1. GARIOA funds for the Ryukyus have since the beginning of occupation been included in Japan's GARIOA projects. This has been due to the fact that Ryukyus has been under supervision of SCAP for requirements and budget purposes.

2. Supplies and services furnished the Ryukyus have not in the past exceeded those submitted by you and inasmuch as no projects have been set up in the fiscal code for Ryukyus as a separate comd, necessary funds to cover Ryukyus supplies and services have been carried under GARIOA projects for Japan. No funds have been expended for the Ryukyus at the expense of Japan.

3. Beginning FY 50, projects will be established for the Ryukyus and funds will be kept separate.

New York Herald Tribune correspondent Alley Raymond, Tokyo 18 Mar: There was much speculation here today over the reasons for statement which Gen Douglas MacArthur issued yesterday, saying that he intends to remain at his post until a Japanese peace treaty is signed, unless he is assigned elsewhere, and that predictions of civilian control of Japan are mere rumors. . . .

In American circles here the general's statement was taken as a dramatic bid for his own continued control of Japan, in open conflict with any adviser of President Truman who may wish to move the State Dept into the general's functions and relegate the Army to garrison duties here. . . .

The general's statement was headlined in the entire Japanese press this morning. . . . The effect of any removal of Gen MacArthur from the Japanese scene may be judged from a statement today by Kanechichi Masuda, Chief Cabinet Secretary that the general "has been the guiding hand for both the State and the people of Japan" since his arrival. . . .

The whole course of Japan's legislation has been practically dictated for three years by Gen MacArthur. Many Japanese like this dictation and regard the general's presence as a stabilizing factor, particularly in view of the rising Communist threat here and in China. . . .

Washington News, UP Tokyo 17 Mar: Gen Douglas MacArthur denied today reports that he intended to retire next fall and said he would handle the occupation of Japan until a peace treaty was signed-unless "assigned by the govt" to duty elsewhere. "As long as I am not assigned by the govt to duty elsewhere, I reiterate my intention to see this job thru to the signing of the peace treaty" the American occupation commander said. Political observers interpreted the statements as the first blow in an open fight between the General and his stateside critics to retain control of the occupation and prevent the State Dept from replacing him with a civilian administrator.

Political observers said after the MacArthur statement that the General would prove a strong barrier to any change in administration here now that he had stated he would have to be ordered out. His associates said they considered it a "significant blow" against persons in America who have been sniping at Gen MacArthur and "spreading rumors" that he had asked for a replacement. A Japanese Govt spokesman said he welcomed the declaration that the General would continue at his post until the treaty was signed.

New York Herald Tribune correspondent Allen Raymond, Tokyo 17 Mar: Abuse of security regulations on govt documents relating to ordinary business or commercial transactions was charged today against officials of the War Dept in Washington and Tokyo, in a statement issued to the press by the American Chamber of Commerce in Japan.

Washington Star, AP Tokyo 17 Mar: Reported Chinese Communist infiltration into Formosa is being watched closely by American military leaders. That Craggy Island north of the Philippines is a major potential weakness in the American Western Pacific defense line.

New York Times correspondent Richard J H Johnston, Seoul 16 Mar: Premier Lee Bum Suk, who holds the rank of Minister of Defense in the Korean Govt, today told a press conference that the Soviet Union was actively aiding anti-govt guerrilla forces in South Korea.

New York Times Correspondent Lindesay Parrott, Tokyo 16 Mar: Premier Shigeru Yoshida's proposal to establish an anti-Japanese Activities Committee directly under the cabinet for the investigation of subversive acts now is meeting with considerable opposition.

Premier Yoshida's plan, which thus far has not been rejected by occupation hq, would establish a body whose principal duty, it is generally understood, would be to check Communist activities.

Washington Star, AP Seoul 17 Mar: Two gunmen today killed Mrs Hovace H Underwood, wife of the former adviser to the American Occupation Mil Govt and former president of Chosen Christian College at her home. No immediate motive for the slaying was found by police, who were aided by American Army units in investigating the shooting.

Although he was adviser to the mil govt, Dr Underwood had taken no part in local politics. Police were checking possible political motives.

Radio commentator Edward R Murrow, CBS 16 Mar: Today, from Tokyo we get a complaint (United States Chamber of Commerce Presidents) about too much secrecy . . . is a sort of contagious thing in the Army or anywhere else.

Radio commentator George Thomas Folstec, NBS News Roundup from Tokyo 16 Mar: . . . This quiet instruction from Washington (To Gen MacArthur) officially closing down the class A bracket of war criminal suspect trials certainly squelches all speculation as to whether or not the Emperor of Japan will be tried. This directive applies only to American auths: it should be noted that any of our allies can still conduct trials on their own if they so wish.

Radio commentator Morgan Beatty, NBC News of the World 16 Mar: Events abroad have prompted an angry corps of Congressmen to protest against the leakage of American mil info here in the US.

"These Japanese laws, passed as must legislation at the insistence of the SCAP of those responsible to him, have almost completely ignored the principle of encouraging American business to participate in Japan's rehabilitation," the investment committee says....

New York Times correspondent Richard J H Johnston, Seoul 14 Mar: Korean Army forces have opened a spring offensive against Communist led guerrilla bands that are terrorizing South Korea. Pres. Syngman Rhee issued orders yesterday to Army commanders to capture or wipe out insurgents who, under North Korean Communist orders, have been burning villages and confiscating food and rural settlements. The most important of these gave the govt permission "if necessary" to order its Public Coal Distribution Corp to impound the mine operators revenues derived from the sales of coal for use in the priority payments of taxes and wages and for purchases of needed equip....

Meanwhile, with almost one voice, Japan's press is presenting evidence that Washington's 9 point recovery program for this country will not work. The press doesn't say so outright, but few readers could be deceived regarding the meaning....

New York Times, Seoul 12 Mar: Edgar A J Johnson, Washington Director of the ECA for Korea, arrived here today to confer with Arthur C Bunce, ECA Director in Korea. He was accompanied by Carl Girous, electric power expert who had made preliminary studies of the Korea power problem created by the North Korean Communist cut off of power.

New York Times correspondent Richard J H Johnston, Seoul 12 Mar: It was estimated here today that South Korea, in which there are 2/3's of the country's 29,000,000 people, had potential mil manpower reserves of upward of a quarter of a million men of mil age. The Korean Army, formed under American director, was recently purged of strong Communist cells fol the costly uprising beginning in the Army's ranks last Oct in Southern Cholla Province. Rad commentator Bill Costello, CBS from Tokyo 11 Mar: A vague under current of tension was developed in Tokyo, in recent weeks, as if the occupation were an "accident" on its way to "happen" somewhere... For many months there has been - increasing irritation at the Army's high handed manner of running things. Because of the fiction that this is a war theater, no one here has any civil rights. Last week an Army off in the Legal Sect of SCAP refused to give to me an interpretation of MacArthur's recent directive on foreign investments. He said that the trouble here is that we have no law and no courts. "If some gen disagrees with my interpretation, he can simply rewrite the directive. My legal opinions here are worthless." Well, that's the environment in which business must operate...

Mr Joseph M Dodge is today probably the most powerful man under MacArthur. Almost single handed, he is writing the new Japanese budget and planning Japan's economy. Some Army off's resent the fact that a mere civ has so much power. In general, there's a feeling in the air that important changes are pending.

Merchandise acquired abroad and sent as gifts to donees in US by members of US Armed Forces on duty outside continental limits of US will not be accorded duty free entry into US under Public Law 790-77th Congress, as amended by Public Law 384 18th Congress, after 30 Jun 49, unless free entry privilege is again extended by legislative action by 81st Congress. It is imperative that oversea commanders disseminate this info to all commands in order that full advantage of privilege may be taken before its expiration. See DA Memo 55-410-2 (re ltr 75-38), 13 Jan 48, for procedures. Gifts must be cleared thru US customs prior to expiration date of law.

Provisions of Tariff Act of 1930 require written consent of trademark registrants in US to be produced at time of entry on importations of merchandise of foreign or American manufacture bearing trademarks which copy or simulate a trademark properly registered under law of US; however, these provisions are not applicable to merchandise entering US which does not bear a trademark such as merchandise from which all trademarks have been obliterated or removed prior to such entry.
