Ref msg specifies ZI orientation of trps returning from Korea. Opinion this office that additional orientation should be given en route to US. To give such orientation at US port would result in unfav returnee reaction against additional delay prior to departure for home. Suggest shipboard as most desirable place for orientation. Consider that 2-hour orientation course should be given, subjects as fol:

A. Review of sit in Korea to date, present sit in US, steps taken to unify European defenses, outstanding record of Army units in Korea.

B. Responsibilities of combat soldiers returning from Korea.

Material in A, above, may be covered in a special edition of Stars and Stripes, 1 copy to be issued to each returning soldier. Would provide factual info for troops, and prevent incorrect interpretation of curr sit by troops. Revised special edition could be issued to each group returning to US.

Fol info should be covered under subject B, above:

1. Soldiers have been through battle, and will be looked upon as experts by new soldiers and the American people in home communities.

2. Troops can do an invaluable svc to the United States by presenting undistorted story of their experiences; a few returnees have created a faulty picture of sit, thus damaging Army in eyes of public and providing support to Communist propaganda. In addition, troops should be cautioned to present

Part 1. It is reqstd that all of the items in the following 4 parts be studied prior to arrival of Gen Tansey on or about 9 Apr and that you discuss them with him while he is in Far East Comd.

Part 2. On 28 Mar, San Fran port advised that Rqn DC-416 for 150 addl Bailey bridges, and Rqn DB-423 for 30 addl Treadway bridges had just been received. These 2 rqn represent approx 50 percent increase in rqmts for these 2 items and are over and above the quantities which have presently been planned and budgeted for. In view of the heavy demands for these bridges it is requested that your needs therefore be restudied and that every effort be made to reduce rqmts to a minimum.

Part 3. Cable from Cmdr in Chief Far East Comd dtd 24 Mar recommended transfer without reimb, of 58 prefab bldgs to ROK for shelter of civs, and stated that he could foresee no mil need for the bldgs. Terms of transfer agreement stipulated that vsls were to be returned by ECA to Army in as good condition as that in which received, making allowance for reasonable wear and tear. Understanding here that Navy does not desire to have subj vsls under their control. Marshall said Sporrer was in error in saying that 11th Marine Regt met the same initial attack that hit the 31st Regt. He said records clearly show Marine unit moved to different sector before Chinese assault.

Marshall also stated that withdrawal operation was not a flight but effort on part of infantry to fight way back to junction with 1st Marines and that they had been ordered to make such an operation and most of the Regiment including Colonel Commanding had been lost in the effort to carry out the order. Colonel Marshall denied that there was cowardice on the part of the Army troops and strongly commended the way the soldiers handled themselves under extremely difficult conditions.

Informatively there has been no inclination on part of Navy or Marine Corps here to contradict Chaplain Sporrer. CINPO feels

Marshall also stated that withdrawal operation was not a flight but effort on part of infantry to fight way back to junction with 1st Marines and that they had been ordered to make such an operation and most of the Regiment including Colonel Commanding had been lost in the effort to carry out the order. Colonel Marshall denied that there was cowardice on the part of the Army troops and strongly commended the way the soldiers handled themselves under extremely difficult conditions.

Informatively there has been no inclination on part of Navy or Marine Corps here to contradict Chaplain Sporrer. CINPO feels

that in order to clear up this situation it is imperative that General Smith, commanding the 1st Marine Division, make a public statement as to the truth in the matter and clear the good name of the Army personnel involved. A clear cut statement from General Smith similar to that given by Colonel Marshall (whose report General Smith has in his possession) would be most important factor in eliminating public controversy and refuting allegations of Sperrer.

Will you advise CINPO soonest if such can be accomplished and send priority any statement made by General Smith.
