Director Gen, ILO, in accordance with decision of governing body at its 107th Session, has requested US Govt to convey to SCAP and invitation to send a tripartite del (govt, employers, workers) of obsrs to the 32d Session of the International Labor Conf (Geneva 6 Jun 49) and to send a similar del to the 31 Session of the Coal Mines Committee (PGH, 20 Apr 49). In respect of each of these meetings it was emphasized in the governing body that the obsrs apt to represent the Japanese employers and the Japanese workers respectively should be free to exp the views of those whom they would represent at the meetings in a manner consistent with the tripartite character of the International Labor Orgn. The representative of the US Govt on the governing body undertook to bring this point to the notice of the prop auth.

US Govt would have no objection to Japanese participation in relevant ILO meetings and ILO policy decisions of 9 Jun 48 entitled attendance at Intergovernmental conf is regarded as interposing no obstacle if you ap in sending Japanese obsrs. The US Govt is prep. to set in ILO and elsewhere your appt invitation for Japs to attend these meetings in such capacity. Your comments requested.

Part 1.

A. Trend of discussions in FEC on economic stabilization directive appears to be generally favorable due to efforts here to make info avail in progress in carrying out directive. Principal interest among FEC members is in measures taken by Japanese Govt to cope with unemployment problem.

B. Published DAMJLAVAL here seem to indicate that scope and character of problem in

- (1) 670,000 were jobless in Aug 48 according to Japanese Govt survey,
- (2) 800,000 estd to have been unemployed end of 48,
- (3) During coming FY Japanese Govt has estd add unemployment of 1,700,000, of which 400,000 will come from Govt adm readjustments, 600,000 from rationalization of pvt enterprises, 200,000 repatriates, 400,000 part time workers, and 100,000 sch graduates.

C. Rpts in newspapers also suggest the fol solutions to this unemployment problem:

- (1) Export industries and other pvt enterprises will employ 1,000,000;
- (2) Public works will take care of 400,000;
- (3) Unemployment ins will care for 550,000.

Part 2. Rqst soonest confirmation or correction of above with indications of what would be proper to inform FEC regarding progress being made in coping with problem.

The following recommendation regarding trial of Japanese War Criminals, received from State, Army, Navy and AF Lepts is transmitted for your info.

"The Far Eastern Commission makes the following recommendations to member governments of the commission:

"If possible, investigations in connection with offenses falling under par 1 (b) and 1 (c) of the policy decision of the Far Eastern Commission entitled 'apprehension, trial and punishment of war criminals in the Far East' (FEC-007/3) passed by the commission on 3 Apr 46, including such offenses alleged to have been committed by persons suspected of offenses falling under par 1 (s) of the said policy decision, should be completed before 30 Jun 49, and all trials thereof should be concluded if possible before 30 Sep 49."

US Govt requested FEC to delay publishing the foregoing until it is dispatched to you. It will be declassified at time of release.

However, from long term view point, assuming intention of Jap Govt to repay entire indebtedness OFPC, Dept regards proposed acquisition of real property and improvements for FBO, possible educational programs under Fulbright Act, if latter should eventually materialize, as means of liquidating indebtedness without drain upon Jap dollar exchange position except for relatively minor amounts for annual rentals which otherwise would be paid in dollars. Both FBO and Fulbright programs are authorized under US laws which do not permit expenditure dollars by US Govt. Many other govts in all parts of world have welcomed these methods of liquidating surplus indebtedness.

Re objections:

(A) Basis stated airtel implies any unpaid balance indebtedness under credit letter Sept 3, 46 would not be repaid on terms to be arranged in Jap peace settlement. Although not expressly stated in credit letter and subsidiary contracts 500 and 501, such understanding is regarded by Dept as implicit in terms stated in such documents and is expressly stated in Art 4 Drafts Agreement quoted WA 85753 Mar 17. If nec to avoid appearance of duress, however, USPOLAD is authorized to waive proposed US option for prior crediting against contracts 502, 503 and 504.
