Dept continues feel that problem of mechanics of aid is one which requires first the mutually agreed desires of 3 states and France and secondly acceptable US policy, resources and public opinion. If either inter-state or quadripartite talks are made impossible by Viet intrasigence it is obvious no mutual program can be formed for submission to US. Equally obvious would be strong US public reaction against attempting deal with NZJ states and Fr when they are unable, in view urgency situation as pointed out by both sides, to agree among themselves.

The tendency which the Viets are showing to play US off against the Fr where mil and econ aid are concerned is one which might well jeopardize our plans in this respect. It should be made plain to them the early creation of a quadripartite organization to which econ and mil aid can be directed is of the greatest importance to this govt in determining extent such aid.

Example urgency solution is fact that it may be possible find 37mm ammunition available for shipment within short time. However, funds cannot be allocated until title of recipient determined.

Dept continues desire and assumes Fr accept desirability making 3 states publicized recipients mil as well econ aid, while actually utilizing channels most appropriate. Dept does not desire disturb any way Fr mil authority upon whom not only problem distribution falls but major share end use mil aid. Required therefore is mutually acceptable procedure applicable all types mil aid regardless end user. This decision need not any way prejudice quadripartite distribution committee allocations after arrival aid.

As an interim measure to apply to emergency items such as C-54's and 37mm ammunition Dept is considering practicability vesting title and resting consignment in Commander-In-Chief Combined French Indo-Chinese Forces. Do you believe similar formula desirable for all subsequent military aid? Could title be vested in quadripartite personality and consignment made in the case of military assistance to Cmdr-In-Chief?

5. Germany-Special Annex. Problem: To counteract attack which Polish Govt has made upon US, charging "Inhumanity" in refusal of US High Commissioner for Germany to accede to recent dumping of Germans, particularly women and children, transported toward Western Germany, fr. their homes East of Oder-Neisse line.

Background: During morning of Mar 2 a trainload of 721 Germans fr Folish Administered territory east of Oder-Neisse line was unloaded at Arbsthausen, 1 mile east of Zonal Border of lower Sazony. High Commission stated its position on this action in a communication addressed to Federal Chancellor Mar 3, as follows:

"Under the powers reserved to it by a letter of Nov 28, 49, approved the admission into the territory of the German Federal Republic of 25,000 refugees of certain categories fr Polish territory and German territory administered by Poland. They consisted of Germans who had relatives in the Western Zones ready to receive them and able to support them:

The communication further points out that it was not possible to establish that any of these refugees were included in agreement mentioned in the letter of Nov 28, 1949. In fact none of those de-trained at Arnsthausen appeared even to be among categories envisaged in Nov 28 letter.

Information given by Polish Govt to British Embassy in Warsaw indicates this transport of refugees represents only a first installment, and Polish Govt proposes to proceed with expulsion to Federal Republic of entire German population still remaining east of Oder-Neisse line.

High Commission takes position that these measures are direct responsibility of Polish authorities who initiated this movement and of Soviet Zone authorities who facilitated.

High Commission believes admission of these refugees could only encourage continuation of these inhumane and arbitrary measures. Moreover, accommodations are not available in Western Zones of Germany for refugees in excess of nos referred

to in Nov 28 letter and admission of numbers of refugees greatly in excess of available accommodations would result in great hardship and misery for people concerned. For these reasons, High Commission directed German Federal Government immediately to prevent entry into Federal Territory of all organized transfers of refugees not included in categories mentioned in Nov 28 letter and whose names are not included in nominal roles of cases included among 25,000 whose acceptance was agreed to estimates indicate that although there may be between 200,000 and 400,000 Germans to be expelled from Poland and Polish Administered Territory, 3 High Commissioners all agreed to order stopping admission of all refugees not included in group of 25,000 to Western Zone of Germany. This prohibition is to stand until mass transports on an organized basis are stopped by Polish Government. There has been no closing of the borders, however, to individual movements. Agreement of US High Commissioner to these measures was also made in additional consideration that, had no agreement been reached, entire movement of the refugees might be directed to the US Zone.

Treatment: In countering Polish Government claims (and on any media inside Germany presenting same charges) that Western Allies have acted in an inhumane manner, emphasize following

facts in forthright, non-defensive tone.

l. US and its Western Allies, in present situation, have been motivated by humane considerations both for refugees and Federal Republic population. Welfare of Federal Republic has already been prejudiced by millions of refugees seeking shelter there from inhumanity of Soviet dominated governments of the east. To admit more refugees indiscriminately to Western Germany might impose hardships with regard to housing, food and employment upon citizens of the Federal Republic.

2. US is determined not to endanger benefits which sacrifices of US citizens bring to German nation by permitting Polish Government in collusion with GDR authorities to force

sacrifices from resources of Western Germany.

3. In this situation Western Allies cannot go beyond their generous agreement to accept 25,000 of refugees from Eastern 65076





In view fact bmbassy since Sep 49 has reported regularly by WEEKA and otherwise complete details re Pakistan wheat surplus and has reiterated seriousness problem due expectation new harvest as yield additional exportable surplus double present quantity with inadeauate storage facilities Embass; believes Department Army and SCAP fully informed. With GOP so far reluctant offer wheat at prices interesting to possible purchasers problem cannot be solved either by Embassy or SCAP but if SCAP should express villingness reopen negotiations Embassy might be able assist."
