M/R: Cited MARBO rad states that since Navy has taken over hosp Guam, Hosp CO has referred several cases to MARBO recommending rtn of depts to ZI due to adverse effect of trop climate and allergy. Deps not placed in patient status and therefore not entitled to med evac UP para 6, Cir 54 FEC 49. Does CG MARBO have auth ro rtn depts UP para 8c (2) AR 35-4880 or should indiv cases be fwd to CINCFE? If so, what info is rqstd?

Blanket auth delegated to MARBO in Jul 50 to take final action on rtn of depts under para 8c (2) AR 35-4880 was withdrawn when dep tvl was resumed to MARBO, PHILCOM and RYCOM in Feb 51. Med evac of depts in this type of case would be disadvantageous in that tvl is often to a hosp not in vicinity of ZI home. Further, allergy usually disappears upon arr ZI, therefore med evac not resorted to normally.

Lt Col Raulerson advises that info rqstd in inst rad will be sufficient upon which to base decisions.

CX 67747, 29 Oct announced policy re rtn of depts to FEC, including statement that dep who rtn ZI gov't exp not allowed rtn to FEC during o/s tour of sponsor.

DA rad (TCFIS) WCL 22463, 28 Oct 50, to world wide commands, states that a lack of accurate information on the cost of loading and discharging berth term vessels where stevedoring is performed by the DA, is creating a serious delay in settling accounts with ocean carriers and MSTs. The rad states that it was proposed to place in effect a standard schedule of allowances to expedite the collection of costs.
2. CINCFE rad, Z 23565, dated 2 Nov 50, to CG MARBO, requested information regarding the average costs for stevedoring and loading berth term vessels at Guam.
3. CG MARBO rad, C 10305 MBYTR, dated 8 Nov 50, to CINCFE, advised that CINCFE's message was passed to the Naval Supply Depot, Guam, for comment. Information was furnished that the average cost to the Navy for handling cargo is \$1.35, which includes tonnage charge, checking and lost time, and that this rate is applicable to both dry and reefer cargo. The radio advises further that a charge of \$1.50 per ton, plus 35% surcharge has long been used as flat rates for direct cost for cargo handled for third parties.
4. DA rad, DA 22197, 3 Mar 51, requests that the loading and discharging costs for Manila and Guam be reviewed and clarified as vessel operators indicate costs for Manila are high, the costs for Guam are low. The DA is being advised of Manila costs by separate action.
5. Confirmation of rates quoted in CG MARBO rad, C 10305, is considered advisable to insure accuracy.

SUBJECT: Decontamination of Saipan Ammunition Areas.

1. Ltr from CG MARBO, subject as above, 10 Jan 51, states that Mr. Dukes of the Asian Refugee Foundation stated that due to recent developments, their land requirements have been revised and reduced to approximately 650 acres, and that now the ARF does not intend to fence off the entire north end of the island of Saipan. CG MARBO now requests that the project be closed by fencing off the two worst contaminated areas, areas 7 and 9. The project can be completed in 30 days.

2. On 15 Dec 50 the CofS approved CG MARBO's recommendation of fencing off the worst of the contaminated area by the Asian Refugee Foundation. HICOMTERPACIS and DA were informed of this decision by CINCPAC msg CX 51406, 16 Dec 50. HICOMTERPACIS concurred in this solution.

3. In reference 1 d of the basic, CG MARBO stated that the required fencing can be constructed by this command with available resources that can be diverted to this project.

4. Msg to CG MARBO again approves action to fence off the Saipan ammo area as presented in the basic. The msg also states that this project must be accomplished with materiel and funds available to the command. This action has been coordinated with CR&E.

5. Within established policy. This line of action was approved by the CofS on 15 Dec 50.

Prescribed that rate for 1 bedroom house would be \$30 rent and \$7.50 utilities per month. Further stated that quonsets and prefabs would be considered same as housekeeping qtrs with 1 bedroom at total rate of \$37.50 per month. Marbo rad asks if this \$37.50 includes util charges prescribed in par 12b, AR 420-80. Asks further if AR supersedes ZX 20131.

2. Para 12, AR 420-80 states:

"a. Military Personnel. --Government-owned quarters assigned to military personnel will be furnished utilities service at Government expense.

b. Civilian Personnel. --Government owned quarters assigned to civilian personnel under AR 210-10 may be furnished utilities services but not at Government expense."

3. Further, para 14, AR 210-10 states: "The installation commander may grant permission to civilian employees and other civilians, whose presence on the installation is desirable because of the nature of their duties, to occupy such quarters as are available, and will be responsible that payment for or deduction from salary of the value of such quarters is effected as prescribed in CPA P16. Bona fide servants occupying rooms built in existing quarters for such purpose will not be required to pay rental."

Department of Army advised on 13 Oct 50 that Senator Johnson of Colorado introduced Bill S 4193 to amend Section 220 of Revenue Act of 1950 to make effective date 1 Jan 51 and that recommendations stated in your radio C 25889 MBACS were receiving full consideration in Department of Army report on Senator Johnson's bill. Present status of bill is unknown. Under circumstances, recommendation in your radio that Department of Army be requested to take steps to obtain legislative extension of approximately six months for all citizen employees of United States in possessions for filing 1950 returns and paying tax not favorably considered.

Rad C 10952 MBACS, 28 Dec 50, from CG, MARBO, quoted a message from the Commander, Naval Forces, Marianas, to the Secretary of the Navy recommending that steps be taken to obtain a blanket extension of time for filing tax returns of approximately six months for personnel in possessions, including Guam; otherwise, most citizen employees of the U.S. on Guam will be required to file declarations of estimated tax for 1950 and pay 1950 income taxes by 15 Jan 51 or suffer penalties. This was considered unduly burdensome inasmuch as most such incomes were exempt from taxation prior to the 1950 Revenue Act, approved 23 Sep 50, which taxed such incomes retroactively to 1 Jan 50. CG, MARBO, requested that the DA be requested to take similar action.

This matter has been under consideration by Congress and the DA. The original Senate version of Section 220 of the Revenue Act of 1950 made the effective date 1 Jan 51; however, this was changed to 1 Jan 50 in conference and as finally enacted. By radio C 25689 MBACS, 11 Oct 50, the CG, MARBO, recommended to CINCPAC that action be undertaken to postpone the effective date of Section 220 until 1 Jan 51. This radio was passed to the DA by CINCPAC radio Z 20385, 12 Oct 50, and the DA replied, by radio WCL 49002, 13 Oct 50, that Senator Johnson, of Colorado, had introduced a bill in the Senate to amend Section 220 to make the effective date 1 Jan 51 and that the recommendations stated in CINCPAC radio Z 20385 were receiving full consideration in the Department of the Army report on Senator Johnson's bill. The present status of this bill is unknown.

This problem has been adequately presented to the DA, and remedial action has been undertaken. It is also clear that Congress in enacting the subject legislation considered this question. In view of the foregoing it is deemed inappropriate to make further recommendations to the DA regarding the matter.
