State Circular of Sep 28, 9 AM procedures for co-ordination in handling of assistance to Republic of Korea.

Steps set down below have been agreed to by United Nations and unified command to facilitate during present emergency co-ordination for prompt and expeditious handling offers of assistance from member Govts, specialized agencies and non-governmental orgs, and of requests of assistance from US.

A. Mil assistance.

(1) Offers of mil assistance from member govts will be transmitted to SYG of UN who, in turn, will transmitt offers to UN through US mission to UN. Requests from UC for additional effective assistance in Korea may be transmitted to SYG for communication to permanent delegations of member govts.

(2) Upon receipt of offer UC will enter into direct negots with the member govt concerned regarding details of offer and its utilization or in respect other effective assistance which member govt might be in a position provide.

(3) Upon completion direct negots UC will inform the SYG of their results. The SYG will transmit this info to del of the member govt concerned and, in consultation with UC and delegation concerned, will release this info to the press.

B. Relief measures.

(1) Requirements for relief measures in Korea both in supplies and personnel will be determined by appropriate branches of UC Tokyo and Korean Govt. Most urgently needed supplies will be procured locally through UC Tokyo. Notification total requirements will be made to UC, Washington and will be forwarded to UN by UC together with an indication of loose requirements of great emergency basis.

(2) UC will transmit to SYG through US mission to UN requests for assistance based on all requirements. In turn SYG will transmit to UC through US mission to UN all offers assistance including all responses to requests of UC from govts, specialized agencies and non-governmental orgs.

(3) SYG will act as focal, coordinating point for requests and offers assistance. SYG will channel requests for assistance to permanent dels of member govts, to appropriate specialized agency or agencies; and, where appropriate, to non-governmental orgs.

(4) After UC has indicated interest in an offer of assistance by a member govt, SYG will enter into prelim consultations to crystallize offer. The prelim consultations may involve questions of transportation, specifications of types of supplies offered, advancing suggested dates of delivery increase in quantities certain items more urgently needed at expense of others, etc in so far as this info is necessary make offer specific. (All arrangements for packing, title to and moving supplies will be left for negot between UC and contributing govt).

(5) SYG will continue explore availabilities with permanent dels member govts, specialized agencies and where appropriate with non-governmental orgs, and will keep UC informed of various steps he takes in implementing request.

(6) SYG will maintain a summary of requests and offers of assistance showing extent to which requests are being met. He will keep UC currently informed of status of its requests for assistance.

(7) When UC has received an offer assistance through SYG will inform SYG, whether it will make immed use of offer or prefer hold it under consideration for time being.

(8) If the UC desires hold and offer under consideration, SYG will inform permanent del of member govt, specialized agency, or non-governmental org concerned. Where an offer can not be immed utilized but may be required at a later stage, SYG will also inform delegation of member govt, specialized agency or non-governmental org, and will also endeavor keep offer open until it is required. When UC has come to conclusion an offer can not be utilized, UC will so inform SYG, who in turn will inform del of member govt, specialized agency or non-governmental org.

(8) Where practicable SYG will inquire whether that govt, specialized agency or non-governmental org is in position provide other supplies or services which have been specifically requested by UC.

(9) When UC has indicated it desires make immed use of an offer, it will so inform SYG and will then enter it into direct negots with member govt, specialized agency or non-governmental org, concerned regarding technical and admin questions involved in trans supplies in question to Korean theater. US will keep SYG currently informed of status of these negots. SYG will take into account progress of negots in maintaining rpt maintaining record of ovr: all status of requests and offers of assistance.

(10) SYG has estab Korean Relief Assistance Fund where monetary contributions will be deposited for use in general program. SYG will inform UC of all monetary contributions offered and received. If a member govt has made a contribution of funds, SYG will consult permanent del of donor govt regarding the use of its contribution by UN or specialized agencies to purchase supplies and transport or meet orther countries. SYG will also consult with UC on use to be made of these funds. SYG will submit fin accounts to permanent reps of contributing govts showing how funds contributed by their govts have been used.

(11) Where no specific offer assistance made, but a member govt has indicated, through SYG, its readiness enter into direct consultations in order define nature its assistance, SYG will initiate these consultations and will inform UC of results.

(12) Where a member govt transmits to SYG an offer from a private firm, SYG will suggest to member govt that it enter direct negots with private firm concerned for purpose of resubmitting it though govt. Whenever practicable, this procedure will be used with regard offers from non-governmental orgs, except in those cases where non-governmental orgs are sufficiently well-orgnd handle contributions of their natl members on an internatl scal scale prs 3. 3. Prs, league of Red Cross societies.

(13) Representatives non-governmental orgs or specialized agencies who may be attached to UN comand, Tokyo, for purpose of providing their agencies with on the-spot by reports regarding utilization of supplies and services provided by these agencies, will not be used as channels for trans mission requests from or offers of assistance to UC. Any info they may provide will be used by orgs concerned, by SYG, and by the UC as background material

Presently arranging prvt deal involving 100 tons Iran cotton (Filestani) in exchange equivalent yardage Jap textiles; may also involve Iran rice. Emb satisfied Kobayashi not purporting rep Jap Govt and earlier news reports unfounded, as frequently case here.

"Kobayashi finds Iran merchants not well acquainted Jap goods and difficult sell. Except cotton and possibly rice, Kobayashi believes traditional Iran exports like goat sheep skins, wool, other raw materials, will find few Jap takers. Signed Grady".

Re 043 Gen Kara Songgras Chief Thai Joint Staff offered Gunboat Macklong 1250 tons and Navy transport Siaphang 850 tons to stay in Korean waters and become part of UN fleet after lifting wps. Thai now negotiating to charter Danish Hertz Maersk for Korea instead of Thai 131. 15 Oct sailing date unchanged. Thai requested use of 2-4 engine planes to operate between Korea and Thailand to carry replacements, evacuate sick and wounded carry mail. I gave no encouragement saying we were in short supply and chartered such ships from normal lines. They desire to train crews to fly these planes. Although not mentioned to Thai possibly MATS now coming to Bangkok could be used. Both this request and offer of Navy ships will be confirmed on 30th level. Query: Thai desire wide publicity on departure any security objections. Thai group for conference with Gen MacArthur's staff Tokyo now enlarged to 12: 6 Army, 1 Navy, 1 Air, 1 Red Cross and me if approved to leave 29 Sep.

Subject is Korean currency.

1. Pls advise immed as ROK FORMIN announces new areas subj to conversion Bank of Korea for Bank of Chosun notes pursuant Art 2, presidential emergency ordinance No 10, giving dates conversion periods and any significant deviation from terms initial announcement applicable Southeast Korea. Specifically what steps taken Inchon and Saohok beachheads under this ordinance. Are steps being carried out by ROK or by UN forces.

2. Consideration being given here to problem status North Korean currency in liberated areas. Pending decision and development plans based thereon, considered advisable here no action be taken by ROK which wld be prejudicial ultimate determination treatment be accorded North Korean currency. Accordingly believe no action shld be taken at this time either to invalidate or prohibit its circulation or withdraw it from circulation. On other hand such currency shld not be accorded legal tender status. Any intelligence as to unofficial rates of exchange between and rough comparison extent of circulation of 2 currencies in newly liberated areas wld be most helpful in further consideration problem as to location, condition and quantity recovered new ROK currency printed by US Treasury in 1947 and held unissued in vaults bank Korea, Seoul. Feeling here that if recovered substantially intact supply shld be held in vaults pending further consideration appropriate disposition. If already placed in circulation shld be handled in accordance

He believes, if western nations refrain from interfering with free play of forces (on Formosa), result of Korean developments is likely be strengthening of Commie China's position in relation to USSR.

Husk has received from Dening in NY text of 2 tels from Brit Amb Moscow, who, in speculating on USSR's reaction to turn of mil tide in Korea, says that, if Sovs realize that prospect of tangible gain for Communism in Korea has evaporated, they must seek to minimize Commie setback. While Sovs would presumably welcome restoration status quo ante, Amb feels they would be somewhat inhibited from putting forth proposals designed forestall UN occupation North Korea. Neutralize danger this would constitute by fact they would either be forced link themselves too closely to lost cause or too obviously disavow their Commie proteges. They would, however, take advantage of any well-intentioned but naive proposal which might be suggested in UN. If no such proposal is forthcoming, principal Sov effort would have to be in propaganda field or it could take form of attempt distract world's attention from Commie losses in Korea by heightening tensions at another point, e.g., Berlin or Indo China. As to whether USSR will consider defeat in Korea sufficient cause for war, Brit Amb notes Soviet losses in men and material in last war, Amer industrial potential and atom stockpile, transitional and unconsolidated status of "new democracies" and Soviet addiction to grandiose planning argue against war. On other hand, actual Soviet superiority conventional arms and organized manpower, and their consequent ability seize all advance bases in Europe and sources of oil etc, in Asia might impel USSR to war. Amb feels arguments against war likely prevail feeling that occupation of

While continuing to assert NK successes and to denounce bombing and shelling of UN milit tgts, these commentators apparently are finding it necessary to offer some explanation for failure NK Forces to push on into sea.

"The Interventionists, making use of natural boundaries rivers and mts, have formed powerful line of defense in Pohang-Taegu-Pusan triangle. Up to 6 Am Div, remnants of Syngman Rhee units and an immense amt materiel have been concentrated in a small section of Southern part of Korea. The aggressors calculated not only on halting offensive of Peoples Army but also on carrying out a large scale counter offensive."

Altho such arts invariably conclude on confident note certainty victory, "Korean patriots", Sov reader cannot fail to detect that all is not going entirely well."

UP Jess Sep 10, reporting joint press conference of Pres Rhee and Gen Church quotes Rhee to effect UN advance imminent and "We will not stop until Reds driven entirely out of Korea."

Dept fully appreciates difficulty limiting expression Rhee's views on advance beyond 38th and relation this subj to Kor morale. However, important that all Amer personnel dealing with Rhee and senior ROK Govt personnel carefully avoid expressing views on this subj that could in any way be interpreted as expression of US policy. This complex question is being considered at highest levels US Govt in light many changing factors including vital importance of maintaining high degree of UN support for whatever policies are adopted. You will be informed of decisions when reached, and, any communication thereof to Govt ROK can be made only by you as Amer Amb.

For ur info in reply to question on television interview on Sep 10 Sec replied that he should like to underline that whether or not "we stop at the 38th Parallel" is a UN decision. He went on to state that "the UN have set up the goal of a united and free Kor. That was in their resolution in the GA in 47 and 48. Now, how this UN operation is conducted is for the UN to decide. And --- the UN cannot decide that until it is clear as to how and under what circumstances its forces reach the 38th Parallel."

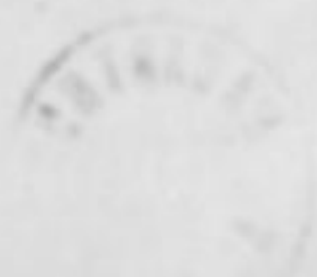
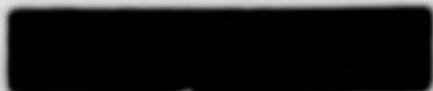

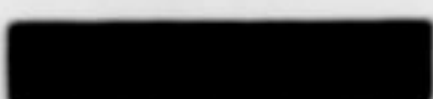
