Under Secretary Draper was called this morning re Miss Twohy of International Girl Scouts who is in Japan. The call came just prior to my departure and I was unable to get DA reaction to request. However, I believe Mister Draper would appreciate favorable consideration this matter if it would be appropriate to do so. - In the event extension cannot be granted full details should be furnished Wash so matter can be properly handled here. Please advise SAOUS of SCAP's action.

Substance of telephone call follows:

The International Girl Scouts sent a professional girl scout organizer, Miss Marguerite Twohy, to Japan in Oct, with the full approval of SCAP. Her permit expires 6 Feb 49. She is being paid by the Qliette Lowell Fund. Military Govt was to furnish quarters, subsistence, etc, and was to be reimbursed from the fund. She has notified her International Hq in New York that military govt has not acted upon her extension and that on 6 Feb all facilities for her will be withdrawn. The International Hq cabled Gen MacArthur asking that her permit be extended until May. They have also cabled Mrs Truman.

New subj. Mister Van Landt submitted the following concurrent

resolution in the House of Representatives on 10 Jan which was

referred to the Committee on Rules:

"Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate concurring), that the President is hereby requested, in the name of the American people, to invite on of the Army Douglas A MacArthur, US Commander in Chief, be, to return to the US for a period of at least 30 days in order that he may appear before a joint meeting of the Senate and House of Representatives to give his views on matters affecting the Security of the US and in order

"The Egyptian Govt has prohibited the export of 25,000 bales of cotton purchased last week by the Soviet Union for delivery to Czechoslovakia.

The Exchange Control Office in Alexandria of the Ministry of Fin in making the announcement said the purchase of Egyptian products with Egyptian money by enecountry for delivery to another country was contrary to the exchange regs.

"The Soviet bought the cotton in Egypt on the basis of clearing and barter deals, supposedly for its own uses. However, it was discovered last spring that the Soviet had been not only sending Egyptian cotton to Czechoslovakia but that Egyptian cotton had been sold on European markets for dollars and other hard currencies.

"To this the Egyptians objected on the ground that they were short of dollars themselves and perfectly capable of selling their own cotton for dollars. Egypt also does a good deal of business with Czechoslovakia, exchanging cotton for industrial equip and products and manufactured goods.

"The last Egyptian cotton crop was excellent. The Soviet, on the contrary, reported it has a somewhat disappointing crop."

NY Hearald Tribune Correspondent Allen Raymond, Tokyo 15 Jan: Gen Douglas MacArthur announced here yesterday the issuance of a new set of rules for foreign investors in Japan, designed to ease some of the tight controls maintained since the surrender. His hq said also that the Japanese Govt had been directed to cooperate in bringing foreign capital here for such activities as meet the General's approval. According to Governor Hisato Ichimada of the Bank of Japan, no considerable influx of foreign capital may be expected before there is sweeping revision of existing laws governing business enterprise, the creation of a single foreign exchange rate for the yen and a great improvement in relations between capital and labor. Most representatives of large American corporations who have visited here since the surrender are now back in the US, having thrown up their hands in dismay at the complex post war controls over business management and the chaos existing in labor management relations. This correspondent recently had access to the report of a committee representing several of these great corporations, which declared that "no major American private enterprise would either enter Japan or return to 't under existing conditions." Meanwhile a new Japanese organization called the Foreign Investment Council


