Request for offers would state that 25 per cent margin had been deposited with three banks. 



Part 1. Sterling receipt aide membire Br Emb 4 Dec 47 containing Br views and suggested amendments US proposal transmitted ourad W 85805. Text Br aide memoire follows:

"His Majesty's Embassy refers to Dept of States aide memoire of Aug 25, 47 concerning financial arrangements for trade between Japan and sterling area. This embassy wisnes to record that, subj to the comments set forth below, the terms of Dept of States aide memoire are generally acceptable to his Majesty's govt in the UB as basis for trade between Japan and the UK and its colonies, with exception of Hong Kong. His Majesty's Govt in the UK share the hope of Dept State that those Br dominions which are members of the sterling area, and also the Govt of Iraq, will desire to adhere to the proposed arrangement, but they cannot of course in any way extend this agreement to cover such countries without their specific concurrence.

With regard to the wording of the proposed specific

provisions it is desired to suggest fol changes:

deleted the phrase or other sterling acquired from areas outside the sterling area and which is currently convertible to US dollars under applicable International agreements and understanding. His Majesty's Govt is prepared to examine any case where SCAP may wish to pay sterling to or receive sterling from 3d countries, but they regret that for the present







Western and Central Europe probably traceable to polithuro perplexity as to next move after recent developments in France, Italy, Greece and London Conference. However, unrestrained violence of Soviet propaganda against US and capitalism as well as numerous reliable reports of ruthlessness of Soviet and satellite communists in strenuous efforts to establish solidarity among eastern European states indicate clearly intentions of Moscow leaders to persist in pursuit long term objectives notwithstanding current repulses in west. Unrelenting pressure on Greece continues and an internal communist demonstration in force looms in Italy.

Guerrilla attack on Konitsa on unprecedented scale for Greek communist operations. Lifting of siege therefore an achievement for Greek government forces but unlikely to give them any respite since bulk of guerrillas escaped to retain capabilities of continuing incessant harassing attacks on villages and national army detachments. Recent authorized increase of Greek regulars by 12,000 men and of local defense units to 100 battalions totaling approximately 50,000 expected to strengthen Greek offensive capabilities and to improve prospects of stamping out guerrilla forces provided latter do not receive substantial assistance from outside Greece and provided Greek Army left free of political interference.



Part 1. Representative of Charles Rudolph Corp did not assert that sales had been negotiated on basis indicated ourad but did assert and reiterate his receipt of verbal assurance that sales would be made on such basis when transfer of sales

program from USCC was completed.

Part 2. Rpt recommendation that all sales in both US and Japan continue to be on basis of grade only. Grade buying is neither enforced nor restrictive. On contrary Raw Silk Council in meeting on 26 Dec urgently requested that sales continue to be made only by grade. Council considers that sale by certificate is function of dealers and that sale by certificate by Boeki Cho would impinge upon their business. Dealers, of course, obtain premium prices for certain lots acquired by grade and subsequently sold by them to selected users requiring SP qualifications in cleanness, neatness or other characteristics. Dealers maintain that this is profit feature to which they are fully entitled to warrant their assuming risk of purchase for inventory and their utmost efforts to promote distribution and consumption of raw silk. Dealers insist that Boeki Cho is not able as they to determine proper premium values for sales by certificate and would in fact through sales by certificate be undercutting and unfairly competing with dealers. It has been decided that a level of \$500 should be established as a maximum sllowed to be exchanged for any one individual per currency conversion without sutometic certifications and varying degrees of investigation. Authorized banking facilities, frmy or commercial, are now available in the comparatively static situation in oversess areas. The holding of more than this amount in MPCs, except in uncommon cases, is not believed to be in the individual's financial interest due to the actual bulk of the amount if carried on the person with the associated possibility of loss and the unwarranted risk connected with the keeping of same in footlockers, personal quarters, etc. Although a ceiling of \$500 is established officiels effecting the conversion should be instructed to question eny smaller sums which are presented under unusual circumstances or by individuels who by their rank, grade or civilian position would not normally be in possession of the declared amount.

C. Subj signing \$5 and \$10 MPCs. The practice of having all personnel sign the \$5 and \$10 denomination MPCs they turn in on "C Day" has been used in the Maditerranean Theater with success. It has facilitated the expeditious handling of notes at finance offices, giving adequate protection against counterfaiting to the accountable finance officers. Although the FEC has not as yet encountered difficulties of this nature, it is believed appropriate that precautionary action be taken against the possibility of counterfaits appearing in the future.

D. Subj conversion of MPCs by individuals leaving MPC areas. The DA has noted that many exceptional cases in past conversions have arisen due to personnel failing to convert their holdings of MPCs prior to departure from MPC areas. Para 5 has been introduced in the proposed letter to cover this situation to the maximum extent possible. All personnel must be admonished to utilize commercial or armed forces facilities which are made available for the convenience and safety of the

Soviet propaganda which has been concentrating on violent abuse of US now turning propaganda machine on UK Bolicy in Near East probably in effort to check rising British popularity in Arab world and as retaliation for recent forthright denunciations of Communism and Soviet aims by British leaders. Bevins advocacy of Western European alliance indicates further shift from position of honorable appeasement of USSR to one of sharing leadership with US in combatting Communist menace.

Evidence accumulates of intention Arab leaders to present unyielding opposition to Palestine Partition. Reports of increasing violence in Palestine and obvious difficulties of establishing new Jewish and Arab Govts without cooperation of present British adminstration and possibly without mil force to maintain order during transitional period may necessitate

reconsideration UN Assembly plan.

Soviet refusal to admit UN Commission to North Korea presents alternatives of proceeding with elections in South Korea or referring matter to UN for further instructions. Settlement of Indonesian dispute after acceptance of truce agreement on 17 Jan encountering difficulties currently owing to Dutch refusal to accept Indonesiar qualifications of supplementary political provisions in agreement.
