For your info representatives, Dept of Justice Mission, will be in Honolulu on or about 16 April 51 and will be available for consultation reference investigations in Japan.

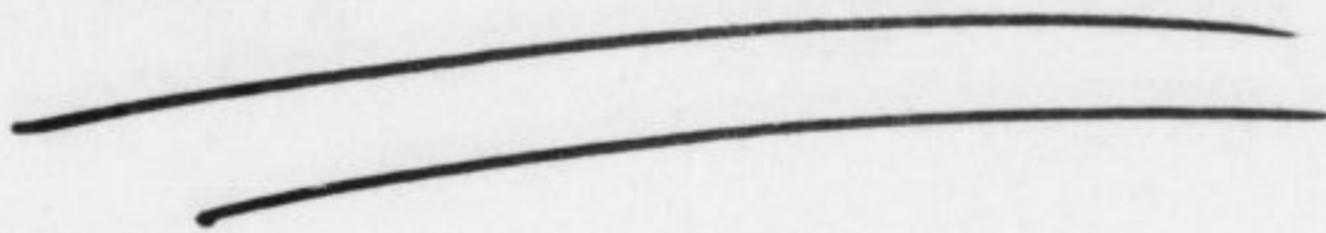
