( X64876 ) Radio from CSGPO WX 91494 quoted for your information  
 vis:

1. Unconfirmed information now being evaluated here suggests outside possibility that large scale sabotage activities or open hostilities may occur during the period 29 Oct to 3 Nov. Certain aspects of this information indicate that it may be a hoax or a plant. However, until it is so proved the contingency cannot be ignored.

2. It is requested:

a. That intelligence and counter-intelligence activities be intensified with the view to confirming or denying validity of the above information.

b. That periodic reports be submitted daily to CINCFE (Attention G-2) as of 0400 Z containing info received reference this matter.

3. Authority is granted to relay this info to major subordinate commanders. Unless events not known here develop, it is considered undesirable to conduct troop movements or to alert physically units or installations based solely upon info contained herein.

( C-64888 ) For CSGID. Re your radio WX 91494 Intelligence and Counter Intelligence activities have been intensified to secure desired information. Report for period ending 280400 Z follows: CINCPAC recognizes the capabilities of the Japanese Communists Party to cripple by acts of sabotage, Japanese communications, power and transportation. There have been no, repeat no, indications here of plans for action on specific future dates. Unconfirmed reports have implied that revolutionary activity might occur during latter part of 1948. The general tempo of Communist activity has increased in recent months

( C-64940 ) For CSOID. Re your radio WX 91494. Report for period ending 290400 Z follows:

JAPAN: All subordinate commands within Japan report Negative.

KOREA: 1. Reports indicate invasion will take place after consideration Korea question in UN, or after U.S. withdrawal of troops. However, North Korean rumor received this week covers unspecified date North Korean farmers will enter South Korea armed with harvest tools to liberate oppressed South Koreans. Peoples Army troops go into action when South Korea Police and Constabulary attempt to stop farmers. South Korea Labor Party members to disrupt rear areas (F-6).

2. Reports received that there will be disturbances South Korea within coming two weeks. Anniversary Bolshevik Revolution 7 November appears most probable for disturbances.

3. Other reports of disturbances in South Korea that may be connected with the MID critical dates are as follows:

a. South Korea Peoples Liberation Revolutionary Army vanguard action corps will commence rioting Kaesong (980-1690), Tongduchon (1000-1680), Kangnung (1180-1680), Korangpo (980-1690) and Taegu (1160-1440) very near future. (Report dated 21 Oct C-3).

b. About 30 Oct SKLP plans to call strikes in all railroad stations.

c. Student groups of SKLP Inchon (960-1630) are to attack members Korean National Youth Corps, North West Young Mens Association and United Young Mens Party near future. Communist demonstrations are planned for 31 October Inchon. (C-3).

d. Large scale riot will occur about 5 November. All Leftists released by Amnesty Law will attack police boxes, policemen and Rightist leaders. (C-3).

e. Communists plan to sabotage alternate railroad route between Seoul and Pusan and October to commemorate October revolution. (C-3).

f. Korean Democratic Patriotic Young Mens Association and the Democratic Students League will instigate demonstrations and spread Leftist propaganda until 7 November. When proper time arrives guerrilla bands, about 20 to 40 men in each, will attack small villages, kidnap pro-Japanese and pro-Americans and try them in "Peoples Courts." (C-3).

g. There will be riots "After signatures for withdrawal of U. S. Army are in." (3 reports F-3, C-3 and C-6).

Comment: Campaign to obtain signatures started about 5 October and is still going on.

h. Communists will rise up during harvest season. (2 reports C-3)

i. Disturbances will be directed by SKLP sometime in November 48. (C-3).

Japan: All subordinate commands within Japan report negative.

PHILCOM: Negative

RYCOM: Negative

MARBO: Negative

Korea: 1. Current reports of planned invasion South Korea and movement Chinese Communist troops to North Korea possibly connected with MID critical dates. Low in evaluation, and past invasion reports inaccurate.

a. High ranking Peoples Army officer overheard to state North Korean forces will move 3 Nov 48 to liberate oppressed laborers, farmers South Korea. (F-3)

b. Approximately 10,000 Peoples Army troops arrived Haeju (870-1700) 15 Oct. (F-6)

G-2 Comment: Movement Peoples Army troops 38 Parallel areas reported since July 48 and connected with relieving Soviet border units.

c. Rumor Chinese Communist and Peoples army leaders met June 48; alleged that 45,000 Chinese Communist troops be sent North Korea.

d. Five reports evaluated F-6 state Chinese Communist troops now in North Korea; strength range as high as 12,000 troops and 900 counter-intelligence personnel; "political investigators" being dispatched South Korea disguised as farmers to investigate attitude South Korean farmers toward Communism. One C-3 report states 1,000 Chinese Communist troops sent North Korea as military instructors.

G-2 Comment: Previous reports have indicated military assistance may be furnished North Korea by Chinese Communists.

e. Three reports evaluated C-3 and F-6 indicates plans for disturbances South Korea; demonstrations reportedly scheduled Inchon (960-1630) between 25 Oct and 18 Nov; scheduled Pusan (1200-1340) 7 Nov; Communists plan general strike early November.
