Contents of this dispatch concern the Island of Iwo Jima. Article 3 of a recent amendment to the bulk sale to China

Agreement states "Removal by United States.

This article hereby constitutes authority for the withdrawal by the United States (without further specific approval by China) from any deposits established by Irticle 3 3 of the agreement, which withdrawals shall be for the payment of reimbursement of any obligation or expenses incurred by the United States in connection with the removal of any surplus property sold under said agreement that has not been completely removed from non-Chinese Territory on or before 1 May 1949. The said authority may be exercised by the United States, only upon the expiration of 30 days notice in writing to China. All such notices to China shall be made on or before 30 June 1949. Any prior arrangements or agreements which are inconsistent herewith are hereby rescinded."

Whereas Article 4 B of the same amendment states,
With respect to the surplus property sold Voseladohe
Agreement and located on islands under the jurisdiction of the
United States, where less than the complete physical removal
of such surplus property is acceptable to the appropriate
authorities, such disposition shall be deemed to comply with
Article 3 hereof."





) Subject is Mollers Inc contract for salvage operations in RYCOM. RYCOM rad E 20986 AIB, 9 Nov 48, as clarified by RYCOM rad E 21005 AIB, 16 Nov 48, is quoted below:

"This rad in three parts.

Part 1. Captain Charlie V Maxwell arr Okinawa 8 Nov, replacing T E Carr. Maxwell states that he has approval for the towing of floating equip to Hongkong where it will be broke up; also for collection of other equip on the beach and the conversion of this to scrap of standard sizes for shipment to US. He wants to take over the Okinawan Salvage Co, employing native labor to perform this work. He still desires to purchase rations and POL, and to build housing to establish camps ashoro.

Part 2. The utilization of Okinawan labor will obviate the need for bringing Chinese labor. However, it is objectionable to place Okinawan labor at the disposal of foreign enterprise. Such employers will probably offer inducements that we cannot match and RYCOM will lose badly needed technical skill among native labor. Mollers has no salvago equip here at this time. One 17 ton erane is now enroute.

Part 3. In view of the current situation in the Far East, the uncertainty over the ultimate disposition of salvage after it leaves here, and undesirability of permitting foreign nationals to establish camps ashore and using Okinawan labor, it is recommended that for the present Mollers be refused permission to bring in any pers or equip for the purpose of conducting salvage operations or making preparations for salvage. Request reply soonest."

RYCOM further indicates that the intent is that Mollers be refused permission to proceed with preparation for operations or to conduct operations of any kind even if done wholly from craft at sea and no parties come ashore. Comments and recommendations are requested. transmission of literal

"2. No property can be removed by the Chinese Govt after mid-night 30 Jun-1 Jul 48 and no sales agreements entered into by the Chinese Govt with any individual, corp, or other agency, wherein the property was not removed prior to mid-night 30 Jun-1 Jul 48 will be honored by MARAMA."

Gen Ting further advised this office that MARAMA has refused to permit BOSEV to enter AF areas to inventory property made available to China Further he stateshe has not been permitted to place Chinese NP's to guard property which belongs to China. You are advised position taken by MARAMA re bulk sale property transfer to China at Harmon Fld is predjudicial to Chinese rights.

The fact that China has not removed property by 30 Jun 48 or within 6 months after title passed to China does not give Tsning Agencies right to repossess property even though property remains on installation.

Further, FLC is only agent of the US Govt which at present is authorized to administer China bulk sale agreement.

It was also recognized that probably only by a fr aty of type desired by Whited States, would it be possible to obtain from Japanese people their maximum identification with cause of free warld and willingness to accept increased responsibility for contributing to their own defense. Unless presented in context of nuch an immediate and extreme emergency as to admit of no choice [with the repercuasions that would flow therefrom), it would appear that all elements in Japan opposed to type treaty desired by United States would be able to fement opposition to treaty on grounds that furnishing of heavy equipment to NPRJ constitued rearmament of country, in contradiction to principles accepted by them at time of their surrender and, until recently, inculcated by openpation authorities, at unilateral decision of United States and without their being given an opportunity to participate in decision.
