Kong 6 Sep recent interview with CCP officer wounded in Korea. Following is info obtained:

A. Officer was member of 174th Div/59th Army. Originally was to be sent to a Peiping Hospital; however since too many foreigners Peiping he was sent to Hunan Ynie Medical College at Chang Sha to prevent disclosure CCP in Korea.

B. Officer stated American tactics of "Carpet Bombing" fails because small sized bombs would be more effective. (Comment: this indicates officer may have been wounded in heavy B-29 assault vic Weagan 17 Aug.)

C. 5 high Chinese Communist military leaders also reported wounded by US bombings in Korea sent to Changsha for hospitalization. Doctor stated all died of wounds. 2 of 5 were reported as Hsiao, a Chief of Staff, who 3-2 defense ministry thinks may be Hsiao Kai, Chief of Staff to Lin Piao, and Nieh Jung-Chen, Commander of CCP special army group and Deputy Chief of Staff to Chu Teh. (A separate report received about 1 Sep reported Hsiao Kai was recently buried in Chang Sha.)

D. Forces sent to Korea by Lin Piao total 130,000 of which 70% Korean, 20% Japanese, 10% Chinese of Northeast origin. This force organized in to 12 div each with 4 Inf Regiments. Each regiment consists of 4 Battallions each having 4 Rifle Companies.

E. Because of heavy losses in North Korean units replacements will be taken from 155,000 CCP in units deployed among the Korean-Manchurian Border. These replacements are to be secretly infiltrated in to North Korean Units.

G. At Paiping meeting between Mao-tze Tung and Molotov in later part July there were representatives from Japan, North Korea, Indo-China, and Philippines. Names unknown.

1. Intelligence Bulletin Nbr 8 (FX 5028) as modified by FX 5047.

~~2. HBJE~~ contains best info here re CCP units and strength in Manchuria and along Korean border. Info gathered various sources tend to confirm.

2. Evaluated A-2 is report of Intelligence Bulletin Nbr 12 (FX 5042) that on 6 Aug, Soviets recalled 200 acft from China to Mukden.

3. Most significant report is given in Intelligence Bulletin Nbr 15 (FX 5049). Source has been most reliable in past reporting and is in position to obtain such info. G-2 Defense Ministry feels that, if North Korean forces unsuccessful in driving UN forces from Korea in reasonable time or success is doubtful, Lin Piao's forces probably will be committed. However, he considers it quite possible that if CCP troops are committed in the immediate future they will not be used as CCP units but will be amalgated with Koreans and entered into combat as North Korean forces. Use of Soviet forces, except as security forces in Manchuria and Korean border area, does not appear likely at this time from info avail here.

4. Another source of replacements for North Korean units is contained in agent report received 25 Aug which states that according to member Chinese overseas association who returned to Hong Kong 1 Aug from North China, Soviets in collaboration with Chinese Communists forces an advisory group in early July. Mission of group is to conscript 200,000 Koreans of military age

"The hard-pressed Asian Peoples must be bewildered, if not disillusioned, by America's attitude toward Taiwan, which is looked upon in this part of the world as bulwork against Communism."

Neutralization of this island and withdrawal of the 7th Flt once the Korean War has been settled could mean the US want to tie-up our hands and feet and be socked hard by armed foe when our limbs are loosened. Aside from its effect on the morale of the people in Taiwan and other Asiatics, is such policy fair and consistent to a nation and people who has been fighting Communism the hardest and suffered the the most? Is it sin to fight the Communists and everybodys envy to befriend them? Any American effort to fight the Red Menace in Asia will be hailed by all Asiatics, and not resented as some apoligists might think.

The people in free China must object most strongly to any suggestion from the United State for United Nations that a Commission be sent over to this island to investigate the so-called American Agression on Taiwan. Since the UN at present consists partly of Communists, Satellites and their sympathizers, we simply cannot allow any UN inquiry commission to probe our island at a time when our life and death struggles is going on. We still have a right to treat our military installations and armed forces Top Secret even at this dark hour of national crisis. We feel it is only fair and proper for the UN to study first Soviet Aggression on our mainland."

3. Chinese agent reports that Chinese Communists are surveying Leng Li and Kweiyang Sections of Kweichow-Kwangsi railway. Rebuilding of this section to be completed before April 51.

4. Chinese Communist POW captured Taitan Island (just west of Little Kinmen) (reports that help shipping squadron has been formed by the 86th Div, 29th Army). Crew organized from men in Div. Squadron consists of 128 motor junk.

5. Chinese Communists Forces (reported from several sources) are pushing construction or repair of the main Foochow-Amoy and Foochow-Nanking-Chen-Cu Roads and numerous other roads leading from the Amoy-Foochow Area into the interior.

Part 1. Army: After a quiet day yesterday, the 25th Div received an indicated allout enemy attack beginning at midnight. Attack preceded by heavy mortar, artillery and flat trajectory fire. Heavy fighting continues in the sector with approximately 2000 yard enemy penetration between the 24th and 35th RCT being contained. In the 2d Div sector, elements of the 38th RCT continued probing attacks on the North bridgehead. 9th RCT repulsed 2 attempted river crossings on South flank. At 0100K, the enemy attacked the 23d Infantry across the Naktong River in the vicinity of TUGONG-NI (1131-1400), and TUKSONG-DONG (1136-1425). A penetration of approximately 1000 yards was made at South crossing, North crossing dispersed by artillery fire. Heavy fighting continues. II Corps sector: 11th Regt relieved 1st Cav Regt and 5th Regt (-); 12th Regt relieved 7th in sector then counter-attacked and seized high ground northwest of UNSAN-DONG (1167-1468); 15th Regt to relieve 19th Regt. 10th Regt atch 3d Div vic POHANG-DONG. 15th Regt made small gains against penetration in 19th Regt area. Right flank 8th Div withdrew 2000 yards as a result of enemy atk. Right flank 3d Div withdrew 2000 yards, later regained 1500 yards.

FEC Survey Group, Formosa, Intell Bulletin No. 16 reported 13,000 tons diesel oil will be shipped from Dairen and Tsingtao to Shanghai during middle of September. ALUSNA, Taipei radio, AG 33465, reports 13,000 tons of heavy oil stored in Dairen being readied for shipment to unknown destination in early September. Chief of Staff requested G-2 to evaluate ALUSNA radio and estimate use of oil referred to therein. Purpose of this radio is to determine whether the oil is diesel fuel suitable for use by submarines or heavy oil suitable for use only by steam turbine powered vessels.
