Part 1. Effective 1 Feb 49 voluntary enlistments RA will be accepted on following plan:

A. Qualified applicants for enlistment for 21 months between the ages of 19 and 26 will be accepted under current standards (profile C and GCT 70).

B. Qualified applicants for enlistment for 12 months 18 years of age will be accepted within current quota (WX 85521, 9 July 48) under current standards (profile C and GCT 70).

C. Qualified applicants reenlisted within 90 days of discharge will be accepted under current standards (profile C).

D. Qualified applicants for enlistment who have had prior service, other than C above, will be accepted under current standards (profile C and GCT 70).

E. All others qualified for enlistment under current standards will be subject of selective system described in Par 2.

Part 2. A. Each month DA will announce a ceiling with physical profile and GCT grouping established for enlistment under that ceiling; of individuals described in 1 E above. These 12 categories are in order of priority:

A 1, A 2, A 3, B 1, B 2, C 1, A 4, B 3, C 2, C 3, B 4, C 4.

B. Applicants under 1 E above, who meet all requirements, including category established for that month, will be enlisted up to number set by ceiling. All other applicants under 1 E above, who meet minimum standards (profile C GCT 70), including those who meet standard established for current month but for whom no vacancy exists, will be placed on waiting list in order of category prescribed above. Names will be added to waiting list in appropriate category. Physical examination will be completed for each applicant with GCT 70 or above to determine proper place on waiting list.

C. Ceilings for subsequent months will be filled:

(1) From those on waiting list whose category is equal or above cut off established for month.

(2) New Applicants whose profile is equal or above cut off.

Part 3. A. For Feb ceiling for applicants under 2 E above is suballocated as follows: First Army 670, Second Army 850, Third Army 550, Fourth Army 470, Fifth Army 960 Sixth Army 440, FEC 20, USARPAC 25, EUCOM 5, USARCARIB 5 USARAL 5.

B. Enlistments in Feb under above ceiling will be restricted to applicants whose profile is 1 of following: A 1, A 2, A 3, B 1, B 2.

Part 4. A. For such time as Army is able to maintain authorized strength with reduced monthly input emphasis will be placed on securing best qualified individuals for military career. Convassers will be impressed with this objective. No effort will be made to induce individuals on waiting lists, or who would qualify for inclusion on waiting lists, to enlist for periods of less than 3 years, but obstacles will not be placed in the way of qualified applicants for short term enlistments.

B. Requirement for reserve service must be carefully explained to each applicant for short term enlistment that he may fully understand all obligations.

C. Rigid adherence mental and physical standards mandatory. No army and no element of recruiting service will be judged or compared on basis of number of enlistments obtained after effective date this plan. Quality not quantity is objective.

Part 5. Army commanders will suballocate authorized ceilings to secure maximum number of men with highest qualifications. Experience gained in past years rather than population data should provide basis for suballocation.

Part 6. Nothing herein will be interpreted as modifying

Under Secretary Draper was called this morning re Miss Twohy of International Girl Scouts who is in Japan. The call came just prior to my departure and I was unable to get DA reaction to request. However, I believe Mister Draper would appreciate favorable consideration this matter if it would be appropriate to do so. - In the event extension cannot be granted full details should be furnished Wash so matter can be properly handled here. Please advise SAOUS of SCAP's action. Substance of telephone call follows:

The International Girl Scouts sent a professional girl scout organizer, Miss Marguerite Twohy, to Japan in Oct, with the full approval of SCAP. Her permit expires 6 Feb 49. She is being paid by the Quiette Lowell Fund. Military Govt was to furnish quarters, subsistence, etc, and was to be reimbursed from the fund. She has notified her International Hq. in New York that military govt has not acted upon her extension and that on 6 Feb all facilities for her will be withdrawn. The International Hq. cabled Gen MacArthur asking that her permit be extended until May. They have also cabled Mrs Truman.

New subj. Mister Van Zandt submitted the following concurrent resolution in the House of Representatives on 10 Jan which was referred to the Committee on Rules:

"Resolved By the House of Representatives (the Senate concurring), that the President is hereby requested, in the name of the American people, to invite Gen of the Army Douglas A MacArthur, US Commander in Chief, USA, to return to the US for a period of at least 30 days in order that he may appear before a joint meeting of the Senate and House of Representatives to give his views on matters affecting the Security of the US and in order

"The Egyptian Govt has prohibited the export of 25,000 bales of cotton purchased last week by the Soviet Union for delivery to Czechoslovakia.

"The Exchange Control Office in Alexandria of the Ministry of Fin in making the announcement said the purchase of Egyptian products with Egyptian money by one country for delivery to another country was contrary to the exchange regs.

"The Soviet bought the cotton in Egypt on the basis of clearing and barter deals, supposedly for its own uses. However, it was discovered last spring that the Soviet had been not only sending Egyptian cotton to Czechoslovakia but that Egyptian cotton had been sold on European markets for dollars and other hard currencies.

"To this the Egyptians objected on the ground that they were short of dollars themselves and perfectly capable of selling their own cotton for dollars. Egypt also does a good deal of business with Czechoslovakia, exchanging cotton for industrial equip and products and manufactured goods.

"The last Egyptian cotton crop was excellent. The Soviet, on the contrary, reported it has a somewhat disappointing crop."

This article substantiates Baruchs contention cited in ourad.

"Former Premier Shigeru Yoshida's ultra conservative Democratic Liberal Party apparently has won this morning the Japanese gen election held yesterday and will form the next govt under Gen Douglas MacArthur. Thus, the extreme right in Japanese politics as tolerated under the occupation authorities presumably will rule Japan during the crucial period during which the US is trying to put the nation on its feet. Surprisingly, there have been few gains thus far for the Japanese Communists. . . .

"According to reports early this morning, only one Communist was elected out of the 1st 79 candidates known to be sure of their Diet seats." . . .

Washington Post correspondent Thurston Griggs, 23 Jan:

"The general national election held in Japan today is a satire on Democracy. Since the ultimate power in Japan now is the Supreme Commander of the Allied Powers, there is no real national sovereignty. MacArthur cannot be removed by election; there is offered only a choice of collaborationist leaders. It is an election without issues. Its only significance is to show the increasing strength of Communism in Japan. 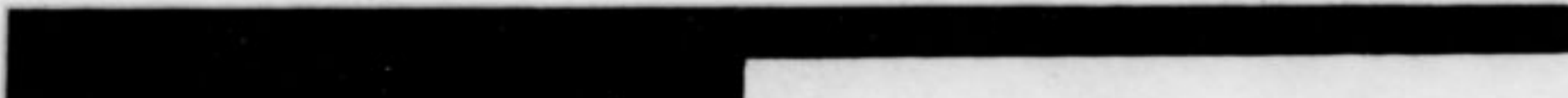

"The Bureau has ruled that a civil employee of the US who returns to this country of his own volition, whether on lv or otherwise, is not entitled to the benefits of Public Law Nbr 633. It has also decided that pers who are merely auth to trvl via govt facilities under orders which permit but do not require them to take the trip are not traveling pursuant to govt instructions within the meaning of the statute.

"In view of the foregoing, the Bureau is of the opinion that civ employees of the US who voluntarily return to this country under orders which only authorize them to utilize USAT facilities, and not at the direction and expense of the govt, are not returning pursuant to govt instructions so as to entitle them to the benefits of Public Law Nbr 633."

WCL 23145, 13 May 48, also quoted:

"Commissioner of customs advises employees of Army Exchange Service are considered within the service of the US, and are therefore entitled to free entry privileges under Public Law 633. Employees of the Red Cross are not entitled to free entry privileges under cited public law and National Hq American Red Cross has been so advised by the acting Sec of the Treasury.

NY Herald Tribune Correspondent Allen Raymond, Tokyo 15 Jan: Gen Douglas MacArthur announced here yesterday the issuance of a new set of rules for foreign investors in Japan, designed to ease some of the tight controls maintained since the surrender. His hq said also that the Japanese Govt had been directed to cooperate in bringing foreign capital here for such activities as meet the General's approval. According to Governor Hisato Ichimada of the Bank of Japan, no considerable influx of foreign capital may be expected before there is sweeping revision of existing laws governing business enterprise, the creation of a single foreign exchange rate for the yen and a great improvement in relations between capital and labor. Most representatives of large American corporations who have visited here since the surrender are now back in the US, having thrown up their hands in dismay at the complex post war controls over business management and the chaos existing in labor management relations. This correspondent recently had access to the report of a committee representing several of these great corporations, which declared that "no major American private enterprise would either enter Japan or return to it under existing conditions."
