




Re Part 6 C urad 2% 25852, reduction of overseas tour to 18 mos for DA mil pers and 15 mos without dependents and 24 mos with dependents for AF pers does not materially affect the present dependent housing situation this command. It is estimated that dependents will arrive overseas during mos of Jan, Feb. Mar and Apr 49 after husbands have completed 11 to 12 mos on their current overseas tour. After month of Apr 49 it is estimated that waiting time before dependents are able to join their husbands will increase up to 13, 14 and 15 mos. Above estimates are based on complete survey of DA mil pers after announcement of 18 mos tour and partial survey of AF pers after announcement of reduction of AF tour. AF unable to furnish complete info due to restrictions imposed during 6 mos allowed for implementation.

Part 5 of urad ZX 25052 will not effect dependent housing until after Apr 49. The Army Corps of Engrs spent \$50,700,000 on construction project on Guam in the yrs 46, 47, 48.

The Governor of Guam has requested the Navy Department to transfer to the Naval Government of Guam title to all lands owned by the USA, other than those required for use by the Armed Forces. As soon as this is done the governor will direct, through the medium of the land transfer board, that these lands be sold to the Guamanian people. It is expected that when this is accomplished that there will be sufficent land throughout the Island for the establishment of permanent homes and a solid economy for the Guamanians.

In an effort to encourage rebuilding of Juam the governor issued executive orders Nbr 5-48 effective 20 Oct 48 providing duty free importation of building materials for 1 yr from date. Building materials from the US and the Philippines have always been free of duty, but are very short of supply now. This order will make it possible to bring in building materials from other countries at a much lower cost than has been possible in the past.

The request of the Philippine Air Lines for a freight and passenger stop at Quam which was reported last week was not objected to by the Army, Navy or Air Force and is expected to be granted. If it is granted MARBO command indicated that it might use the line for emergency transportation for civilian personnel desiring transportation at personal expense and some cargo purchased through non-appropriated funds

Most controversial topic of discussion among Guamanians at present time is the acquisition by Naval Govt of lands for mil use which Guamanians can or on which they are living. Comments following as regards acquisition of areas for mil use are extracts from congressional record of bob and 9th Congress and were not derived from official mil sources.

In a special session with the Naval Governor of Gram.

Rear Admire: O A Pownall, on 27 Sep 46, members of the Guam Congress stated openly that they believed the Naval Governments choice of lands for mil installations on Guam had not been made with the best interests of the Guamaniana in mind.

Congressman Carlos Taitano, Representative from the Barrigada District, Guam, stated in the aforementioned session that the Government of Guam should be a model of the democracy which is the United States of America, and that the government which now exists on Guam is not a democracy but under the complete rule of the Dept of Navy and that the Guamanian has little if anything to say about his own personal and business affairs. The Governor of Guam stated that the Navy Government is not always in a position to tell the individual Guamanian why he is being moved from his land to make way for new military installations or improvements to mil installations already in use, as such matters are usually classified and not authorized for release to the general public.

The Guamanian Congress may introduce and pass bills on metters affecting Guam, and the bill is then passed up to the Naval Governor of Guam. If the Naval Governor vetoes the bill, the Guam Congress has the power of direct petition

Tumon Bay Beach as a recreational beach for the mil, Guamanians allowed another segment. Members of the Guam Congress maintain that the mil on Guam have acquired the majority of the beaches available to the Guamanian for swimming and

fishing, which they resent greatly,

The 8th Guamanian Congress unanimously passed a bill which would leave the Tumon Bay Beach open to all concerned, which bill was vetoed by the Naval Governor of Guam. The bill was forwarded to the Dept of Navy which ruled that the Army and Air Force on Guam could build their segregated recreational area on the Tumon Bay Beach. Members of the Guam Congress have openly stated that they believe liaison too close between the Naval Governor of Guam and the Dept of Navy for any petition from them to be taken unbiased or without pressure from WITH the Navy. Some members of the Guam Congress have expressed an intense desire to know, "Are we citizens or not?"

Members of the Guan Congress have indicated that a House Investigating Committee from Washington, headed by Rep Barkley, will visit Guam in Nov this year, at which time the grievances of the Guamanian people will be brought

up before the Committee.

Current West Coast shipping strike has had little if any effect on the Guamanian economy, the foodstocks on Guam being of such a level as to support the Guamanian population for some time. Some commercial establishments such as the beverage bottling plants on Guam have had to curtail their production or shut down completely for lack of material with which to work, but reports indicate that shipping is commencing from the New York Port in the face of the continuing West Coast shipping strike against all but vital mil shipments.
