

This command has an established policy in connection with the employment of civilians as fol: The employment of dependents of mil or DA and AF Civilians pers. who have not been auth dependent housing, is prohibited. This precludes the recruitment of the husband, wife, or any other dependent of pers in the MARIANAS BONIS Area who have not been legally auth family type quarters."

Foregoing policy was concurred in by CG 20th AF and is applicable to all AF and Army installations in MARBO Area. The reason for the above policy is that in the past in many cases dependents of pers not assigned family type quarters assigned to this command upon arrival refused assignments or broke their contracts shortly after arrival. In many cases wives became pregnant and had to be returned to the ZI shortly after arrival in as much as dependent housing is not avail. It has been best that the policy of hiring dependents created a morale problem due to the fact that dependents of all pers desiring their dependents in this command could not be employed by reason of children in the family and since omestic help is not avail in the area.

Not withstanding the foregoing reasons for the present policy this he concurs in the request of CG FEAF and if approved for that command will be adopted as policy in MARBO provided ea individual being recruited signs a statement at the time of recruitment that



M/R: Referred rad from CG, MARBO, requested use of Keeler Polygraph (lie detector) and operator in connection with Farnsworth case. Ruth Farnsworth was Dept of Navy Civilian employee who was murdered on or about 11 Dec 48. Written permission must be obtained from subject or subjects before polygraph examination may be conducted. Previous experience by CID Lab indicates that transportation of polygraph mehine to outlying areas is desirable only in exceptional cases inasmuch as the machine is easily damaged in transit. Inst rad is to request MARBO to submit additional information before approval for transportation and use of lie detector may be granted.

District Engineer and Air Force concur in 256 per hour increase.

Funds are not available for wage increase program. It is estimated that approximately \$313,500 will be needed to cover wage increase of 25¢ per hour for remainder of Fiscal Year. At present no competition from Navy since Navy wage board rated generally lower than those paid DACs. Info this hq indicates that wage board increase in ZI will make recruitment increasingly more difficult unless comparable rates are established for Guam. It is presumed PHILCOM is experiencing similar recruiting difficulties. Recommend higher wage board pay schedule for Guam than for PHILCOM to compensate for non favorable living conditions.

Food: All food items secured thru importation. Army Navy inspects meat handling markets. No inspection fish, shell fish. No milk. Sewage disposal primarily deep pit latrines in coral under base. Sewage disposal by seepage from pits. Human excreta not used for land fertilizing. Island has good drainage, no storm sewers, numerous open ditches in rainy season, general collection surface water which drains out thru coral. Garbage refuse collected daily. Disposal to pits and to ocean. Deceased persons disposed by burial. Pest control for mosquitos, flies, lice, rodents, fleas but inadequate for rodents, mosquitos in jungle areas. Total hospital beds 750, non charity. Medical surgical nursing obstetrical care available serious cases. Emergency dental treatment furnished. Common drugs difficult procurement, military issue only. One civilian dentist praticing on Guam. Hospital employs 32 physicians, 39 nurses, 2 sanitary inspectors. Communicable diseases reported. Children receive small pox, typhoid immun-1zations, general public small pox, typhoid, tetanus and encephalitis.

Recreational facilities outdoor movies, swimming, tennis, bowling. Facilities limited and difficult access because of transportation. Only 18 civilians have families present, quarters not available to 95% of dependent civilian personnel.

Comment: American Nationals cannot own land on Guam nor buy or rent property making family life impossible for 95% of personnel. Limited recreation transportation and supplies puts mental hygiene of employees at unsatisfactory level.

Employees are isolated from most areas of island, all native villages off limits and most of shore line and beaches. Transportation very limited, roads excellent, gasoline adequate. Gen environment creates restrictive social atmosphere, recreational supplies dependent on imports and very limited. Housing, messing simulate camp life. Approximately same conditions as above apply for Saipan.
