B. Any cotton procured from proceeds of exports, OJEIRF money or other non-appropriated funds will, if procured by the DA here, be limited to US cotton to be shipped from US ports.





Reference WX 93680, ZGOG 43, CX 58J53. Conference helo by Under Secty Eraper attended by representatives of Army Comptroller, P and O, CINCLE, USAFIK, subject Korean Trace with Japan and Pay As You Go. USAFIK comments on WX >3600 Were considered.

Para 2. Regarding trade with Japan, tentative position of DA, subject to agreement of other interested agencies, is that order of source of payment as given in WX 93680 to remain unchanged. Item C to be reworded substantially as follows: "Dollars available for this purpose from Pa, As You Go proceeds." Tals is interpreted to permit CG USAFIK reasonable latitude in determining extent of availability of Pay As You Go funds for payment to Japan, but will not authorize commitment of Pay As You Go proceeds entirely to purposes other than payment of Japanese commitments.

Para 3. With reference CX 58053, which indicates position of CINCER regarding change in 50 to 1 military conversion rate at this time, Under Secty desires a statement earliest of CG "SAFIK regarding conversion rate. Implementation of Pay As You Go will not change existing situattion whereby individuals occupying quarters for dependents are required to give up quarters allowances. Question of amount of custodial and maintenance service furnished with quarters as a charge against ESA funds, to be determined by the theater. Week characterized by difficulties of Korean and Palestinian UN Commission in carrying out their assignments, by stiffening Iranian attitude toward USSR and by further development Anti Communist measures in Europe.

UN Commission Kores, having been refused entry Soviet Zone and having consulted only Korean Rightists and Moderates, is sending chairman back to UN for further instructions. Meanwhile Communist controlled Leftists in South Korea refused to cooperate Commission and committed numerous acts violence and sabotage to protest against commission and attempt to discredit US Mil Occupation. Acts sporadic and relatively ineffective, and public order unimpaired.

Communist attacks on Nats lines of communications south of Mukden continue, denying reinforcement from North China. Civil disturbances symptomatic dissatisfaction present regime which may soon lack minimum popular support necessary for survival.

Palestine and Korea continue perplexing. UN Palestine Commission has requested Security Council to provide it with non Palestinian Armed Force lacking which it can neither maintain order in Palestine upon termination of mandate nor carry out its mission. 3 lines of action appear open to Security Council: 1 find the armed force, 2 refer matter to Gen Assembly for reconsideration or 3 refer matter to International Court of Justice. Neither of the 2 latter alternatives solves more immediate problem of maintaining order in Palestine upon termination of mandate.

About 6,000 Arab volunteers are estimated to have entered Palestine to help the 100,000 armed Palestinian Arabs of which some 10 to 15,000 are in loosely organized units. The Arabs are based on hills of Western Galilee and those of Mablus area. Their operations show evidence of organization and planting and are currently directed at covering entry of Arab bands into Palestine, blockade of Jewish Communities and capture of stores. Against Arab initiative, the 90,000 Zionists Militia are employed about 2/3 in static defense and 1/3 for offensive

and relief operations.

In Morea Soviets are moving rapidly to forestall UN action by setting up Morean state which will eventually claim sovereignty over whole nation and which Soviets will be willing to recognize. Establishment of Morth Korean Peoples Army, estimated at 125,000, has been proclaimed and radio has announced submission

1. As explained onally to Gen Helmick, the Secretary has modified budget procedure for occupied areas by assuming here overall responsibility for the GARIOA Budget and responsibility for availability and expenditure of GARIOA Funds for Category 1 items subj to theater determination of requirements for type and quantity of items. With latter info we will procure items desired or nearest available substitutes. This change became necessary because of several factors:

A. Current Congressional practice of making only partial appropriations but authorizing accelerated expenditure there of . Under such installment method of appropriating we are in best position to estimate total funds which should be available and Secretary recognized that it was impossible for theaters to be held to rigid budget procedure as this would unduly out rations although we believe clear Congressional intent is to provide dequate funds ultimately.

P. Inclusion of large amounts of surplus items bought by Commodity Credit Corporation can best be worked out here.

C. Total GARIOA Funds must be managed flexibly as to theaters and projects to obtain optimum usefulness.





This mag referred to in Para 4 of WX 96597. It covers Budget Projects 113, 123, 133, 153, and 423. Of total cut of \$150,000,000 last Dec, only \$2,000,000 was applied to Korea in tentative working apportionment of appropriation. However no definite allocation of remaining funds can be made because out for Germany necessitated by congressional expressions accompanying appropriation was so heavy that entire appropriation must be utilized for most immediate needs of either area pending receipt of further appropriation. Secretary Royall has directed US to proceed upon assumption that at least \$100,000,000 will be restored. This would go to Germany and should obviate above problems.

Cut of \$2,000,000 above mentioned constituted only provision for cereal pipeline shomts to be made curing Jul but purchased from current year's funds in Jun. Even if appropriation cut is restored, we cannot restore such pipeline because of necessity for providing funds for advance contracts to operate ordnance fertilizer plant: after 1 Jul which through error were not included in deficiency request and for additional costs of fertilizer transp which were underestimated in Dec justification. However, we have working arrangement with commodity credit corporation under which Jul shpmts will be set up as planned and should not be delayed because of unavailability of 47 funds before 1 Jul.

As to Project 133 we believe that since POL for civ use is procured by &M in conjunction with its purchases for mil requirements, and since state for procurement is prepared ty you, you will need to continue manage funds on this project.

This is message referred to in Par 4 of WN 96599. It covers budget Projects 112, 122, 132, 152 and 422. Of total cut of \$150,000,000 in appropriation last Dec, only \$19,000,000 was applied to Japan in tentative working apportionment. However, no definite allocation of remaining funds can be made because cut for Germany messaitated by Congressional expressions accompanying appropriation was so heavy that entire appropriation under Projects 110, 120, 150 and 420 must be utilized for most immediate needs of either area pending receipt of further appropriation. Secretary Royall has directed US to proceed upon assumption that at least \$100,000,000 of cut will be restored. This would go to Germany and should largely obviste above problems.

We have prepared alternate food plans for Japan and Ryukyus; Program 1 on assumption of restoration of \$100,000,000 and Program 2 on assumption of restoration of full \$150,000,000. Difference between them is only 200,000 tons of food which will be either all im graim or part graim and part sugar depending upon availability of graim. Stated in brown rice equivalent Program 1 will be about 1,825,000 tons of all foods for Japan ant Ryukyus, and Program 2 will be full 2,025,000 tons, the same figure as in justification last Dec. Difference between Program 1 and Program 2 is limited to food. All other profects are considered firm on either of such contingencies. Will cable separately details of food program. Other programs for fertilizer, seed, medical supplies, POL, remain im substance as you know them.
