Reour WCL 48896 (TCMOV DC 752 dtd 2 Oct current year). This is semimonthly situation summary and generalized shipping forecast or movement of dependents to ETO and Japan. Instructions contained part 1 above signal apply.

Part 1-Backlog on Dec 1 for dependents destined European theater, excluding France and Belgium, is 4750, principally Oct and Nov priorities. Still awaiting port call on these priority lists are dependents with children 6 months to 6 years of age inclusive. Dependents without children, or with children over 6 years of age are now being called from Dec list. Forecast of probable call dates for dependents with children 6 months to 6 years inclusive on Dec list remains as in part 1, WCL 29988, 15 Nov 46.

Part 2-Positive action now being taken by CG NYPE to increase vessel capacity wherever possible to provide additional spaces suitable for infants, and small children. Known results of this action are not yet sufficiently clear to accurately estimate total effect on European theater backlog; however, when program is fully implemented, net effect will be to accelerate movement of dependents with children below age of 7, and to reduce over-all vessel

It is desired that Col 3 be prepared to show MDC requirements broken down on a project level. Other columns need only be completed to show requirements on a major project level, except for appropriations normally allocated on a specific project basis (contingencies of the Army; Quartermaster Service Army, Welfare of EM; Quartermaster Service Army, regular supplies, project 129; etc). Columnar form will be accompanied by such additional justification as you may desire to submit. Justification for project 129, Quartermaster Service Army, regular supplies, should include breakdown of requirements for Engineer Service (heating), Quartermaster Service (vehicles), and Transportation Service (boat; locomotive) for all 4 quarters.

Due date of quarterly request is extended from 10 Dec to 15 Dec in order to allow for mailing time.

Only pertinent press material single editorial in Baltimore Sun this date commenting on statement by Professor Robert Oliver, Syracuse University, recently returned from survey of Korean conditions. After reviewing Yalta Agreement and the resultant 38th Parallel Div which has split the country into 2 airtight compartments," editorial continues: "The results are pointed out by Professor Oliver, who has seen them. The basis for the throttling of Korean recovery, he writes, is in the fact that industry, mines and hydroelectric power are concentrated in the Russian held area, while the agriculture is in the American Zone. With that artery of trade completely cut, the country has no chance economically. People in Northern Korea get insufficient food while those in the Southern section find no consumer goods on the market. The inevitable result is inflation which is growing beyond reason. Unemployment is high. Even the avenue of relief by imports is cut off by the policy of military occupation.

Meanwhile, Professor Oliver finds, the Russians are engaged in stamping out Nationalism in their zone and promoting the interests of the Communist Party, thereby directing any emergence of political feeling and responsibility into their own channels. He deplors the lack of a definite policy on the part of this country toward the development of Korean Independence politically. It is his

contention that we should disband our Military Government in Korea, leave troops there as 'a bar to further Russian aggression,' make every effort to force Russia to withdraw from Northern Korea, and give such material aid to the country that it can have a chance to establish itself.

There are certain practical obstacles in the way of Professor Olivers plan. One is the extreme improbability of getting Russia to withdraw. Another is based on the fact that Korea lived under the heavy hand of Japanese domination for 35 years. In such circumstances, it takes time to develop the vigorous political institutions which are the essential basis of responsible self government. The fact remains that Korea is the Cinderella of World War II, and that our efforts in her behalf, so far, have been nothing to be proud of."

1. Request clarification of statement that "Conversion of 20 SCAJAP Liberties has been initiated".
2. War Dept awaits with interest completion of study to determine most efficient utilization of CIMAVI, Baltic and Liberty shipping in order that schedule for release of remaining SCAJAP Liberties can be determined.
3. For your info the Govt Bureau of the Budget has made decision that WD will not be charged bareboat charter hire on Maritime Commission vessels which are directly used for WD business. However, the Maritime Commission expects to collect charter hire on vessels used by foreign Govts for example SCAJAP Liberties used by British.
4. Although Navy delivers fuel for SCAJAP and CIMAVI ships the WD reimburses the Navy for fuel used since these vessels were chartered on bareboat charter basis by WD from Maritime Commission. These merchant ships are all WD vessels placed under AFPAC control for specific purposes of expediting repatriation in case of Liberty ships and of meeting coastal shipping needs in case of CIMAVIS.

Subj is clothing for civilian supply in Korea. Urad TFYMG 2839, Oct 8 received concurrently with SCAP's ZX 20694, 7 Oct info copy of which addressed CG USAFIK. SCAP cable includes statment "Expect to ship bulk of supplies to Korea."

All available clothing and related items set up in approved program for civilian supplies, QM section, part WP-66 dtd 16 Oct, 2 copies of which airmailed CG USAFIK.

Since SCAP has undertaken distribution these supplies among Korea, Japan and Ryukyus suggest USAFIK state its case direct to SCAP.

Note that no shoes available for inclusion in program WP-66. However, civilian supply shoes have been set up for Japan in programs WP-38 and WP-61 dtd 2 July and 23 Sep respectively. Thus to obtain shoes for Korea, USAFIK must obtain a allotment from SCAP.

To SCAP-new subj. Calls forward for clothing and shoes. So far as records here indicate programs WP-61 or WP-66 not called forward to date. Urge promptest action, not only to give add during coldest season in Korea but also to release storage space here. Shipment of WP-38 in progress.

W H Chamberlin, in today's Wall Street Journal said: A prolonged deadlock has prevailed in the administration of Korea. We hold the southern part, the Russians the northern part. A Far Eastern expert with whom I recently discussed the Korean situation remarked with a smile that the American showing had not been overly brilliant, but that the Russians had been so much worse that we came out fairly well on a comparative basis. Over half a million Koreans have fled from the Soviet sector into the American part of Korea. Some difficulties of American Military administration have grown out of Korean inexperience in self-govt. Others are a result of conspicuous understaffing. The assumption in the beginning had been that both we and the Russians would pull out fairly quickly, leaving the Koreans to manage their own affairs. This assumption has not been justified. One of many examples of understaffing was the placing of large corporations administering perhaps \$100,000,000 worth of sequestered Japanese assets, under the charge of an officer and 2 sergeants. Unless the outlook for an agreed mutual withdrawal from Korea improves, we should strengthen our Military Govt in numbers and in quality.

UP Seoul 11 Nov: Lt Gen Hodge, American Commander in Korea, denied today "Propagandists" charges that the United States was attempting to turn Korea into an American Colony. In a statement to Koreans analyzing "Recent propaganda documents originating from subversive elements and agitators," he commented on 7 "Basic lies being told by agitators in your midst." The 7 lies were statements that the United States was colonizing Korea, that it was building bases in Korea, that it was protecting "Pro-Japanese" policy, that the American Occupation was blighting a future Korean Government with debt, that occupation authorities were building up trade and resources monopolies, that the United States was hoarding and/or shipping grain from Korea and that the Interim Legislative Assembly would be a tool of the Military Government.

Mark Gyan, Chicago Sun correspondent, Tokyo 11 Nov: It will surprise few Americans in Seoul if Gen Hodge this week voids, partly or wholly, Korea's first "Free and Democratic" election. If it comes, his action will be prompted by a wave of protests which maintain that last week's American sponsored election had been a travesty on Democratic procedure . . . the most vigorous of the protests came from Dr Kimm, chosen by the United States Army as the mainstay of the Interim Legislature . . . and of any future Government that Korea might have . . . according to Kimm, in Seoul 2 of the 3 men elected helped to whip up Korean support for the Japanese war effort . . . the election was rushed through in such haste that in some villages visited by this correspondent election notices were not posted

"Korea, although not a member of the UN, was permitted today to put her case to the International Press through UN channels by a special ruling from UN Secretary General Trygve Lie.

Lie ruled that a 3 page Korean appeal--which asked that both American and Soviet troops clear out of the nation--could be issued as UN document. The ruling came after Korea, which is represented here by a Women's College President from Seoul, Miss Louisa Yim, had failed to get a consideration of Korea on the current program of the UN General Assembly.

Miss Yim represents the "Democratic Council of South Korea"--the American Occupation Zone.

Buffalo News, 30 Oct, in an editorial comment said: "It is hard to read Supreme Commander MacArthur's report on Korea's 1st year as a liberated country without being sick at heart over the fact that the Japanese have been gone a year, and the Koreans still haven't a government of their own.

The Supreme Commander and Lt Gen Hodge, his deputy in the American Occupation of Korea south of 38th parallel, have been throwing their weight to get the Russians to resume the negotiations over the form of a Provisional Korean Democratic Government. Col Gen I M Christiakov, the Red Army Commander, will do this if the Americans agree to consult only those Koreans who supported the Trusteeship Decision.

London 30 Oct: The Moscow radio said tonight that Soviet Officials in Korea want to resume "as soon as possible" joint discussions with US authorities on the establishment of democratic provisional Government for Korea under Allied Trusteeship. The broadcast quoted a lengthy exchange of letters between General Hodge and Colonel General Chistiakov, on difference of opinion between the Russian and US delegation. It charged that the resumption of negotiations had been prevented by American attempts to deviate from instructions laid down by the Big 3 Foreign Ministers meeting at Moscow in Dec 1945. During the Allied Occupation, Korea has been divided at the 38 parallel into separate Russian and American Zones with virtually no communication between the two areas since the Soviet consulate was withdrawn from Seoul last June.

Washington post today carried a 10 column inch story under heading "Korean women want freedom, says Miss Yim". Miss Yim is President of the Central Womens College in Seoul.
